
STATE OF THE INDUSTRY


As the first table illustrates, the share of manufacturing, represented by the secondary sector, has declined in Punjab. Similarly, since 2011–12, the rate of growth of this sector has reduced significantly. Data from the Annual Survey of Industries show that the number of factories in Punjab declined between 2010–11 and 2011–12 (latest figures). During the same period, the number of employees also fell by around 14.000
