Seven die as rain, hailstorms wreak havoc in Bihar's Siwan

At least seven people died due to heavy rain and hailstorms in Bihar's Siwan district, according to a statement issued by the Disaster Management Department (DMD) on Tuesday. The rain and hailstorms also damaged several houses and uprooted a number of trees.

"Heavy rain and hailstorms lashed several parts, including Barharia, Basantpur, Lakri Nabiganj and Gauraiya Kothi in Siwan district on Monday, leaving seven people dead," the statement said.

The DMD has directed the district administration to ensure that immediate family members of the deceased get compensation as per the existing norms on a priority basis, it said.

More than 90 people were killed in lightning strikes and thunderstorms in various districts in the state in April. Nalanda district had reported the highest number of fatalities at 23 in that month.

"I am deeply saddened by the tragic deaths of more than 50 people in various incidents of storm, rain, lightning, tree and wall collapse in Bihar. I express my deepest condolences, hour," RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav wrote in Hindi in a post on X.

LANGUAGE ROW | Karnataka HC criticises actor-filmmaker for refusing to apologise for remark Kannada was born out of Tamil

Won't apologise, says Haasan; Thug Life release deferred

Refusing to apologise for his controversial remark regarding the origins of the Kannada language, actor Kamal Haasan has informed the Karnataka High Court that his production house has decided not to release his movie 'Thug Life' in the state next week.

The High Court bench, headed by Justice M. Nagaprasanna, recorded this submission and adjourned the matter to June 10. While adjourning, the bench advised actor Kamal Haasan to at least use his discretion regarding the matter now.

Senior Counsel Dhyan Chinnappa, appearing for Kamal Haasan, submitted that the actor cannot be compelled to apologise or issue apologies in a certain manner. The bench intervened, stating that the court had not asked the actor to apologise.

The counsel for the actor maintained that while the court had not demanded an apology, the Karnataka Film Chambers of Commerce had. "We will discuss the matter with the film body. We will not release the movie 'Thug Life' in Karnataka," the counsel stated.

The counsel further added that he had spoken to Kamal Haasan



regarding the court's observations on the case that morning and conveyed them to him."

Kamal Haasan has expressed his respect towards the Kannada language in his letter to the film body. The actor has not issued any statement showing the Kannada language in a poor light. He has not used any inappropriate words regarding the Kannada language. Since there is no ill motive, he is not tendering apologies," the counsel stated after reading Kamal Haasan's letter to the Karnataka film body in court.

The bench observed that instead of "beating around the bush," the addition of one word would have resolved the matter.

"His ego must be coming in the way. Neither Kamal Haasan nor

anyone should cause pain to the feelings of the people," the bench stated.

The counsel for the actor submitted, "We should not get divided on the basis of language. Our country is the same. Kannada and Tamil languages both should thrive. The court has not directed Kamal Haasan to tender his apologies in a certain manner."

Earlier on Tuesday, the Karnataka High Court reprimanded actor Kamal Haasan over his controversial remark on the origins of the Kannada language, questioning why the police should provide security for his mistake. "Don't use the Right to Speech to hurt sentiments," the court said.

Justice M. Nagaprasanna of the Karnataka High Court stated that

such remarks had hurt the sentiments of the people of Karnataka. "Language is an emotional and cultural identity of a people. No individual has the right to undermine the pride of an entire linguistic community," he observed. The judge further questioned Haasan's authority to make such claims, asking, "Are you a historian or a linguist to make such a statement? No language is born out of another."

He added, "A single apology could have resolved the situation." Justice Nagaprasanna stressed the importance of respecting cultural sensitivities and remarked, "Water, land, and language — Jala, Nela, Bashe — are sacred to the people. The division of this country itself was based on linguistic lines. No citizen has the right to hurt such sentiments."

The bench, headed by Justice M. Nagaprasanna, made these observations while hearing a petition submitted by Kamal Haasan seeking security for the screening of his movie 'Thug Life' in Karnataka's theatres and multiplexes.

The controversy erupted after Haasan, during the audio launch of Thug Life in Chennai in late May, reportedly remarked that "Kannada was born out of Tamil."

Raj cop busts Rs 150 cr online betting racket, three arrested

Rajasthan Police have arrested three persons, including a software engineer, exposing a big online cricket betting ring. The gang had made bets of more than Rs 150 crore across the country, with a network spread to Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and several other states.

Police have seized six Android mobile phones, two laptops, a hard drive and an SUV with 15 ATM cards from them. Alwar SP Sanjeev Nain said that the arrested accused used to cheat people by creating websites of online betting apps.

Calcutta HC allows petitions challenging fresh notification

The Calcutta high court on Tuesday allowed separate petitions challenging the format of a fresh selection test for the Bengal government-appointed school teachers from the 2016 panel and chief minister Mamata Banerjee's decision to offer monthly stipend to the Group-C and D staff inducted that year, lawyers aware of the development said.

The appointments of all these people were cancelled by the Supreme Court on April 3 in the bribe-for-job case. Both petitions were filed by people who appeared for the selection tests in 2016 but did not get jobs. They have claimed to be victims of the alleged bribe-for-job in the education department that the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and Enforcement Directorate (ED) have been probing since 2022.

One of the sacked teachers Lubana Parveen, the petitioner stated

that the fresh notification had violated the directives issued by the Supreme Court. The matter is listed to be heard on June 5. Senior CPI (M) leader and lawyer Bikash Ranjan Bhattacharya said that the challenge against the notification was bound to happen.

"In order to hide one corruption, the state government wants to do another corruption in the name of fresh recruitment. This state government can't come out of corruption," added Bhattacharya. Lawyer Firdous Shamim said that the directives issued by the apex court doesn't give any provision 'to allot 10 marks for experience'.

Shamim also mentioned that the recruitment process 'should adhere to the rules from 2016'. Notably, under the 2016 rules, academic qualifications carried 35 marks, the written test was worth 55 marks, and interviews were allotted 10 marks. The SSC on May 30 had issued the fresh notification for recruitment.

JAGAN FACES PROTESTS BY DALITS IN TENALI

Man who accused Sharmishta Panoli goes 'missing'

Wajahat Khan, the Kolkata man whose complaint led to the arrest of 22-year-old Pune law student and social media influencer Sharmishta Panoli, has gone "missing", according to his father. While Panoli was arrested by Kolkata Police on Friday, Wajahat has since found himself at the centre of a political slugfest and legal storm. FIRs have been filed against Wajahat in at least three states, with Assam set to dispatch a police team to arrest him.

Police from West Bengal, Assam and Delhi have either

registered FIRs or initiated enquiries against him. He went "missing" after reportedly receiving numerous threats and abuse calls, as claimed by his father, Saadat Khan. In fact, a police team from Dispur is set to travel to West Bengal to bring Wajahat Khan to justice.

So, who is Wajahat Khan, and what exactly has he got himself into after his complaint resulted in Sharmishta Panoli's arrest?

Wajahat Khan is reportedly the general secretary of the Kolkata-based Rashidi Foundation, the organisation that lodged the initial complaint against Sharmishta Panoli, al-

leged the Shri Ram Swabhiman Parishad, which on Tuesday filed an FIR against the Kolkata man.

The Shri Ram Swabhiman Parishad, a charitable trust, lodged a complaint against Khan at Kolkata's Garden Reach Police Station, the same station where he had initially filed his complaint against Sharmishta Panoli.

In its complaint to Kolkata's Garden Reach Police Station, it accused Wajahat Khan of sharing "malicious and inflammatory posts" on social media that were "intentionally directed toward the Hindu community, its sacred beliefs, and revered deities".

Mumbai lawyers body writes to CJI, seeks prosecution of Varma

Bombay Lawyers Association has written to Chief Justice of India B R Gavai seeking sanction to prosecute high court judge Yashwant Varma over the discovery of huge cash from his official residence when he was in Delhi.

The judge was transferred to Allahabad High Court amidst the raging controversy.

Former CJI Sanjiv Khanna had recently written to President Droupadi Murmu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi, besides sharing with them the report of the apex court-appointed committee reportedly indicting Varma and the judge's response.

Bombay Lawyers Association (BLA) in its letter dated June 2 and signed by president Ahmad M Abdi and secretary Eknath R Dhokale sought the sanction to prosecute the judge besides referring to the top court rejecting a PIL on the issue on May 21.

The top court called it "premature" and dismissed the PIL seeking an FIR over the matter and asked the petitioners to approach appropriate authorities instead.

The lawyers' body said, "It needs to be kept in mind that litigants and other lay persons are active stakeholders in the legal process. The applicant is seeking your sanction to initiate criminal prosecution, including the registration of an FIR, against Justice Yashwant Varma, a sitting Judge of the Allahabad High Court, under the relevant provisions of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, in connection with the alleged recovery of unaccounted cash from his official residence."

The letter referred to the apex court's landmark ruling in K Veeraswami case of 1991 which mandates that no criminal case be registered against a sitting judge of the high court or Supreme Court without the CJI's prior approval.

The 1991 judgement, the letter went on to say, held that judges of the high courts and Supreme Court are "public servants" under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and liable for prosecution for offenses such as possession of disproportionate assets.
