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India hopes US will consider visa applications of students on merit

NEW DELHI: India hoped the US will consider the visa applications of Indian students on merit and that they will be able to join their academic programmes on time, amid reports that the US has paused scheduling new interviews for international students under the F, M, and J visa categories. MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said at a briefing in response to a question: We have seen reports suggesting US government’s updated guidance regarding students and exchange visitor visa applicants. “The welfare of Indian students abroad remains of

utmost priority to the Government of India. We will continue to follow further



developments in this regard. “While we note that issuance of visa is a sovereign function, we hope that the application of Indian students will be considered

on merit and they will be able to join their academic programs on time. “There are other categories of visas which are also issued, and hopefully these are functions which lie in the sovereign domain, and we should be respectful of them.” “In 2023-24, 330,000 students were there. This year, the updated figure we don’t have ... we are talking about 2023-24. For updated figures, you can also visit the relevant websites of the US Government. “ This appeal comes amid Washington considering tightening social media scrutiny for visa applicants.

LCA Tejas Mk 1A

First centre fuselage handed over to HAL

NEW DELHI: In a significant boost to India’s indigenous defence manufacturing capabilities, the first centre fuselage assembly for the Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas Mk1A was handed over to Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) by VEM Technologies in Hyderabad on Friday. The handover took place in the presence of Secretary (Defence Production) Sanjeev Kumar and Chairman & Managing Director (CMD) of HAL, DK Sunil, a Defence Ministry statement said. This event marks the first time a major sub-assembly

for the LCA Tejas is being manufactured by a private Indian company. Speaking on the occasion, Sanjeev Kumar hailed the partnership between HAL and VEM Technologies in accelerating the production of LCA Mk 1A. He said, “There is a significant growth in defence production at a rate of about 10 percent annually, as well as in our defence exports. This would not have been possible without the support of industries and Public Sector Units like HAL. Security and sovereignty of the country are paramount and cannot be achieved without our own manufac-

turing and supply of spare parts, which could meet the requirements of the Armed Forces”. CMD, HAL, acknowledged the rapid growth of Tier 1 and MSME suppliers in the production of the LCA Tejas. The handover marked a significant milestone in establishing a fourth production line for the LCA Mk1A, in addition to the two existing lines in HAL-Bengaluru and one in HAL-Nashik. He assured that with major sub-assemblies underway, HAL will increase the production of the LCA aircraft and ensure timely deliveries to the Indian Air Force.

HAL has built a national aerospace ecosystem by closely supporting private partners and providing critical inputs such as jigs, fixtures, tools, and technical know-how. This has enabled companies like L&T, Alpha Tocol, Tata Advanced Systems Ltd (TASL), VEM Technologies, and Lakshmi Machine Works (LMW) to produce complex sub-assemblies such as centre fuselages, fuel drop tanks, pylons, rear fuselages, wings, fins, rudders, and air intakes. The LCA Tejas Division has already received structural modules of air intake assemblies, rear fuselage

assemblies, loom assemblies, and fin and rudder assemblies in the Mk1A configuration. HAL plans to extend this outsourcing model to future projects, reinforcing its in-house capacity with the expertise of Indian industry. In line with the vision of Aatmanirbhar Bharat, HAL continues to drive indigenisation efforts in the aerospace and defence sector. In the last three years, HAL has placed orders worth Rs 13,763 crore with Indian vendors and is actively pursuing the indigenisation of complex aircraft systems and critical components across platforms.

Govt will announce package: Shah

JAMMU: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Friday said the government will announce a package



for the families affected in the Pakistan shelling and ensure that the development of Jammu and Kashmir will continue. Shah also handed over appointment letters to the families affected in shelling during 'Operation Sindoor'. Interacting with the shelling-affected families in Poonch, Shah said, “We un-

derstand that the relief and jobs cannot compensate the pain and damage you have suffered; you have lost your loved ones. The Jammu and Kashmir government, the government of India and the sentiments of the nation are connected with the people of this border belt.” Shah said the government will soon announce a separate package for the shelling-affected families, adding, “we condemn the Pahalgam terror attack and the attack on civilian areas, religious places, schools, by Pakistan in Jammu and Kashmir in which Poonch district was the worst affected.” At least 14 civilians, including twin sisters, died in the Pakistani shelling in Poonch district.

Five killed, 29 injured

MUKTSAR (PUNJAB): Five migrant workers were killed and 29 others injured in an explosion at a firecracker manufacturing unit at Singhwala village in Muktsar district on early on Friday. Many migrant workers engaged in the production and packaging of firecrackers worked in this factory located near the Haryana border. SSP Akhil Chaudhary said that preliminary information has revealed that the explosion took place in the firecracker manufacturing area. The reasons are yet to be ascertained. He said that the explosion caused the building to collapse, causing casualties.

PM to release stamp & coin

BHOPAL: PM Narendra Modi will release a commemorative stamp and a Rs 300 coin in honour of Ahilyabai Holkar during the Women Empowerment Conference in Bhopal today (Saturday). Official sources said the PM will attend the conference at Jamburi Maidan today (May 31), marking the 300th birth anniversary of Ahilyabai Holkar. On this occasion, he will release a commemorative stamp and a special Rs 300 coin featuring Ahilyabai Holkar's image. The PM will also confer the National Devi Ahilyabai Award on a woman artist who has made significant contributions to tribal, folk, and will lay the foundation stone for ghat construction works worth over Rs 860 crore along the Shipra River in Ujjain as part of preparations for “Singhst 2028”. The PM will also virtually inaugurate two new airports in Datia and Satna and launch passenger services on the Super Priority Corridor/

PM warns Op Sindoor will resume...

BIKRAMGANJ (BIHAR): Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday renewed his warning of stern action against terrorism under ‘Operation Sindoor’ if any misadventure was visible on Indian soil, and that those involved would be taken out of their hideouts and crushed. PM Modi was addressing a public meeting in Rohtas district of Bihar, second in the state since April 24 after Pahalgam terror attack. He said he had made a promise during his last visit to punish terrorists and their patronisers “beyond their imagination” for killing innocent people in Pahalgam on April 22. He fulfilled his promise as terror hideouts in Pakistan were razed and other military establishments were damaged in Operation Sindoor carried out by the armed forces, he said. “Operation Sindoor has not been stopped; it is just on hold but would be put in action again if any misadventure of terror attack was attempted on our soil,”



the Prime Minister said, adding that those involved in any such misadventure even in the future would be crushed, taking them out from their hideouts. “Valour of our armed forces in Operation Sindoor was witnessed around the world but it is not the only arrow in our tarkash (quiver) and more will come out in the event of any terror attack again “, Modi said, clearly indicating that further action against terrorists and their patronisers would be more fierce and devastating. The Prime Minister said that youths of Bihar, particularly of the Shahabad region, the birthplace of Veer Kunwar Singh, were in the armed forces in large numbers. He also paid tribute to BSF Jawan Imtiyaz, who was martyred during Operation Sindoor. Modi, during his last visit on April 24 in Madhubani district of Bihar, had issued a warning to terrorists and conspirators involved in the Pahalgam attack that they would be punished beyond their imagination.

Agriculture sector

Govt to invest Rs 5K cr every year: CM

HINGOLI: Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis announced on Thursday that the state government has undertaken the task of making a big change in agriculture by investing Rs 5,000 crore per year in agriculture sector. Speaking on occasion of inaugurating various developmental works in the district, he said, “We are giving the benefit of the Solar Agricultural Pump Scheme to whoever asks for it. Through the Nanaji Deshmukh Krishi Sanjeevani Scheme, we have tried to increase the productivity of agricul-

ture by investing in the agriculture sector in 5,000 villages of Marathwada and Western Vidarbha with the help of the World Bank. We have added the Magnet Project to it. Now, the government has decided to implement the Nanaji Deshmukh Krishi Samruddhi Scheme Phase 2 in 7,500 villages in the state, including Hingoli.” The Chief Minister also expressed his resolve to complete the works of the CM Solar Scheme by December 2026 and said that due to this, farmers will have access to electricity during the day.

Nigeria flooding

21 dead, 10 missing


ABUJA: At least 21 bodies have been recovered, and 10 others remain missing after torrential rainfalls triggered severe flooding in Nigeria's north-central state of Niger, local authorities said Thursday. Ibrahim Hussaini, head of the Niger State Emergency Management Agency, told reporters that three people were

rescued after the torrential downpour late Wednesday caused widespread destruction in the Mokwa area. More than 50 residential houses were submerged and swept away, some with occupants still inside, Hussaini said, adding that a rescue operation is underway for the 10 missing. Earlier this week, Zubaida Umar, director-general of the

National Emergency Management Agency, said efforts were underway to mitigate the impact of flooding across the country this year. Speaking during a national sensitisation campaign on flood preparedness, Umar urged all levels of government to invest in drainage systems, dams, and flood-resilient infrastructure in riverine areas.

Trump’s envoys to visit Israel: Reports

TEL AVIV: US special envoy for Syria Thomas Barrack and Deputy Special Presidential Envoy to the Middle East Morgan Ortagus will visit Israel’s northern border next week amid normalisation talks between the Jewish state and Syria, Israeli media reported. Israel and Syria held several rounds of the first known direct talks in order to ease the tensions between the two neighboring countries and prevent conflict in the border region.
