Minister announces Integrated Agri Extension Centres

Chennai, Apr 4: Agriculture Minister M.R.K. Panneerselvam announced in the Legislative Assembly that integrated agricultural extension centres will be set up at seven locations at a cost of Rs.25 crores by the Agriculture Department.

During the discussion on the Agriculture Department’s grant request held in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly yesterday, Minister Panneerselvam responded as follows:

During the debate, MLAs Agri Krishnamoorthy and Pollachi Jayaraman raised questions, asking whether the government truly cared about agriculture and what had been done to support it. The Minister responded, “The only achievement of the AIADMK regime in agriculture was farmer suicides.”

He added, “During their rule, 47 farmers died by suicide. The then government offered compensation of Rs.2.76 crores. Now they ask what our government has done. Under our administration, the Chief Minister has generously allocated funds to the Agriculture Department, enabling us to achieve

numerous milestones.”

Key Announcements:

Pollachi Jayaraman had also raised concerns about damage to coconut cultivation. The Minister noted that coconut farming spans 12 lakh acres in Tamil Nadu and said, “During the previous regime, nothing was done for coconut farmers. Under the DMK regime, the area under cultivation has increased by 5 lakh acres compared to the AIADMK tenure.”

To enable farmers to access all agriculture-related schemes, advisory services, and quality agricultural inputs in one place, seven integrated agricultural extension centres will be established at a cost of Rs.25 crores.

To ensure farmers receive quality fertilizers, two fertilizer quality control laboratories will be established — one each in Tirunelveli and Cuddalore — at a total cost of Rs.6 crores.

To reduce post-harvest losses and extend storage life, cold storage facilities will be built at Thisayanvilai and Manamadurai at a cost of Rs.4 crores.

To safely store agricultural engineering equipment and provide services to farmers at the local level, 15 agricultural machinery sheds will be constructed in different zones at a cost of Rs.3.30 crores.

To improve services provided at Tamil Nadu’s 386 integrated agricultural extension centres and to monitor them effectively, surveillance cameras and digital attendance systems will be installed at a cost of Rs.2.5 crores.

In total, the Minister announced 22 new measures for the Agriculture Department.

Following this, Opposition Leader Edappadi K. Palaniswami asked, “As promised in your election manifesto, will Rs.4,000 per ton be provided for sugarcane and Rs.2,500 per quintal for paddy this year?”

Responding to the question, Minister Panneerselvam said, “The paddy support price is currently Rs.50 short. Starting this September, Rs.2,500 per quintal will be provided. For sugarcane, Rs.4,000 per ton will be given in the next season.”
