Work begins on Rs. 17.65 cr Viruthaseera bridge

Ranipet, Feb 2:

The foundation stone for the construction of a high-level bridge across the Viruthaseera River was laid on Saturday at kilometre 31/6 on State Highway 50B near Arigilapadi, connecting Thandalam, Perambakkam and Thakkolam areas in Arakkonam taluk of Ranipet district.

The project, estimated at Rs.17.65 crore, is being implemented under the State Highways Department's comprehensive road infrastructure development programme. The bridge will have a total length of 125.06 metres with a carriageway width of 10.5 metres.



As part of the structure, 11 abutments and piers will be constructed along with the superstructure. Retaining walls measuring 40 metres on the Thandalam side and 46.49 metres on the Arakkonam side will also be built. The contract period for the project is 15 months.

Handlooms and Textiles Minister R. Gandhi inaugurated the work by performing the ground-breaking ceremony. He urged the contractor to ensure that the construction is completed swiftly and with high quality, and stressed that the bridge should be opened for public use before the onset of the next monsoon season.

Ranipet District Collector J.U. Chandrakala was present during the event.

Officials from the Highways Department, including Divisional Engineer Sundaram, Assistant Director Gnanaprakasam and Assistant Engineer Ashok, attended the function. Thakkolam Municipal Chairperson Nagarajan, Nemili Union Chairperson Vadivelu, Thakkolam Municipal Vice-Chairperson Gomala, along with contractors Deenadayalan and Chandrakumar, and local representatives were also present.

Rajan Venkatesan, CFO, reported quarterly revenue of Rs.2,780 million, reflecting 7.9% growth in rupee terms and 5.7% in dollar terms.

Collector inspects cleanliness drive along Girivalam path

Tiruvannamalai, Feb 2:

Tiruvannamalai District Collector K. Tharpagaraj inspected the cleanliness drive being carried out along the Girivalam path following the Thai Poornami festival. The inspection was conducted to review sanitation measures undertaken after the large-scale pilgrimage to the Arunachaleswarar Temple.

The Thai Poornami Girivalam, held a day earlier at the Arulmigu Arunachaleswarar Temple in Tiruvannamalai, witnessed the participation of around 15 lakh devotees and members of the public from various districts and states. In the aftermath of the event, extensive sanitation work has been taken up to clear garbage and waste generated along the Girivalam routes.

A total of 410 sanitation workers have been deployed for the operation, and approximately 210 tonnes of waste have been removed so far. During the inspection, the Collector reviewed the ongoing cleaning work and instructed sanitation workers to

strictly use safety gloves and protective equipment while handling waste.

He also interacted with the workers to ensure that essential facilities such as vehicles and food arrangements were being provided properly during the sanitation drive.
