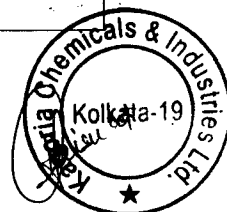
This is in reply to your email dated 31st January 2026, regarding additional details required for Corporate Announcement filed under Regulation 30 of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015.

In terms the Regulations 30 read with Para A of Schedule III of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, kindly note that only orders passed by any regulatory, statutory, enforcement authority or judicial body **against** the listed entity or its directors, key managerial personnel, senior management, promoter or subsidiary, in relation to the listed entity, is required to be disclosed. 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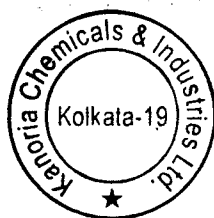
