Food delivery, qcom firms raise incentives amid gig workers' strike

Food delivery and quick commerce (qcom) companies, including Swiggy, Zomato, Blinkit, Instamart, and Zepto, increased payouts and rolled out additional incentives for delivery partners on Wednesday (December 31), as New Year's Eve (NYE) remains one of the busiest days of the year for these platforms.

While the hikes in per-order payouts and incentives are a usual phenomenon during festive periods and peak-demand occasions, the development also comes at a time when several gig worker unions have called for a nationwide strike. Workers are protesting low pay structures, poor working conditions, long working hours, arbitrary deactivation of IDs, and lack of medical facilities, emergency support, and social security.

In a joint statement, Telangana Gig and Platform Workers Union (TGPWU), and Indian Federation of App-based Transport Workers (IFAT) have said: "As of last night, over 170,000 delivery and app-based workers across India have confirmed participation, with numbers expected to rise further by evening."

As a result, to ensure adequate availability of delivery partners and smooth business operations, various companies are offering several attractive incentives.

In a social media post, Zomato said that over 23,000 delivery partners earned more than ₹1,500 on Christmas Day (December 25). It added that workers can earn up to ₹3,000 on NYE. Notably, the platform is offering up to ₹150 per order between 6 pm and midnight on food deliveries. Similar to Zomato, Swiggy is also advertising peak-hour earnings (6 pm-12 midnight) of ₹2,000.

On the qcom side, Raj, a 24-year-old delivery partner working at Swiggy Instamart, shared that the company is giving incentives worth ₹1,000 on 20 orders, ₹1,600 on 30 orders, ₹2,400 on 40 orders, and ₹3,000 on 45 orders, and so on. "On normal days, the incentive is usually around ₹145 for 17 orders,

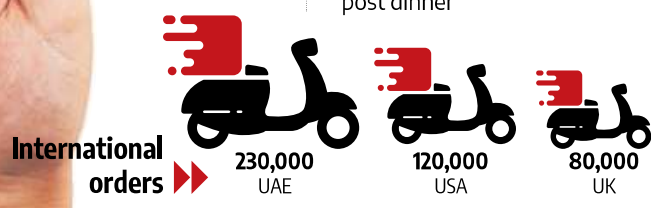

DAZZLING SYDNEY FIREWORKS RING IN NEW YEAR



In Sydney, thousands thronged to the downtown waterfront on Wednesday to watch a dazzling fireworks show centred on the Sydney Harbour Bridge to welcome the New Year. But celebrations were held under the pall of its worst mass shooting at Bondi Beach in almost 30 years. Auckland was the first major city to ring in 2026 with a downtown fireworks display launched from New Zealand's tallest structure, Sky Tower. In Indonesia, cities scaled back New Year's Eve festivities as a gesture of solidarity with communities devastated by catastrophic floods and landslides

Consumers drive qcom sales on New Year's Eve

Consumers increasingly turned to quick commerce (qcom) and food delivery platforms on New Year's Eve (December 31), with sales volumes seeing a noticeable uptick as demand rose ahead of the celebrations despite the gig workers' strike.

Swiggy Co-founder Phani Kishan Addepalli said the search for grapes spiked throughout the day. "Today, Instamart saw 235,000 searches for grapes in the first half of the day, with searches starting as early as 5 am." In all, the searches for grapes on Instamart rose 78 times compared to usual days.

Not just on Instamart, Zepto also witnessed

a sharp spike in grape purchases. The grapes were one of the top searched items as consumers followed a global ritual of eating 12 grapes at midnight, symbolising luck for each month of the year.

While Instamart had waived delivery, handling, and surge fees on orders above ₹199, Zepto removed all fees on orders exceeding ₹149.

On overall trends on qcom, Amitesh Jha, chief executive officer of Instamart, said that categories such as party supplies, gifting essentials, snacks and beverages, beauty, personal care, and grooming, and grapes saw high growth on the platform.
