Decisions regarding the regional president should be taken after recognizing the tone of discontent within the party

NCP's former state secretary Novel Salve demands that decisions regarding the state president be taken after recognizing the tone of discontent within the party led by Sharad Chandra Pawar. Dr.Jagannathrao Hegde's birthday; Various awards to be distributed





PM Modi Likely To Meet All-Party Teams On Operation Sindoor Global Diplomacy Next Week

Prime Minister NarendraModi is likely to meet members of the all-party delegation that has been engaging with the international community to convey India's message post the Pahalgam terror attack and Operation Sindoor. Sources told CNN that the meeting is expected to take place in Delhi around June 9 or 10, where the delegations are likely to brief the Prime Minister on their global outreach efforts, key interactions, and responses received from various countries.As part of its initiative to garner global backing for India's fight against terrorism, the BJP-led government tasked seven multi-party delegations to visit 33 global capitals to carry forth India's message.Each delegation comprised Members of Parliament from various political parties, senior political figures, and experienced diplomats. The seven delegations were led by the following MPs:ShashiTharoor (INC); Ravi



Shankar Prasad (BJP); Sanjay Kumar Jha (JDU); Baijayant Panda (BJP); KanimozhiKarunanidhi (DMK); SupriyaSule (NCP); ShrikantEknathShinde (Shiv Sena). The seven delegations included a total of 59 members, featuring 31 political leaders from the ruling National Democratic Alliance (NDA) and 20 representatives from other political parties. Former diplomats also accompanied and supported the delegations in their outreach efforts.

Global Support For Team India Saudi Arabia expressed strong support for India's fight against terrorism originating from Pakistan, while Italy proposed enhancing bilateral cooperation and Indonesia

pledged to back New Delhi's stance against terrorism at all possible international platforms.India's zero-tolerance approach to terrorism was also commended in South Africa, and France reaffirmed its solidarity with New Delhi in combating the global threat.During their visit to Saudi Arabia, the all-party delegation met with Adel Al-Jubeir, Minister of State for Foreign Affairs, and acknowledged Riyadh's firm position against terrorism.The Indian Embassy in Riyadh, in a post on X, said the delegation "appreciated Saudi stand against terrorism and underscored India's strong position, including its zero-tolerance and 'new normal' approach toward terrorism."Delegation leader Baijayant Jay Panda described the meeting as "meaningful," noting on X that "India and Saudi Arabia share a dynamic partnership rooted in trust, shared interests, and a growing strategic bond."Panda led the eight-member group to Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Bahrain, and Algeria.

Bihar Assembly Polls Likely In 2-3 Phases; EC To Avoid Dates Coinciding With Diwali, Chhath

The Bihar Assembly Elections are likely to be held in two to three phases, and the decision on the poll schedule will be taken keeping dates of Diwali and Chhath festivals in view, sources said on Monday.The Election Commission of India has begun preparations for polls for the state Assembly, the term of which will end on November 22 this year. It is therefore mandatory for the election process to be completed before the tenure of the current government comes to an end.Chief Election Commissioner Gyanesh Kumar will visit Bihar this month to take stock of the situation. The ECI has already begun the training of its staff for the polls.Sources said that the ECI is making efforts to nullify the Opposition's allegations related to voter list fraud, like those made in previous Assembly polls, including in

Maharashtra, Haryana, and Delhi."That's why training for BLOs (Booth Level Officers) has also been conducted. All BLOs will be provided identity cards so that they can go door-to-door for verification," sources said.A campaign will also be launched in Bihar to update the voter list, so that the names of young people turning 18 can be added. "Now there will be no duplicate EPIC (Electors Photo Identity Card) numbers — they have been eliminated," sources said. Notably, after a crushing defeat in Maharashtra, Opposition leaders, including Rahul Gandhi, had alleged voter fraud, claiming that additional voters were added to the list to benefit the BJP.The ECI is also preparing to deal with the challenges posed by artificial intelligence (AI)."Soon, a special cell will be formed within the Commission to monitor AI-related issues," sources said.

2 Riders Flung Into Air, 2 Dragged After Speeding Car Rams Into Bike In Gorakhpur

In a tragic incident, four persons were killed after their two-wheeler was mowed down by a speeding car on the Gorakhpur-Varanasi National Highway in Uttar Pradesh. The accident, captured on surveillance camera, took place on Sunday at around 10 am.All the four individuals were riding on a single bike when it was hit by a Grand Vitara, causing two of them to be flung into the air while the other two were dragged on the bonnet for about 100 meters before the vehicle came to a stop.The accident took place when Sunil Kumar, Pradeep Kumar, Arvind Kumar and Rahul Kumar — all painters and residents of GarthauliTola in Sidhuwapar gram sabha — were heading towards Gorakhpur city on a single motorcycle, reported T OI.As per the footage, the bike was seen overtaking a tractor-trolley moments before ramming into the oncoming SUV, which was travelling at high speed. At the point of impact, two were flung a few meters into the air before landing on the road, while two got stuck on the car's front side and were dragged along the highway as the driver failed to stop immediately.The motorcycle was completely damaged in the collision. The SUV driver fled the scene and has yet to



be caught.Following the accident, locals rushed the victims to a nearby hospital where Pradeep, Sunil, and Arvind were declared dead on arrival. Rahul was referred to the district hospital but succumbed to his injuries on the way. Among the four deceased, Sunil, Pradeep and Rahul were cousins, while the fourth one, Arvind was Rahul's friend.Rahul, the only son of his parents, was supposed to get engaged on June 1, while Sunil left behind his two daughters.The police have registered a case against the missing driver and the bodies have been sent for postmortem. An investigation is currently underway.Earlier today, four people, including a woman, were killed and three others were severely injured after a truck collided with an SUV in Barabanki.

Mumbai Monsoon: 134 Private Buildings Declared 'Extremely Dangerous' To Live In

The Mumbai civic body has identified at least 134 private buildings as extremely dangerous and placed them under the 'C1 category', ordering them to evacuate immediately. These buildings have been classified as being in a state of extreme disrepair and unsafe for habitation.This alarming revelation comes after an extensive pre-monsoon structural audit carried out by the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC), which routinely surveys old and dilapidated structures ahead of the rainy season to avert potential tragedies. With the 2025 monsoon around the corner, the findings have triggered fresh concerns about urban safety in a city where vertical expansion often outpaces infrastructure upkeep.

Mumbai's Danger Zones Among the worst-affected areas is P North ward, covering neighbourhoods like Madh, Malvani, AppaPada, and Malad. Here, officials uncovered 15 buildings deemed critically dangerous. The area, marked by rapid urban expansion and a dense cluster of aging residential units, has long struggled with structural degradation.Another 15 buildings were recorded in the H West ward, which includes Bandra West and Santa Cruz West. This belt is known



for its older chawls and housing societies, many of which have not seen major repairs in decades.In the K East (Andheri East, Jogeshwari East) and N (Vidyavihar, Ghatkopar, Vikhroli) wards, 11 buildings each were classified under the C1 category. These central suburban zones are dotted with several pre-independence structures that now stand dangerously weakened.The upscale yet aging K West ward — home to areas like Versova, Seven Bungalows, and Juhu — was found to house 10 dangerously dilapidated buildings. Many of these structures, despite their premium real estate locations, have suffered from prolonged neglect.Further north, the R Central ward, which includes Borivali, Chikwadi, and Vajira Naka, had 8 buildings listed under the C1 classification. Meanwhile, P South (Goregaon, Aarey Colony) and H East (Bandra East, Khar) recorded 7 extremely unsafe buildings each. In some of the city's most densely populated and historically significant neighborhoods — Girgaon, Matunga, and Kurla, located in the D, G North, and L

wards — officials found 6 dangerously dilapidated buildings per ward.

How Buildings Are Classified According to civic engineers, a building's classification into categories C1, C2, or C3 depends on a detailed assessment of its structural integrity, including inspections of the RCC frame, columns, slabs, and overall stability.;C1: Requires immediate evacuation and demolition.;C2: Can be made safe through major structural repairs.; C3: Needs only minor repairs and is not immediately hazardous.

Some of the structures reviewed this year are more than 190 years old, while others are caught in limbo due to private redevelopment disputes or legal standstills involving tenants and owners.

BMC Action Underway Municipal authorities have already begun issuing eviction notices to residents of C1-classified buildings. If occupants fail to vacate, officials warn, legal measures will follow. Past experiences show that evacuation efforts are often slowed by resistance from residents, legal complications, or stalled redevelopment agreements.The BMC's initiative is part of a broader pre-monsoon preparedness strategy, aimed at minimising casualties from potential building collapses during heavy rainfall.

Why Has No Permanent DGP Been Appointed In Uttar Pradesh For 3 Years?

The Uttar Pradesh government has named senior IPS officer Rajeev Krishna as the new acting Director General of Police (DGP), replacing Prashant Kumar, whose term many expected to be extended. With this appointment, Krishna becomes the ninth DGP since 2017 and the fifth to hold the post in an acting capacity.The repeated appointment of acting DGPs has raised questions about the state's reluctance to follow the Supreme Court-mandated procedure for selecting a full-time top cop. The apex court, in its 2006 ruling in the Prakash Singh vs Union of India case, mandated that all states must forward a list of the three most senior eligible officers to the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), which would then recommend one name. The chosen officer would serve a fixed two-year term. However, the state has kept the top post firmly within the government's discretionary control since 2021.In 2024, the Yogi Adityanath government



introduced the Uttar Pradesh Police (Selection and Appointment to the Post of Director General of Police) Rules, a legislative move ostensibly designed to institutionalise the DGP selection process. The rules empowered the state government to make the appointment but did not fundamentally alter the lack of UPSC involvement for acting DGPs.While there were murmurs that then-acting DGP Prashant Kumar would be given a formal two-year term, the government ultimately refrained from doing so, again opting for a temporary appointment.With multiple elections looming including panchayat and urban body polls, and the crucial 2029 Lok Sabha elections, this temporary appointment has led to several

questions from the opposition. Several opposition leaders, including Samajwadi Party chief AkhileshYadav, have frequently accused the UP police of being skewed toward Thakur officers, an allegation aimed at highlighting caste imbalances under the Yogi Adityanath administration.

Why Rajeev Krishna? According to sources, 11 senior IPS officers were in contention for the top job this time, including one woman officer, raising hopes that UP might see its first-ever female DGP. However, Rajeev Krishna emerged as the government's pick — a choice driven, insiders say, by his reputation as a field-oriented, no-nonsense officer with a clean image and a track record of loyal service.Currently serving as acting DGP, Krishna is expected to remain in the post until March 2026. By that time, with several of his seniors due to retire, he may rise to fourth in the seniority list, making a case for a potential permanent appointment, depending upon the government's discretion.

Police action against Taal Bar and Restaurant; Crime against owner Arun Shetty

Mahatma PhuleChowk police have registered a case against the owner, cashier and six women under various sections of the Indian Penal Code after women were found wearing semi-nude clothes and staying outside the prescribed hours at Tal Bar and Restaurant in Rambagh, Kalyan West, Deputy Commissioner of Police AtulZende has informed. InKalyanDombivli, work is underway to directly file cases

against people violating the law, so there are fears of breaking the rules.

On the orders of Police Circle 03, when the Crime Detection Team went to inspect the Tal Bar and Restaurant within the limits of Mahatma Phule Police Station, it was found that the Tal Bar and Restaurant was open beyond the prescribed time till 01.40. Also, when 06 female singers were found dancing in



obscene gestures in the said place, they immediately made a panchnama in the presence of the panchnama in the e-saksh

app and a total of 23 accused, including the owner ArunShetty and cashier Lavkunsh Sharma, including the accused, were registered by the government and a complaint was registered against the accused at Mahatma Phule Police Station, G. Reg. No. 636/2025 under Section 296,54,3(5) of the Indian Penal Code. Also, a total of Rs. 28980/- was seized.Meanwhile, this action has shaken the spirits of bar owners who violate the rules.

Unseasonal rains have broken the backs of farmers, why the simplification of Panchnama?

Immediately provide assistance of Rs 50 thousand per hectare - Balasaheb Thorat

Maharashtra has been hit by pre-monsoon rains and it has been raining continuously for three weeks. Farmers have suffered huge losses in their crops. There is also a problem of fodder for their animals. Farmers, who were already in trouble, have been put in trouble again by unseasonal rains. Farmers are the backbone of the economy. The government should stand by them in this crisis and immediately provide assistance of Rs 50,000 per hectare , leaving aside the formalities of Panchnama, said Congress Working Committee member and senior leader BalasahebThorat.Speaking at a press conference at Gandhi Bhavan, BalasahebThorat further said that in May , when some crops were ready for harvesting , the rains washed away everything , causing extensive damage to bananas, saffron , mangoes. Vegetables , tomatoes , onions , and pomegranates have also been damaged. Houses have collapsed , livestock has been lost in some places , the rains have also created a problem of fodder for animals , roads have been damaged , and animal sheds have been damaged. On the other hand, when the preparations for Kharif were underway, the farmers now have no money , and the farmers are broke. But the government's mentality to help is not visible. Whether to help according to the criteria of NDRF or SDRF has nothing to do with the farmers , they should get substantial help. It is even more unfair that the government has changed the criteria of 3 hectares to 2 hectares. Even after changing the criteria of crop insurance, not much help is being provided. The government has ordered to conduct Panchnamas but in reality the administration is not seen working. The guardian minister should visit the district and take stock, but it doesn't seem to be happening. Today, onion costs Rs 60,000 per acre, while tomato costs Rs 50,000 per acre. Farming has become expensive. The government should provide substantial assistance to farmers in times of such crisis. During the election campaign, the BJP alliance leaders had announced loan waivers, but after coming to power, they seem to have forgotten about it. During the Congress alliance government and the MIA government, they continuously provided help to the farmers and waived off loans, but the

current government is not talking about loan waivers. There isimmense dissatisfaction among the farmers against the government. Instead of just making dry announcements, the government should announce loan waivers , said Thorat.The Agriculture Minister should speak sensitively. Speaking on the controversial statement of Agriculture Minister ManikraoKokate ,BalasahebThorat said that when farmers are in trouble, they need to be supported , we should not hurt them by making statements like we are their parents , we should act sensitively. The post of Agriculture Minister is important , I myself was the minister of this department , SharadPawar was the Union Agriculture Minister, but I don't know why Kokate thinks that he is the head of a desolate village. If the Ministry of Agriculture is the head of a desolate village, then he should tell which is the Horticulture Department ,Thorat also said. comeSatyajitTambe's statement is childish!While answering a question about Legislative Council MLA SatyajitTambe, BalasahebThorat said that we should be indebted to those who have done something for us. The Congress party has given us a lot. His words were childish , he still has a lot to learn and he should do some self-reflection, Thorat also said. The press conference was attended by Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee Vice President Administration and Organization Ganesh Patil , Mumbai Congress Working President and National Spokesperson Charanjit Singh Sapra , Pradesh Congress General Secretary Ramesh Shetty , Shrirang Barge and others.

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Ayodhya Ram Mandir: You Can Witness Ram Darbar Pran Pratishtha, But Not With These Passes

The Ram Temple in Ayodhya is once again in focus. After the consecration of Ram Lalla on January 22, 2024, the temple is now preparing for the installation of Rajaram on its first floor. A three-day PranPratishtha (consecration) ceremony will be held from June 3 to June 5.

Entry Restrictions

In view of the upcoming PranPratishtha, the Ram Mandir Trust has issued updated entry guidelines. On June 5, no special passes—including Vishisht and SugamDarshan passes—will be valid. Devotees will not be allowed entry into the temple premises that day.The installation of Ram Darbar will be led by Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath. The presence of VIPs and VVIPs has prompted these restrictions for crowd control and security purposes.

Rituals and Celebrations

The three-day ceremony will include consecration rituals not only for the Ram Darbar but also for smaller temples built along the temple's ramparts. Devotees unable to attend in person will be able to view the ceremonies online.

Preparations in Full Swing

Preparations for the PranPratishthaMahotsav are nearing completion. A group of 101 Vedic scholars from across India will lead the rituals. In the lead-up to the main event, a traditional KalashYatra will be carried out by women, starting from SaryuGhat and ending at the temple.

Darshan for General Public

Despite the upcoming consecration, general visitors will have to wait longer for darshan (viewing). Gold-plating of the temple spire is currently underway and is expected to be completed, along with the adornment of surrounding shrines, by the last week of July.

Formulate a robust monsoon contingency plan for crowded Metro stations. Directed Mumbai Suburban Guardian Minister Adv. Ashish Shelar

Mumbai,Suresh Dhere :

Authorities responsible for Mumbai Metro including the MMRDA must not only maintain seamless coordination among themselves but also ensure constant communication and coordination with the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC), instructed Mumbai Suburban Guardian Minister Adv. AshishShelar on Monday. He emphasized that instead of indulging in blame games, all the agencies must work as one united team.To ensure Mumbai is monsoon-ready, in his capacity as the Suburban Guardian Minister Adv. AshishShelar chaired a high-level review meeting at the MMRDA to assess city's readiness ahead of the monsoon. MMRDA Commissioner Sanjay Mukherjee, additional commissioners Vikram Kumar, Ashwin Mudgal, Aastikkumar Pandey, Maha Metro Director Rubal Agrawal and senior officials from the BMC and concerned departments were present for the meeting.A comprehensive presentation was made during the meeting outlining the monsoon



preparedness measures completed so far. Both MMRDA and Maha Metro have established dedicated emergency control rooms, with teams deployed round-the-clock to respond to any crisis. A pothole-filling system has been put in place for each project site, while 114 kilometres of road barricades have been cleared to ease traffic flow. Additionally, 19 ambulances have been strategically deployed and pumps installed at 107 key locations across the city.Minister Adv. AshishShelar directed officials to conduct thorough safety audits of

ongoing metro construction sites and to ensure uninterrupted Wi-Fi connectivity in underground metro stations. He further stressed the need for a robust contingency plan in case of emergencies or disruptions in metro services, particularly at high-footfall stations like Andheri and Ghatkopar. The plan must include coordination with the BMC and BEST to facilitate smooth passenger evacuation and provide immediate alternative transport options. After the Metro preparedness meeting, Minister Adv. AshishShelar chaired a

dedicated review session with officials from the State Health Department, BMC and the Directorate of Medical Education. The meeting focused on the current COVID-19 situation in Mumbai, including case trends and healthcare system readiness.While new cases are being reported, there is no cause for alarm. However, high-risk individuals, particularly those with diabetes, hypertension or serious underlying health conditions, are advised to wear masks and consider getting re-vaccinated as a precautionary measure. Minister Shelar assured that

coordination with central health agencies is ongoing, and that both the state health machinery and BMC are functioning as per the advisories issued by the Government of India.

Tesla 'Not Interested' In Manufacturing Cars In India, To Set Up Only Showrooms: Union Minister

New Delhi,(Agencies) :

Elon Musk-owned Tesla is not interested in manufacturing electric cars in India, said Union Heavy Industries Minister H D Kumaraswamy on Monday, as per news agency . He said the global EV giant is more interested only to start showrooms. However, he said Mercedes-Benz, Skoda-Volkswagen, Hyundai and Kia have shown interest in making EV cars in India."Tesla... They are more (interested) only to start showrooms. They are not interested to (start) manufacturing in India," Kumaraswamy told reporters here.He said this at a press conference to announce the unveiling of guidelines for the Scheme to Promote Manufacturing of Electric Cars in India. The company's representative was not part of the second and third round of the stakeholder deliberations," PTI cited an official as saying. Kumaraswamy said global automobile makers including Mercedes Benz, Skoda-Volkswagen, Hyundai and Kia have shown interest in manufacturing electric cars in India. These companies have



expressed interest during the stakeholder discussions between the government and the industry regarding the 'Scheme to Promote Manufacturing of Electric Passenger Cars in India', the detailed guidelines for which were unveiled by the minister.While the scheme was notified on March 15 last year, its guidelines were issued on Monday.US President Donald Trump has said that if Tesla were to build a factory in India to circumvent that country's tariffs, it would be "unfair" to the US.Tesla CEO billionaireElon Musk had said in April last year that his visit to India has been delayed due to the company's heavy obligations.Meanwhile, Elon Musk's father, Errol Musk, landed in India on Sunday to visit the Ayodhya Ram temple. During his visit to the country, Errol is also scheduled to attend various business-related meetings. Errol is on a five-day trip to India, starting from June 1 till June

6.Recently, US President Trump also warned iPhone maker Apple against manufacturing in India threatening with 25 per cent tariffs. On May 23, in a post on Truth Social, he said iPhones sold in the United States should be manufactured domestically or face a steep 25 per cent tariff if built in India or anyplace else.It came a week after a similar statement by the US president, warning Apple CEO Tim Cook against expanding Apple's manufacturing footprint in India, unless it is specifically to serve the Indian market.Apple sells over 60 million iPhones in the US annually with roughly 80% of them made in China currently.Last week, during a business event in Doha, Qatar, on May 15, Trump said he had a direct conversation with Apple CEO Tim Cook, advising him against expanding Apple's manufacturing footprint in India, unless it is specifically to serve the Indian market.

Tata Motors Final Dividend 2025: Tata Motors Limited (TML) has announced a final dividend of Rs 6 per equity share of Rs 2 each (300%) for the year ended March 31, 2025, along with its Q4 FY25 results. The Board of Directors has set Friday, June 20, 2025, as the date for the company's 80th Annual General Meeting (AGM).

Tata Motors Dividend 2025 Payment Date If approved at the AGM, the dividend will be paid to eligible shareholders on or before June 24, 2025.

Tata Motors Dividend History Tata Motors Limited has previously declared several dividends. They announced a special dividend of Rs 3 per equity share with an ex-date of June 11,2024.Prior to that, they declared a final dividend of Rs 3 per equity share for FY24 and a dividend of Rs 2 for FY24.

Tata Motors Demerger Shareholders of Tata Motors Limited approved the demerger plan, separating the company into two listed entities: commercial vehicles and passenger vehicles. The resolution for the Composite Scheme of Arrangement was passed with the required



majority, with 2,730,875,858 votes cast. Of these, 2,730,862,142 votes (99.9995%) were in favor, and 13,716 votes (0.0005%) were against. The share entitlement ratio will be 1:1, meaning shareholders will receive one share of TMLCV worth Rs 2 per share for every share of TML they hold.

Tata Motors Q4 Results Tata Motors Ltd reported a consolidated net profit of Rs 8,556 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2025, a significant 51.2% decline from Rs 17,528 crore in Q4 FY24. 24.The automaker's revenue growth remained flat at Rs 119,502 crore in Q4 FY25, compared to Rs 119,033 crore in Q4 FY24.

Tata Motors Share Price Target 2025

Brokerage opinions on Tata Motors are divided, with CLSA maintaining an "Outperform" rating and a price target of Rs 805, suggesting a potential upside of 14% from Wednesday's closing price. CLSA noted that while Jaguar Land Rover (JLR) remains cautious about demand in FY26 due to tariff concernsand macroeconomic challenges, the overall luxury passenger vehicle segment may not be significantly affected. Despite these headwinds, JLR is confident in achieving its FY26 EBIT margin guidance.In contrast, Jefferies has rated the stock "Underperform" with a price target of Rs 630, implying an 11% downside. The brokerage flagged multiple concerns, including U.S. tariffs,

intensifying competition in China, and rising customer acquisition costs. Additionally, a slowdown in the Indian commercial vehicle (CV) market and increasing competition in the electric passenger vehicle (PV) space are expected to weigh on performance. As a result, Jefferies has cut Tata Motors' FY26 and FY27 EBITDA estimates by 8% and 9%, respectively, while slightly raising its EPS forecasts by 3-4%.Citi has suspended its rating on the stock but highlighted that while Tata Motors' management remains optimistic about the India CV business, the PV segment—especially electric vehicles—may face near-term challenges .K o t a k Institutional Equities has downgraded Tata Motors to "Sell" from "Reduce" and assigned a price target of Rs 600, indicating a potential 15% downside. It echoed concerns about JLR's exposure to weak demand in China and tariff risks in the U.S., despite the unit turning net cash positive in FY25. Kotak also flagged market share losses in both the CV and PV segments in India as key risks. It has cut its consolidated EBITDA estimates for Tata Motors by 4-10% over FY25-FY27.

Sensex Today: Domestic stock markets staged a sharp intraday rebound to end Monday's session only mildly lower. The BSE Sensex closed at 81,374, down by 77 points or 0.09%, after recovering 719 points from its intraday low of 80,654. The NSE Nifty50 settled at 24,717, shedding 34 points or 0.14%, but well off the day's low of 24,526.Early in the session, sentiment was dampened by US President Donald Trump's announcement of fresh tariffs on steel imports, raising the rate to 50% from 25% effective June 4. Renewed tensions between Russia and Ukraine, India's rising Covid-19 cases, FIIL volatility, and nervousness ahead of the Reserve Bank of



India's monetary policy meeting also weighed on the market.However, buying interest in select stocks including Adani Ports, M&M, Eternal (Zomato), PowerGrid, HUL, Bajaj Finserv, ITC, ICICI Bank, Asian Paints, and Nestle India helped the benchmarks recoup most of their losses. These stocks gained between 0.4% and 2%. Broader markets outperformed, with the Nifty MidCap and Nifty SmallCap indices rising 0.62% and 1.1%, respectively.Sectorally, the Nifty IT and Nifty

Metal indices were the worst performers, each down 0.7% on Trump's tariff threats. In contrast, the Nifty Realty and Nifty PSU Bank indices rallied over 2% each. Global Cues Asian markets opened mixed after US President Donald Trump announced a steep hike in steel import tariffs. Addressing steelworkers in Pennsylvania late Friday, Trump said tariffs on steel imports would double to 50% starting Wednesday, aiming to bolster the US steel industry. He confirmed

the June 4 implementation date via a Truth Social post. Following the news, Japan's Nikkei index declined 1.21%, while the Topix slipped 0.83%. Australia's ASX200 dipped 0.1%. However, South Korea's Kospi bucked the trend and was up 0.3%.Markets in China, Malaysia, and New Zealand were closed for public holidays. Meanwhile, US stock futures edged lower ahead of the June kickoff. Futures on the S&P 500 and Nasdaq-100 were down 0.3%, while Dow Jones futures dropped 0.3%.On Friday, Wall Street ended mixed. The S&P 500 closed marginally lower, down 0.01%, while the Nasdaq shed 0.32%. The Dow Jones Industrial Average gained 0.13%.

fourth quarter ended March 31, 2025 (Q4 FY25). Its revenue from operations for January-March 2025 increased by 5.29 percent to Rs 64,479 crore, compared with Rs 61,237 crore a year ago.

TCS Dividend History In the last fiscal year, the IT giant announced three interim dividends of Rs 10 each (in January 2025, October 2024, and July 2024) and a special dividend of Rs 66 (in January 2025) for its investors. The company

had a dividend yield of 4% in the last 12 months, with a total payout of Rs 124 during the same period, according to a report from Axis Securities.

TCS Share Price Target 2025

Nomura has maintained its "neutral" rating on TCS but reduced its price target to Rs 3,490 from Rs 3,890 earlier. Established in 1900 If its rare to see a Lord Krishna (Narayan) temple without Radha in it, its because it has Arjun (Nar)standing by him. You have seen Amar Chitra Katha pictorials of the Mahabharata show LordKrishna talking to Arjun during the battle, but to see a temple that's dedicated to that period of timeand that too in the very busy lanes of Kalbadevi in Mumbai is definitely worth a darshan.

UNIQUENESS
The Nar - Narayan Temple is a unique breakaway from the traditional Krishna temples that dotMumbai. In fact just one of the few temples in India which are of its kind.Built by well known philanthropist Sheth Motichand Rugnath in the late 19th century, the temple issurrounded by a large courtyard, marriage hall, 2 multi-storey buildings for visiting pilgrims (nowpermanent residents,) and a resident holy cow. The temple is a safe and calm heaven in the midst ofKalbadevi chaos.Built at that time, for a princely sum of Rs 1 lakh, today it is run by the Shethna family (greatgrandson of the founder) under the ShethKahandasNarandas Charities Trust. The temple generatesits funds for maintenance from tenant rents and some donations.The Shethna family follows philanthropic traditions even today, and yet continuously evolve to breakaway from age old customs. Several years back, the trustees agreed with PanditMadan MohanMalviya to throw open the temple to untouchables for darshan. This was a bold and courageousstep.

HISTORY & ARCHITECTURE OF THE TEMPLE

This temple was built 115 years ago by MotiRugandas as per the last wishes of his father KahandasNaraindas on whom it is named. These are pictures of the ankutardarshan which takes place everyyear around Diwall the ceiling has original carvings century old, depicting the 10 avatars of Vishnu and the story of Krishna from birth to the raaseela etc. There is a gaushala with the cow-calf from the original lineage of Gir and supposedly descendent ofKamadhenu. The temple celebrates the annual Path utsav with great pomp every year and invites notablespeakers and artists to perform.The fervour of the aarti and the tranquil and quite atmosphere like a tirthsthaan in the heart ofcrowded mumbai is amazing.Once you are inside the compound you blank out the sounds of kalbadevi and sit near the famouskadamb tree or feed the innumerable pigeons or play with the cows and then attend evening bhajansand aarti, your life has been transformed already.The temple was run totally on the funds of the family, over the years donors came by with welcomegifts of Palnas and silver toys and clothes for the Lord and sponsors for the cow feeds unasked.The mandir performs the most sincere and pious gaudaanpoojas, therajaibhog and delicious prasad is another well kept recipe since 115 years passed down bygenerations of poojaris. The architecture of the temple is unique based on the lines of the original haveli of our LordNarayan and the huge compound is used for yagnas and havans to public. There is wedding hallattached to the temple where programs and blood donation drive are organized.The ceiling of the temple depicts the Bhagvad Gita with intricately carved figures of krishnaleela.There are pillars on either side of the temple have beautiful and intricate carving.

IMPORTANCE AND BENIFITS OF A GAUSHALA IN A TEMPLE: GAUSHALAS ARE PROTECTIVE SHELTERS FOR COWS IN INDIA.

In India, most of the Vaishnava temples have their own Gaushala. The unadulterated milk supplied these



cows is used for the worship of the Lord. The Vedas, Saints and Sadhus, and Lord Krishnahimself proclaim that service and protection of Mother Cow is the greatest solution for mankind'suffering, the path to real peace.Cows are sacred. Chaan and Gau-mutra havingits own energy can drive away any atrocities, and restoring to purity.The milk of a cow is to promote sattvik (purifying) qualities.The ghee (clarified butter) from the cow's milk is used in ceremonies, and in preparing religious food.Cow dung, is used as fertilizer, as a fuel and as a disinfectant in homes. Modern scienceacknowledges that the smoke from cow dung is a powerful disinfectant and an anti-pollutant.Its urine is also used for religious rituals as well as medicinal purposes. The supreme purificatorymaterial, panchagavya, is a mixture of five products of the cow, namely milk, curds, ghee, urine anddung. Nar Narayan Mandir, Gaushala is in the compound premises.

Jaswant Singh Opposed the Use of IAF in Kargil War. Here’s why

The two interviews by Chief of Defence Staff General Anil Chauhan in Singapore, where he accepted the loss of an unspecified number of fighter jets by the Indian Air Force (IAF) on the first night of Operation Sindoor, has once again raised questions about the use of IAF against Pakistani targets.This issue had raised its head even in 1999, during the Kargil War, when the Indian armed forces evicted Pakistani intruders who had crossed the Line of Control and occupied Indian territory. Delivering the Air Chief Marshal L.M. Katre Memorial Lecture on September 9, 2017 at Bangalore, Air Chief Marshal B.S. Dhanoa, then Chief of the Air Staff, had mentioned that in “a cabinet level meeting on May 18, the then foreign minister Jaswant Singh was instrumental in denying permission to use air power in the conflict for fear of escalation”. The approval for the use of IAF was granted by the CCS on May 24-25, 1999, when Jaswant Singh was travelling abroad.Air Chief Marshal A.Y. Tipnis recounted to the Force magazine that:“EAM went on to observe that bringing in the air force would internationalise the issue and it would be preferable not to let that happen. He was scheduled to leave for international visits, these he felt should not be disturbed. While he was away, Army Headquarters could get on with the job of establishing [the] enemy’s intent. His recommendation: do not involve the Air Force yet.” In his memoirs A Call to Honour: In Service of Emergent India, Singh provided a more detailed explanation:“It was my view that the use of the Air Force at this point was not good policy. My reservations were born of two or three principal considerations. Should the adversary be determined to escalate the conflict, as all his early actions demonstrated, then we ought to be prepared for air casualties. The difficulty with air casualties, as against casualties on land, is principally of imagery. The sheer optical value of the Air Force is so much greater, particularly in a limited and contained conflict. That is why the loss of an aircraft becomes so instantly an issue that catches the public eye, as compared to the loss of even a platoon of infantry.”He goes on to provide another reason for his view, which was more specific to the terrain and operational environment of Kargil, where the IAF was to be deployed:“To ask our Air Force to undertake these missions and within such narrow, tight confines bound by the LOC was to send it on virtual suicide missions. And there was no way that the political leadership would permit cross-LOC operations. As such, there were but two routes for the Air Force to operate on, and both were extremely narrow funnels... Thereafter the fact of the LOC not being a visibly marked line on the ground compounded difficulties. High speed aircraft even at low altitude, or even helicopters chugging along peaks, would have difficulty in determining where exactly the LOC was. A minuscule mistake of a few seconds could convert into several nautical miles of flying. Some years later, it was precisely such a mistake that cost the Indian Air Force one of its most promising officers.”Singh’s initial reluctance to deploy the IAF during the 1999 Kargil War remains significant in contemporary strategic discussions, primarily for the sheer optics of losses suffered by the air force in the public mind. It serves as a reminder that early political caution and thoughtful employment of air power may prevent unintended escalation and internationalisation of a bilateral issue between India and Pakistan.

An Open Letter: ‘I Have Small Eyes, Mr Prime Minister’

Dear Mr Prime Minister,

I saw a video from a public speech delivered by you in your home state of Gujarat on Tuesday, May 27. To say the least, I, as a person from Northeast India, am still numb at your references to “small eyes” and with “eyes that don’t even open”.Before I come to why, let me take this opportunity to convey to you that far from Gujarat, in my family home in Assam, ever since my school days, I have seen a sizeable photo of a certain Gujarati hanging on a wall of the drawing room. Every godhuli (dusk), an incense stick is stuck on to the photo frame by my father, just after he finishes the same ritual on all the frames containing various gods and goddesses hung across the house, while reciting his evening mantras. I am proud to say here, that the Gujarati prayed in my family is none other than the Mahatma – Mahatma Gandhi.My father, now 93, still continues the daily ritual. He also never forgets to tell any first-time visitor with a tinge of pride that the Mahatma, during his maiden trip to Assam in 1921, had also paid a short visit to his now over-a-century-old family house. My grandfather was one of the first in that Upper Assam town to have signed up for a Congress membership at the call of the Mahatma then to fight the foreign powers, and yes, to refuse foreign goods too. Prime Minister, I am sure you are aware of the great Naga freedom fighter Rani Gaidinliu. When there was no advocate to fight the case mounted against her by the British, my grandfather had traveled a challenging path all the way to the Rangoon high court with a set of fellow Nagas to fight for her release from jail. In a country under foreign powers then, it was no surprise that the advocate was also jailed along with Gaidinliu, a young accused then who had the gumption to stand up to the colonial powers for converting fellow Nagas to Christianity from their religion, Heraka. That fight, by the way, had made our first prime minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru bestow on Gaidinliu the prefix to her name, Rani (queen), as we know her today, and call her a freedom fighter. These references, particularly to the Father of the Nation, are only to underline that the connections that we form with powerful leaders and change-makers who may belong to another region or community, just keeps alive the unity and solidarity of the people of this huge country that we are all part of, and so proud of. Tiny, daily rituals carried out in houses like mine also acknowledge that we may know little about a region that the leader or change-maker comes from or their people, but, as the constitution says, we are the same people – no matter how large or small the size of our eyes are (irrespective of race and creed, remember?). Prime Minister, like several from the

Northeast, I too have lived on those lines. I happened to choose a partner from outside the region. I never looked at the size of his eyes, and I am sure, he didn’t either. Let me tell you, what we saw in each other’s eyes was the same – love and respect. In your May 27 speech, even if you had made an indirect reference to the Chinese when you had referred to Ganesha with “small eyes” and “eyes that don’t even open”, the remark cannot be overlooked. It cannot be not seen to apply to “small-eyed” Indians like me, those who come from the region I call home.Prime Minister, even in the national capital, many from the Northeast (that includes me too) face racism and discrimination on the streets almost every day. Often in central Delhi, I am stopped by random strangers while walking, to ask in English which country I belong to – whether I am looking for a currency exchange booth, a cheaper hotel room, or a taxi for sightseeing.For those who may ask, ‘What clothes were you wearing then’ – well, no ‘Indian’ dress has been able to help me ward off such casual street racism in Delhi yet. I am sure this must be the case in various other cities.Also, I speak for many northeastern women living in mainland cities when I say that I almost never step out of my house without using kajal on my eyes, just because we don’t want to be on the streets with “small eyes”; eyes that are seen by others as “barely open”.Sir, I am not sure if you are aware, it is also well documented in the report of the Bezbaruah Committee, set up by the Union government after the tragic death of an Arunachali youth, Nido Tania, in Delhi’s Lajpat Nagar, that the racist terms used on people from the Northeast in big cities includes words like ‘chinky’ and ‘Chinese’. “Small eyes” too is a term used for us. At times, no words are needed but finger tips are used to press the corners of the attacker’s eyes to send us the message that we have “small eyes” and “eyes that barely open” – the same gesture you used in your speech. And exactly like that China-made Ganesha idol you had referred to in your speech. Prime Minister, it is also well documented that during the COVID-19 pandemic, many from my region were thrown out of stores and rented accommodations, some even attacked physically and spat at, just because they looked ‘Chinese’ and the epidemic had stemmed from China.In such a dark reality, if you, as the prime minister, lampoon “small eyes” publicly, in our eyes, you are seen backing those nameless people in many mainland cities who call us “Chinky” and “Chinese”.Anyway, it doesn’t behove the stature of an Indian prime minister to deploy such racist language about any community or set of people, whether Indian or not. What I understood also from your speech is that India’s contest is economic and versus China, and rightly so. In such a fight, there



should be no space for the size of the eyes. Like it didn’t matter in diplomacy, when you set your big eyes on the “small-eyed” Chinese premier Xi Jinping while sitting on a swing and chuckling together by the Sabarmati some years ago. Prime Minister, let me remind you here, that even in your own cabinet, there are ministers with ‘small eyes’. I am referring to SarbanandaSonowal and KirenRijiju. In 2018, when your government, reportedly due to Chinese insistence, kept Rijiju out of an official function in New Delhi, many in my region were upset and sad that New Delhi didn’t stand up to the Chinese pressure. Arunachal Pradesh, Rijiju’s home state, is an Indian state, and shall remain so. Also, doesn’t at least one of your important cabinet ministers, who is in the CCS, have a partner whose eyes are “small” due to her race? Personal preferences aside, racist outbursts by the country’s top leader should have no space in a public speech in today’s day and time; they are bad for both domestic and international optics. Remember how US president Donald Trump was chided by the world for having questioned the attire of Ukrainian president Zelenskyy. Prime Minister, here is something about Lord Ganesha having “small eyes”.The fact is that Ganesha is also a Buddhist deity, revered across South-East and East Asia – where people have “small eyes”. Even in several Indian monasteries, say, Alchi, said to be the oldest monastery in Ladakh, Ganesha exists in miniature paintings on its walls – and yes, with small eyes! The Vinayaka or the Ganapati cult within various sects of Buddhism exists beyond India, across the South and South-East Asia’s geography. Finding a Ganesha sculpture in a museum, therefore, in these countries where Buddhism has been a strong religious influence, is not a rarity. By the way, Ganesha is the only Hindu god regarded as Bodhisatva. Even in China, there have been Ganapati rituals. French Buddhism expert Robert Duquenne in his note, ‘Ganapathi Rituals in Chinese’, had pointed out that “Not less than twelve texts in the Chinese Buddhist Canon are dedicated to Vinayaka or Ganapati.” The author had noted, “The alternative and more usual name Ganesa never occurs here.” Here, let me also inform you that some of our goddesses may in all likelihood have “small eyes”. Assam’s revered goddess Kesaikhati is a tribal goddess. We don’t often draw Ma Kamakhya, but as per new research, she too might have a tribal (Khasi) origin. In Assam, we also celebrate the annual arrival of the monsoons, no less than that of a goddess. We

call her Bordoisila. Every monsoon, we keep out a small mirror, a bottle of hair oil and a comb, for her to look at; the belief is, the rains are strong because she is rushing home to see her mother. Since the name Bordoisila has been drawn from the Bodo community, of TibetoBurman origin, that goddess also, racially speaking, should have “small eyes”. Prime Minister, I fully agree with you that a country which is aspiring to become a developed nation by 2047, must start its self-sufficiency journey on a war footing. You had implied China in your speech and I agree that we must stay away from using not just cheaper Chinese goods like Diwali lights and Holi colours and Lakshmi and Ganesha idols, but also all foreign goods that have a decent equivalent which is Made in India.This country had seen a time when people had booked their HMT watches and waited for months for them to be delivered; same with India-made cars and scooters. But should that journey not start with you? Like it did with Gandhi when he gave a call to quit using foreign goods?Therefore, if you still wear that Movado watch, that pair of Maybach sunglasses, that Mont Blanc pen, etc., which several media reports speak of regularly, please replace them with Made in India equivalents. Show the path. And that western hat you wore while visiting a wildlife park? I have a suggestion for its replacement too. In the Northeast, each community has its own hat; you can truly promote indigenous traditions and Made in India products if you choose to replace that cowboy-like hat with one from my region. The choices are too many, I promise. Before I end, I must also say why I took the liberty to write an open letter to you. This is in keeping with my understanding of what you often say, India is not just the world’s largest democracy but the mother of all democracies. In such a democracy, a common citizen must then have the right to question her elected Prime Minister. So have I here, just as a common citizen who comes from the Northeast. I have questioned you about a sensitivity that you clearly overlooked in your May 27 public speech, and as a “small eyed” Indian, I am offended. I hope you ponder over it and course correct, because India’s prime minister must not be seen just talking about the need for fellow Indians to treat people from the Northeast without discrimination; but must be seen doing so too, both in his words and deeds so that he becomes an example for others to emulate.

The Grand Tamasha of Jammu and Kashmir Politics

In Kashmiri, there is a famous saying, “Nav Kath NavanDohun” – a new debate lasts for only nine days. It means people have a short memory and forget anything that may prima facie look very important. The same is true for Kashmiri politicians.Be it Mehbooba Mufti or Farooq Abdullah or anyone else from the mainstream camp, they hardly miss an opportunity to grab dividends for themselves from the miseries and tragedies of commoners. From Article 370 to Pahalgam attack

People had great expectations from Mehbooba and Farooq Abdullah after the reading down of Article 370, when separatists were ‘silenced’. The field was open for mainstream parties to not only fill the vacuum but also prove that they were not traitors or agents for anyone else but only Kashmiris.After their release from the preventive detention in 2019, they launched Gupkar Alliance. It is now an established fact that they were only bailing out New Delhi by creating false hopes about fighting for the legitimate rights of people of Jammu and Kashmir. Once New Delhi strengthened its narrative and consolidated its position on ground, the constituents’ of Gupkar alliance went back to their original dens. New Delhi kept them alive as long as it served New Delhi’s interests: they needed for these leaders to counter each other to show the world that Kashmiris enjoyed democracy and right to expression just like the rest of the country enjoyed.It is pretty clear had the Gupkar Declaration been intact who would have opposed or fought whom, especially in Kashmir valley and Muslim-dominated areas of Jammu region. Be it Mehbooba Mufti or Omar Abdullah or Sajad Lone or anyone else, they all started parting ways when parliamentary elections were announced in 2024, as now their fighting each other suited not only ruling BhartiyaJanata Party in Delhi, but also their own vicious ambitions. However, amid their allegations and counter allegations, Kashmiris lost their voice and New Delhi got a cover to continue its constitutional onslaughts and alleged human rights abuses against Kashmiris post the abrogation of Article 370. The worst of it was displayed last month, when the Pahalgam massacre happened on April and India and Pakistan were allegedly on the brink of a nuclear war. While the entire world was worried, unfortunately, the NC leadership was trying every trick and gesture to please New Delhi. Farooq Abdullah even went to the extent to make the claim that Pahalgam massacre would not have taken place without some local support, despite knowing that like New Delhi’s proxies were dependant and helpless before New Delhi’s aggression, same was the case with Pakistani proxies in Kashmir.His statement yielded nothing except encouraging security agencies to further tighten the noose on Kashmiris. Meanwhile, not even the death and destruction in border areas and the four-day military confrontation between India and Pakistan

could stop Muftis and Abdullahs from fighting each other. At a time when Kashmiris needed to come together to tell the world that they were the main stakeholders but also collectively, the real victims of the animosity between two countries, these leaders of the union territory engaged in their own war-of-words rather than highlighting plight of their people. At the same time, the few legitimate voices in Kashmir were silenced through jails. These mainstream Kashmiri leaders don’t fight for their rights or political ideology on streets, through peaceful protests or hunger strikes, or even through diplomacy – they only protest on social media platforms. The latest sparring between Omar Abdullah and Mehbooba Mufti started with Abdullah’s post on X regarding Tulbul Navigation project, which is in abeyance since the nineties, ever since Pakistan objected to it citing terms of the Indus Waters Treaty (IWT).Abdullah praised the decision to keep IWT in abeyance, saying he wondered if the work could be resumed on the Tulbul navigation barrage project in Wular Lake, after the suspension of IWT. Mufti reacted to Omar’s post and said, “At a time when both countries have stepped back from the blink of a full-fledged war, with J&K bearing the brunt through the loss of innocent lives, widespread destruction & immense suffering, such statements are not only irresponsible but also dangerously provocative. Our people deserve peace as much as anyone else in the country.” “Weaponizing something as essential & life-giving as water is not only inhuman, it also risks internationalising what should remain a bilateral matter,” she said. Then, Abdullah reacted with another post: “What is unfortunate is that your blind lust to try to score cheap publicity points and please some people sitting across the border, you refused to acknowledge that the IWT has been one of the biggest historic betrayals of the interests of the people of J&K. I have always opposed this treaty & I will continue to do so. Opposing a blatantly unfair treaty is in no way, Shape, size or form warmongering. It is about correcting a historic injustice that denied the people of J&K the right to use our water for ourselves”.Mufti, too, had no option but to react again and said, “Time will reveal who seeks to appease whom. However it is worth recalling that your esteemed grandfather ShiekhShb once advocated for accession to Pakistan for over two decades after losing power. But post being reinstated as CM, he suddenly reversed his stance by aligning with India.”Umar responded: “Taking cheap shots at a person you yourself have called Kashmiris tallest leader. I will rise above the gutter you want to take this conversation to by keeping the late Mufti shb and North pole South pole out of this. You keep advocating the interests of anyone you want to and i will be advocating for the interest of people of J&k to our use our own rivers for our own benefit. I am not going to stop the water, just use more of it for ourselves. Now I think I will do some real work & you keep posting.”

Series of betrayals

Being the chief minister of J&K, Omar Abdullah is well within his rights to perform his constitutional duty when he talks about the Tulbul barrage project. He is also 100% correct in claiming that J&K suffered because of IWT. However, he loses the moral ground on the subject because had IWT been truly so significant for him, he could have at least included it in the manifesto



of his party – that never happened. He also needs to be reminded that giving waters of three rivers to Pakistan was a part of an international agreement by virtue of which India retains the water of other rivers. What he has said about IWT may be true, but the timing only proves that he is saying it to remain in the good books of Modi and his team. He is right in calling the IWT a historic betrayal, but should he not answer why he talks about only this historic blunder. Has he has forgotten he sought votes on fighting for restoration of Article 370? Once elected, he surrendered the topic even before taking oath and went on to say he will not be seeking its restoration in Modi’s regime. He is right to call IWT a betrayal to people of J&K but 100% wrong when he calls it the “biggest betrayal”. The biggest betrayal to people of J&K was when his grandfather joined hands with the Maharaja Hari Singh to sign Instrument of accession with India without clarity in his own vision in 1947. It was ShiekhAbdullah who joined hands with the Maharaja, whom he once called autocratic ruler, to handover J&K to Nehru on a plate. He complicated the issue further by not allowing J&K to merge with India nor was able to include the autonomy in the preamble to the Constitution of India. In fact, the biggest betrayal was when Shiekhshahab agreed to become the administrator and work under teenager Karan Singh. The biggest betrayal was when Shiekhshahab converted Muslim Conference – a party he founded – into the National Conference. The biggest betrayal was when Shiekhshahab – on being thrown out of power on August 8, 1953 – started plebisite movement and sought implementation of UN resolutions, but 22 years later called his entire movement as political wilderness. The biggest betrayal was when Shiekhshahab agreed to become the chief minister of J&K in 1975 with the support of Congress MLAs whom he otherwise called ‘gutter worms’ and asked people to socially boycott them. The biggest betrayal, in fact, was when Farooqsahab, against the wishes of Kashmiris, contested the 1996 elections without even getting the pity autonomy restored. The biggest betrayal was when Farooqsahab became part of the team of Indian politicians at UN and other forums to give cover to grave human rights abuses in J&K in the mid nineties; and when he visited Pakistan and was seen waving gun along with JKLF leaders, but only to blackmail New Delhi. The biggest betrayal was when the father and the son duo, Farooq and Omar Abdullah, cried in every public meeting that Engineer Rashid was a BJP proxy because they could not swallow Omar’s defeat in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. The biggest betrayal was when Omar Abdullah praised Modi and claimed that weather was so clear in Srinagar, to say that even God approved what Modi did. The list of

betrayals NC has made is unending and every betrayal is bigger than the previous one. It was Farooqsahab who claimed that he would like to seek help from even China in getting article 370 restored, but now is playing in the arms of Modi only to remain in power and avoid New Delhi’s wrath. Many untold betrayals can be found in Dulatsahab’s – A.S. Dulat, former secretary of R&AW – latest book The Chief Minister And The Spy. Mehbooba Mufti too needs to not forget that she and her father, Mufti Mohammad Sayeed, have taken birth from the Congress, the party which is responsible for all the betrayals and cheatings with Kashmiris. Should she not answer that why her father chose to be a part and parcel of all the oppressions which Congress carried out against Kashmiris, from eroding the special status to snatching away everything we had?It was Congress that divided Pakistan into two and now Mehbooba has suddenly become a peace preacher. celebrations in the European nation following PSG's continental crown. "Nothing can justify what has happened in the last few hours, the violent clashes are

unacceptable," the French leader said. "We will pursue, we will punish, we will be relentless," the 47-year-old continued. "The violent clashes that took place are unacceptable and have come at a heavy cost: two people are dead, around 30 police officers and several firefighters have been injured," Macron said. "My thoughts are also with the police officer in Coutances who is currently in a coma," he added. "These isolated acts are contrary to the club's values and in no way represent the vast majority of our supporters, whose exemplary behaviour throughout the season deserves to be commended," the club said on Sunday.

Carlsen's Reaction Viral After Losing To Gukesh, Fans Say: 'Never Seen Such...'

World Champion D Gukesh secured a stunning victory against Magnus Carlsen in Round 6 of the Norway Chess 2025 tournament, recovering from a losing position on Sunday. This win marks Gukesh's first classical victory over the Norwegian grandmaster. The 19-year-old also became the second Indian player to defeat Carlsen in the tournament's history, following Rameshbabu Praggnanandhaa. Carlsen dominated the match for a significant period, but ultimately faltered under pressure, allowing Gukesh to capitalise and secure the win. After the loss, a visibly frustrated Carlsen reacted by slamming the chessboard and swiftly exiting the arena. In contrast, Gukesh quietly



celebrated his career-defining win with his coach, Grzegorz Gajewski. Fans on social media did not like Carlsen's reaction and lauded Gukesh for his. This victory propelled Gukesh



to third place in the Norway Chess 2025 standings with 8.5 points, just one point behind Carlsen and American Fabiano Caruana. Previously, on 27 May, the highly

anticipated Round One clash at Norway Chess 2025 delivered a thrilling spectacle. Carlsen executed a classic king hunt to defeat reigning World Champion Gukesh in

their first classical encounter since Gukesh claimed the world title. This match also marked Carlsen's return to individual classical chess after almost a year. Following the upset, Grandmaster Vishnu Prasanna, commended the teenager's tenacity and resilience. "We have to give a lot of credit to Gukesh for his stubbornness and resourcefulness because I think he was aware that he was dead lost for so long. Yet, he kept fighting, and as the time went lower, he had more chances to do something with the position. I don't think his intention was to win that, but I'm sure he is happy," Vishnu Prasanna stated. This victory intensifies the competition in the tournament's final rounds, making the race for the top spot even closer.

How Russia's Iskander, Which Outsmarted US Patriot In Ukraine, Compares To Brah Mos

Moscow,(Agencies) :
India's BrahMos is a supersonic cruise missile developed jointly with Russia, while the Iskander is a tactical ballistic missile with different design and operational roles. In the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict, Russia's recent use of Iskander missiles has drawn international attention after they reportedly bypassed the US-made Patriot defence system and struck their targets with precision. Reports indicate that the missile strikes came in retaliation to a Ukrainian drone attack and have raised fresh concerns in the United States over the evolving capabilities of Russian weaponry. According to defence experts, the Patriot defence system is comparable to the Russian-made S-400, which is currently in use by India. In the latest strike, Russia claims to have destroyed Ukrainian drone launchers. The Russian Iskander missile, officially known as the 9K720 Iskander, is a highly advanced tactical ballistic missile system designed for short-to medium-range precision strikes. With a speed of 6 to 7 Mach and an accuracy of 5 to 7 meters, it falls under the hypersonic class of missiles. The Iskander has a range of 500 to 1,000 kilometers and was inducted into the Russian military in 2006. The Iskander system uses ground-to-ground missiles capable of carrying both conventional and nuclear warheads. Its most advanced variant, the Iskander-M, is specifically designed to meet the demands of modern warfare. With a range of 50 to 500 kilometers, it can effectively target military bases, command centers and air defense systems. Its key strengths lie in its mobility, precision and radar-evading capabilities. Deployed on a mobile launcher, the system is easy to relocate and can be rapidly deployed across different terrains. How Strong Is The Iskander? The Iskander missile system is renowned for its speed, precision, and radar-evading capabilities. The system follows a quasi-ballistic trajectory, allowing the missile to perform unpredictable maneuvers mid-flight, which makes interception extremely difficult. The



advanced Iskander-M variant further enhances its survivability by deploying radar decoys that confuse enemy air defense systems.

Did The Iskander Break Through US Patriot Defence System?

During the ongoing Ukraine conflict, Russia claimed that its Iskander-M missile effectively challenged the US-made Patriot air defence system (MIM-104 Patriot). In May 2025, Ukrainian Air Force spokesperson Yuri Ihnat acknowledged that the Iskander-M possesses several advanced features—such as radar decoys and a quasi-ballistic trajectory—that make it a difficult target for the Patriot system. The decoys are designed to mislead radar tracking, while the missile's unpredictable flight path complicates the software-based interception calculations of the Patriot.

Comparison With BrahMos
India's BrahMos missile system is a supersonic cruise missile developed through a joint venture between India and Russia, whereas the Iskander is a tactical ballistic missile. While both are advanced and powerful in their respective categories, they differ significantly in design, function, and purpose. They can be compared on the following key parameters:

Speed And Trajectory: BrahMos flies at a speed of 2.8 to 3.0 Mach, classifying it as a supersonic missile, while the Iskander reaches hypersonic speeds of 6 to 7 Mach. BrahMos follows a low-altitude, sea-skimming or straight flight path. In contrast, the Iskander follows a quasi-ballistic trajectory.

Range: BrahMos has a range of 290 to 800 km, with extended-range variants like the BrahMos-ER offering greater reach. The Iskander has a more limited range of

up to 500 km, but its hypersonic speed enables it to strike targets with exceptional speed.

Target And Use: BrahMos is primarily designed for precision strikes against ships and land-based targets. It is a versatile missile that can be launched from land, sea, air and submarines. The Iskander, on the other hand, is a tactical ballistic missile intended mainly for destroying high-value military targets and air defense systems.

Radar Evasion: BrahMos features a low radar cross-section (RCS) and incorporates stealth technology to help it evade enemy radar detection. In contrast, the Iskander relies on radar decoys and unpredictable flight maneuvers.

Use In War: BrahMos was recently deployed in the military conflict between India and Pakistan, demonstrating its effectiveness by penetrating Pakistan's HQ-9B air defense system. The Iskander has also challenged the US-made Patriot system in Ukraine, though complete details about its impact remain unclear. Overall, the Iskander missile system symbolises Russia's strategic strength, renowned for its hypersonic speed, precision, and radar-evasion capabilities. While it has exposed limitations in the Patriot system during the Ukraine conflict, claims of completely defeating it remain controversial. In contrast, the BrahMos stands as a prime example of India's supersonic cruise missile technology, celebrated for its versatility and accuracy.



Movie-Review:

From Metropolis (1927) to Taxi Driver (1976) and Salaam Bombay! (1988) to Gully Boy (2019), cities on screen have long fascinated us - mirroring, distorting and reimagining urban life. Scholars such as Raymond Williams and David B. Clarke have shown how literature and film shape our understanding of cities, often revealing the tension between community and alienation, modernity and nostalgia. Thinkers like Marcus Doel and Henri Lefebvre remind us that cities are not just concrete and commerce. They are lived, felt and socially constructed.Few cities have inspired this dual gaze in films more than Tokyo. In Studio Ghibli's Whisper of the Heart (1995) and Only Yesterday (1991), Tokyo becomes a character in its own right; it can be both grounding and disorienting, echoing George Simmel's vision of the urban space as a site of both creativity and quiet estrangement.Studio Ghibli, founded in 1985 by Hayao Miyazaki, Isao Takahata and Toshio Suzuki, has become synonymous with animation excellence. Their movies have critiqued Japan's rapid urban growth, showcasing the delicate harmony between human development and nature's grandeur. In an era of AI-generated imitation, the Studio's artistry, once quietly revered, now stands at the centre of a broader conversation about what makes art truly human. Yoshifumi Kondō's Whisper of the Heart presents Tokyo as a place of inspiration and dreams. It follows 14-year-old Shizuku as she wanders through the bustling city with a sense of wonder, finding creative inspiration in its vibrant neighbourhoods and the people she meets. Her journey through Tokyo's suburban landscapes, antique shops and libraries highlights the city's potential to nurture creativity and personal growth.The film uses a warm and bright colour palette for the city - yellows, oranges, reds and

homes to life. The film's music, including its use of 'Country Roads', is upbeat and melodic, reflecting Shizuku's youthful enthusiasm and the lively city atmosphere. The animation is detailed and realistic, with smooth movements, expressive faces and intricate backgrounds. Background characters are never still; they actively engage with their surroundings, making the city a living, breathing part of the story. The style is influenced by manga and the works of Miyazaki, who wrote the screenplay and oversaw the film's production. Around 70% of the film follows Shizuku's everyday life and adventures in Tokyo, allowing the city itself to take centre stage.In contrast, Isao Takahata's Only Yesterday takes a more introspective approach and explores themes of alienation and nostalgia. The film follows Taeko, a 27-year-old office worker, who reflects on her childhood in Tokyo and her current life, feeling disconnected from the city's relentless pace and modernity. The film juxtaposes her desire for a simpler, more rural life with her present-day experiences in Tokyo, highlighting the emotional and psychological distance she feels. The film's animation and realistic portrayal of Tokyo's urban environment bring out her sense of disconnection and longing for a simpler life.The film employs a cold, dark colour palette with shades of blue, grey, black and white to reflect the monotony and gloom of the city, as well as the nostalgia and regret of the protagonist. Taeko's daily commute and office scenes illustrate the repetitive rhythm and routine of adult life in Tokyo. The use of muted and earthy tones for the city captures Taeko's introspective and occasionally melancholic state of mind. The soundtrack is soft and reflective, enhancing the film's contemplative atmosphere and tracing Taeko's emotional journey.The animation style is simple and stylised, characterised by

greens - that reflects the characters' mood and emotions, along with the seasons and time of day. The detailed animation brings Tokyo's streets

minimal, sometimes rough movements, understated facial expressions, and sketch-like backgrounds. This approach is influenced by the watercolour paintings of the original manga, as well as the works of Takahata, who directed and wrote the film. Unlike Whisper of the Heart, the city occupies a small portion of the film, about 15%, as the story alternates between Taeko's life in Tokyo and in Yamagata, the rural neighbourhood she moves to.The dual representation of Tokyo in these films serves not only as a narrative choice but also as a reflection of the city's complex identity. Like many global cities, Tokyo is a place of contrasts where tradition meets modernity and where dreams can be both realised and shattered. This duality is a common theme in urban studies, which regard cities as sites of both opportunity and alienation. Furthermore, the difference in the protagonists' ages influences their interactions with and perceptions of the city.While Shizuku's youthful perspective adds a sense of excitement and discovery to her experiences in Tokyo, Taeko's adult viewpoint is more reflective and critical.By examining these two films, we can gain insights into how Tokyo's multifaceted nature is portrayed through different lenses. Whisper of the Heart and Only Yesterday show us that cities are not monolithic; they are experienced differently by each individual. They are shaped by who we are, what we remember, and what we hope to become. These films help us think more deeply about what it means to live in a city, touching on themes of identity, belonging and the pace of urban change.Together, the two films offer two distinct yet complementary views of Tokyo: one full of possibility, the other tinged with longing. Through their contrasting tones and visual styles, they capture how the same city can feel radically different depending on who is looking and when. It is this quiet attention to emotional texture that makes Studio Ghibli's vision of urban life so resonant and so deeply human.By-Priya Singh.
