Garbage piles up across Coimbatore city as sanitation workers, drivers stage stir

GARBAGE collection across several wards in Coimbatore city came to a halt on Friday after drivers of dump trucks and garbage transfer vehicles working with the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) staged a protest near the Ukkadam garbage transfer station.

The protest comes in the wake of a new private agency taking over solid waste management operations in the city from Friday. The workers, who were engaged under the previous contractor, raised serious concerns over job security and long-pending employee benefits.

Their demands include a wage hike, proper regulation of Provident Fund (PF) and Employees' State Insurance (ESI) contributions, permanent employment status, and an end

to the contract labour system currently followed by CCMC.

"We've been working as drivers and sanitation workers under the Corporation for years. The previous contractor didn't provide basic safety equipment or ensure PF and ESI benefits.

Despite submitting several petitions, there was no resolution," said one of the protesting workers.

According to them, Corporation officials had earlier promised to negotiate with the incoming agency and secure

written assurances on employee benefits and job continuity. However, with no updates or formal communication from the authorities, the workers said they felt compelled to protest. They are now seeking a detailed report and written assurance on the dues owed by the previous contractor and a clear plan on the new agency's policies regarding existing workers.

Senior CCMC officials, including Deputy Commissioners A Sulthana and T Kumaresan, along with health department authorities, held discussions with the protesting workers. The officials assured them that steps would be taken to address their concerns within a month.

The protest has left garbage collection operations in limbo, impacting several parts of the city and raising concerns about sanitation and public health.

'Power to control CBSE schools lies with the state'

MARUMALARCHI Makkal Iyakkam founder V Eswaran petitioned the state child rights commission seeking action against CBSE's move to implement a policy where students of Classes 3, 5 and 8 could be detained if they score low marks.

"There have been reports that CBSE schools in the state are seeking parents' consent to detain students if they perform poorly. It is regrettable that the School Education Minister has asked parents to oppose this, even though the power to control it lies with the state government," said Eswaran.

He added that the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) in 2024 replied to the Madras High Court in a case related to the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Educa-

tion Act 2009, that the board has minimum control over CBSE-affiliated schools, especially examinations and had affirmed that schools will function within legal provisions of the respective state government.

"Except for Tamil Nadu, in other states, the state government conducts student admission, including to CBSE schools, under the RTE Act. According to RTE Act, students from Class 1 to 8 cannot be detained. However, as per the new amendment, they can be failed in Class 5 and 8. However, it has also

been said that the final decision for this remains with the respective state government. Since the state government has not accepted this amendment, there is no need to implement the practice here," Eswaran said, in his letter. He urged the State Child Rights Protection Commission to initiate appropriate action in this regard.

Collector holds grievance meeting with trans persons

Coimbatore: The Coimbatore district administration conducted a special grievance meeting on Friday for trans persons. Collector Pavankumar G Giriyanavar presided over the meeting held in the collectorate in which around 260 trans persons took part. Officials from various departments also attended. Trans persons submitted petitions to the collector regarding employment, housing, bank loans, Aadhaar card amendment, medical insurance card, etc. Acamp for Aadhaar card correction was set up for trans persons. Further, those who completed 18 years of age were given a form to apply for a voter ID card. Subiksha Srinivasan, a trans person and founder of My Society Trust, said, "We are grateful for the special grievance meeting held for the transgender community. This is the first time the district administration conducted a grievance meeting in which officials from several departments participated. In the meeting, we submitted our grievances, especially the lack of reservations for trans persons in education and employment."

Firm ordered to pay damages for faulty machine

Coimbatore: The District Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission has ordered an electronic goods manufacturing company to pay ₹7,000 as compensation to a petitioner for 'deficiency in service'. Petitioner Mayilsamy of Ganapathy in the city complained that he bought a washing machine from a showroom at Gandhipuram by paying ₹11,600. It had a five-year warranty but the machine malfunctioned. He filed a suit at the consumer court after the company's service centre did not rectify the fault. After a probe, the court ordered the company to pay the compensation along with ₹5,000 as legal expenses. ENS

SEVERAL ministers in Chief Minister MK Stalin's Cabinet will lose their post in the run-up to the state polls due next year, stated Coimbatore South constituency legislator Vanathi Srinivasan on Friday.

"There will be a situation where Chief Minister MK Stalin will have to keep changing his Cabinet, and before the assembly election, many in his Cabinet will be meeting the people without the post of a minister," the BJP leader said, adding it was not a threat or warning but an outcome due to their previous actions.

She was speaking during the

inauguration of an anganwadi built under a CSR initiative of the ONGC at Annapoorana Layout in Siddhapudur.

Referring to her constituency, the MLA said, "The needs and issues of the Coimbatore South constituency were presented in the recent assembly session and the ministers have responded to them. The Chief Minister has also answered our questions promptly and it was conveyed that ₹350 crore has been allocated for the constituency."

Speaking about the Central Government's decision to conduct a caste census, Vanathi said the BJP believes that through the census, plans for the development of the people

can be formulated. She refuted the claims that it was an announcement focused on the Bihar assembly election due late this year.

Welcoming the CBSE's new evaluation procedure for classes 3, 5 and 8, Vanathi said "students completing middle school in government-run schools in Tamil Nadu are unable to read a single page and solve simple calculations. Hence evaluations based on examinations are a must."

On TVK's recent meeting in Coimbatore, Vanathi said since Vijay comes from a cinema background, it is natural people would gather to see him. "We should see how they take up the public issues and how they represent the voices of the people," she said.
