Plane crash exposes serious lapses

Let us start with what India truly is- despite the big multi-colored posters in petrol bunks where Modi is projected as the Saviour of India, lifting people from the street, running to find food and opening the door to Indian Heaven. This narrative is driven by flashy rallies and grandiose promises, but that image does not change the ground reality of endemic corruption, compromises, and systemic failings that many citizens experience daily, especially when tragedies reveal institutional weaknesses. The recent Baramati plane crash and the questions it raises about regulatory oversight only add to these concerns.

A chartered Business Learjet 45 carrying Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar and four others crashed near Baramati Airport on January 28, 2026, killing instantly everyone on board. The aircraft was operated as a charter flight from Mumbai and was attempting a second landing when it lost control and burst into flames near the runway. All five occupants, including two crew members and two staff, died in the accident.

In the wake of the tragedy, aviation safety issues have come into sharp focus. An European Aviation Regulator (EASA) had previously suspended the international authorisation of the operator, VSR Ventures, citing serious safety concerns over compliance and a failure to provide crucial documentation, making it one of the regulator's most severe "level-1" findings. This suspension was communicated to India's DGCA, raising immediate questions about how the operator continued flights here despite those warnings.

However, the DGCA's own records indicate that VSR Ventures held a valid non-scheduled operator permit and had undergone an audit in early 2025 without any level-1 findings, suggesting a disparity



between domestic oversight and international safety evaluations. The operator has maintained that the jet was "in good condition" before the flight, even as investigations continue.

Initial findings from the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB), point to poor visibility and challenging landing conditions at the Baramati airstrip, which lacks advanced navigation aids and is classified as an uncontrolled aerodrome. Foggy conditions reportedly hampered the approach on the morning of the crash, a factor that can complicate landings even for experienced crews.

Investigators have recovered the black box (flight data and cockpit voice recorder), and further analysis of that data will be the key to determining the precise chain of events leading up to the crash. The official probe is expected to take several weeks and may examine issues ranging from pilot

decision-making under visual flight rules to infrastructural shortfalls at the airstrip.

Critics of the handling and oversight of non-scheduled flights have called for deeper scrutiny of regulatory practices, pointing out that this is not an isolated incident in India's aviation history - with multiple runway excursions and landing phase occurrences documented in recent years - and that stronger enforcement of safety standards is overdue.

This tragic accident has sparked broad debate about institutional accountability rather than serving only as a technical question of aviation safety. In a country where political narratives often dominate headlines, the deeper issue remains whether authorities will genuinely learn from warnings and investigations or simply move on with the next briefing, leaving systemic flaws unaddressed.

As these do not alter water taste or clarity, households may unknowingly consume unsafe water.

Factors such as untreated discharge, over-extraction, construction, and seasonal changes are worsening water quality. Municipal treatment efforts exist, but variability across neighbourhoods and buildings limits reliability. Household water filters provide essential protection, with certified systems removing contaminants effectively for extended periods, unlike ordinary or unbranded filters.

Ensuring safe drinking water requires modern filtration, improved infrastructure, and regulatory oversight, alongside informed household choices, to safeguard public health and support sustainable urban living.
