MODIFICATION IN TATKAL BOOKING SYSTEM

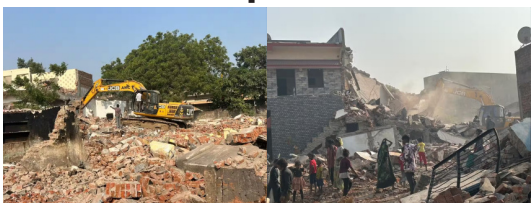
Ahmedabad, Western Railway will be implementing an important modification in the Tatkal booking system in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Railway Board. Tatkal tickets will now be issued only after authentication of a system generated One Time Password (OTP). This OTP will be sent to the mobile number furnished by the passenger at the time of booking, and the ticket will be issued only after successful validation of the

OTP. According to press release issued by Chief Public Relations Officer, Western Railway Shri Vineet Abhishek, this OTP-based Tatkal authentication system will be implemented with effect from 01st December 2025 at 00:00 hrs and will initially apply to Train No. 12009/12010 Mumbai Central - Ahmedabad Shatabdi Express.

The new system will be applicable for Tatkal bookings made through computerized PRS counters, authorized

agents, IRCTC website and IRCTC mobile app. The objective of this change is to ensure transparent Tatkal bookings and to facilitate genuine passengers in getting better access to Tatkal tickets. Passengers are advised to provide a valid, accessible mobile number at the time of booking to ensure smooth completion of the OTP verification process. Western Railway urges all passengers to take note of this important change.

AMC removes encroachments at Isanpur Talav



Ahmedabad: Moving on to another site of illegal encroachment, the Amavadi Municipal Corporation (AMC) team on Monday morning reached the Isanpur Talav location for removal of encroachments. Multiple JCB machines have been deployed for the task along with police bandobast and the presence of over 500 AMC staffers.

According to Deputy Commissioner Riddhesha R. Rawal, Isanpur is the third-largest lake in the city and the demolition drive is being carried out to protect the

waterbody. The corporation had earlier demolished 167 commercial structures, while the present phase involves the demolition of 925 residential structures that have come up illegally on the lake area. Officials stated that notices were issued to all residential units before the monsoon, but the action was delayed due to Diwali.

Later, the drive was originally scheduled for November 20 but was postponed after locals requested four days; now the action has been initiated

today. Currently, the demolition work is being executed with the team of 4 zones.

The operation is underway with 8 Hitachi and 8 JCB machines, in the presence of 500 police personnel and 500 AMC staff members including medical and fire teams. Officials further added that 10 residents had approached the High Court, but the court order AMC to carry out demolition as the site is a lake area, while directing that those 10 petitioners be given time for compliance.

3 km long queue of vehicles, police closed the bridge as the situation worsened; Traffic eased at two and a half hours



Jamnagar The longest bridge in Saurashtra, inaugurated by the Chief Minister in Jamnagar, faced a huge traffic jam on the first day itself. People thronged the illuminated bridge for photo shoots and video making, disrupting traffic. The police had to struggle for two and a half hours to ease the traffic and had to close the bridge for a while. The Municipal Corporation has put up a mesmerizing display of lights on the bridge, which will be kept up for three days.

Saurashtra's longest 3.5-kilometer flyover, under construction since August 2021 at a cost of Rs 226 crore, was inaugurated by Chief Minister Bhupendra

Patel yesterday. After the bridge was opened yesterday afternoon, in the evening, the city residents went out to ride on the bridge in two-wheelers and four-wheelers with their family elders and children. After 9:30 pm, long queues of vehicles were formed on the roads from Sat Rasta Circle to Subhash Bridge.

People made reels and watched the view of the new bridge.

As the lighting on the new bridge was kept intact for three days by the Municipal Corporation, many motorists came to take advantage of it and make reels. Thousands of motorists made reels on their mobile phones on the first day itself and watched the view of the new bridge.

The police struggled continuously for two and a half hours, but on the other hand, the enthusiasm of the city residents became a challenge for the police. Vehicles were stuck in Sat Road and its surrounding areas, while a heavy traffic jam was also created on Subhash Bridge. The police had to struggle continuously for two and a half hours to undo the traffic.

Traffic flow was normal in the late night.

Jamnagar Traffic Police, along with the police staff of the city's City B. Division and other police teams were busy in smoothing the traffic flow. As the townspeople were in a hurry to move forward and honk their horns on the moving vehicles, the noise on most of the roads increased, however, the flow of townspeople decreased in the late night and traffic flow on the bridge was normal.

The bridge had to be closed to the public for a while, so on the first day, there was a lot of traffic on the bridge as the townspeople showed great enthusiasm to ride the new bridge. As the police removed the people from the bridge, they also closed the bridge to new people for a while.

Four-Year-Old Boy Critically Injured in Attack by Pack of Stray Dogs in Surat

Surat: A four-year-old boy of migrant family from Uttar Pradesh was critically injured after being mauled by a pack of stray dogs in the Sachin area of the city on Monday, highlighting once again the growing concern over stray dog attacks across the country. The incident happened outside the Diamond Eco Park in Gabheni area of the city. The child, identified as Shival, lives with the Rajesh Prajapati family in Sachin. According to police and local residents, he had accompanied his father, Rajesh Prajapati, near a company close to Eco Diamond park, where he was playing with his friends. Suddenly, a pack of stray dogs attacked him outside the premises. Witnesses said the dogs pounced on the child without warning, inflicting severe injuries on his head and multiple parts of his body.

Locals rushed to rescue the boy, and a passerby managed to pull him away from the dogs. The child, bleeding heavily, was immediately rushed to a nearby hospital. Doctors treating him said he has sustained deep injuries on his head and more than 50 bite wounds across the body. His condition remains extremely critical. Family members who reached the hospital were overwhelmed with grief, with the mother breaking down upon seeing the child's condition. Residents of the area expressed shock over the incident, pointing to repeated complaints about stray dog attacks in various parts of the city. The incident has once again raised concerns about public safety and the need for urgent measures to control aggressive stray dog population.

For the first time, a crime was registered against a dairy owner in Surat after a cheese sample failed

Action was taken against Shailesh Patel; 754 kg of cheese from Surabhi Dairy was seized, they were selling it at cheap prices

Surat Shailesh Patel confessed that the cheese was fake. The entire matter came to light on November 10, when the Special Operation Group (SOG) and the Health Department jointly raided the godown of Surabhi Dairy. During the operation, the officials seized more than 750 kilograms of fake cheese from the godown. Owner Shailesh Patel confessed on the spot that the cheese was fake. Owner Shailesh Patel arrested - Samples of the seized fake cheese were immediately sent to the laboratory. The lab report revealed that the quality of this cheese was extremely poor and unfit for human consumption.

Based on this report, a complaint was registered against Shailesh Patel at Khatodara police station and he was subsequently arrested. However, accused Shailesh Patel remained silent in the face of Divya Bhaskar's questions.

Reconstruction of the accused in the presence of DCP After the arrest, considering the seriousness of the case, DCP Rajdeep Singh Nakum of the Special Operations Group himself was present at the spot for the reconstruction. Caring for Our Elders: Preventing Abuse and Neglect

The world is undergoing significant demographic changes. Estimates indicate that by 2050, the global population of people above the age of 60 will exceed the number of younger people. According to UN estimates, the global population of people aged 60 years and older is set to touch about 1.2 billion in 2025 and globally around 4 per cent to 6 per cent of elderly people have experienced some form of maltreatment at home. In order to encourage communities to recognize the problem of elderly abuse, 15th June is observed as 'World elder abuse awareness day'.

Study shows that elderly are abused, neglected and exploited which is one of the biggest issues facing senior citizens around the world. According to World Health Organization 4 to 6 per cent of elderly suffer from some form of abuse, a large percentage of which goes unreported.

Nearly half of all senior citizens are experiencing abuse and 'mistreatment' in public spaces. According to the survey, the senior citizens faces abuse in the areas like the actual experience of elders as they interacted with people and service providers; elder perceptions on elder ill-treatment; the general state



of mind of elders as they stepped out of their homes; and a wish-list of their expectations from society. 55% believed that Indian society discriminates against elders. Today, elders are abused in public/private places, the result of living conditions. Under the present scenario each and everything is being measured by Money Power. The problems of the elderly are primarily economic, marked by the loss of independent incomes. Health-related problems typically dog them too. Lack of safety and security are added perils, especially in urban settings. It was found that 65 per cent of elderly people are poor with no source of known income. 35 per cent have money or properties, savings, investments, inheritance and or supportive children. Irrespective to their financial status most of them face abuse in one form or the other. It is not only elders even young parents have to face embarrassing situations with their school going children, whenever child demands money for meeting what schools demands for extracurricular activities. It is a common sight in city buses, the seats 'reserved for senior citizens' reserved for senior citizens are invariably occupied by

others. To steal from elders money from their bank account is the simplest thing by own children/in-laws/bank staff/hackers. Don't we feel shame of ourselves treating our elders like that which is so disgraceful? Generally, we forget that one day, in ageing, we will also face such thing. It's India, where we learn to respect our elders. But, today, new generation has forgotten all things. Government must create awareness about the rights of elderly people, advocacy of old age issues at all level of governance and ensure implementation of policies pertaining to protection of interests of senior citizens. Senior citizens who are unable to maintain themselves financially shall have the right to apply to a maintenance tribunal for an allowance from their children and relatives. We need to give more stress to take concrete action and develop specific measures to address and monitor financial exploitation and material abuse in the context of an ageing society. The right of an elderly citizen to live a life of dignity must be made justifiable. Programmes to enhance skills and knowledge in geriatric care are needed. Explosive collision between dumper and trailer on Thara National Highway, CCTV

One died on the spot, crane had to be called to remove the body trapped in the cabin

Banaskantha (Palanpur) A serious accident took place between a dumper and a trailer on the Thara National Highway in Ogad taluka of Banaskantha district. In this accident, the trailer driver died tragically on the spot. The accident was so terrible that a crane had to be called to remove the body of the driver trapped in the cabin of the trailer. The entire incident of the accident has been captured on CCTV camera.

The dumper suddenly stopped in the middle of the road...

It can be clearly seen in the CCTV footage that a dumper driver suddenly stops the vehicle in the middle of the road on the slope of Thara Bridge on the Deesa-Radhanpur highway. Meanwhile, a trailer coming from behind at high speed collides with the dumper with a bang. The trailer driver died on the spot. After the accident, the local people immediately rushed to the spot and tried to pull out the trailer driver. However, due to the serious accident, the trailer driver died on the spot and was trapped in the cabin. The locals informed the police, after which the police reached the spot. JCB-crane had to be called to remove the body.

Despite the great efforts of the police and local people, it was difficult to remove the driver from the cabin. Finally, JCB and crane were called and with their help, the body of the trailer driver was removed. The body has been shifted to a nearby hospital for postmortem. Following this accident on the Thara National Highway, a crowd of people had gathered. The police have controlled the traffic and taken

further legal action. The trailer was going from Rajasthan to Morbi: PI

Regarding this, Thara PI. K.B. Desai said that this accident happened last night. The trailer was going towards Morbi from Rajasthan with powder for making tiles. Its driver Shankarhal Gujar had died in this accident. Further investigation is currently underway, Volkswagen breaks down while trying to save a
