POSTAL BALLOT NOTICE

[Notice pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014]

Dear Members,

NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, (the 'Companies Act'), read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('SEBI Listing Regulations'), Secretarial Standards issued by Institute of Company Secretaries of India on General Meetings ('SS-2'), (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force), and other applicable laws and regulations, if any, that it is proposed to seek the consent of the shareholders ('Members') of Jump Networks Limited (the "Company"), for the resolutions appended herein below through postal ballot ('Postal Ballot') by way of Postal Ballot forms and remote electronic voting ('E-voting').

In view of the pandemic situation of COVID-19 and pursuant to the guidelines and notification issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India and in light of circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (the 'MCA') vide its General Circular No.14/2020 dated April 08, 2020 and General Circular No.17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 read with General Circular No. 33/2020 dated 28th September, 2021, General Circular No. 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020 and General Circular No. 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021 (collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars") and pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act and the Rules made thereunder, the company proposes for passing of resolutions as per this Postal Ballot Notice.

In terms of said Section of the Companies Act and the Rules, a company may, and in case of resolutions relating to such business as the Central Government may, by notification, declare to be conducted only by Postal Ballot, shall, get any resolution (other than Ordinary Business and any Business in respect of which Directors or Auditors have right to be heard at any meeting) passed by means of Postal Ballot, instead of transacting the business in general meeting of the Company.

In terms of the MCA Circulars, in view of the current extraordinary circumstances due to COVID-19 pandemic requiring social distancing, companies are advised to take all decisions requiring Members' approval, other than items of ordinary business or business where any person has a right to be heard, through the mechanism of Postal Ballot/E-voting in accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act and Rules made thereunder, without holding a general meeting that requires physical presence of Members at a common venue.

This Postal Ballot is accordingly being initiated in compliance with the above MCA Circulars.

You are requested to peruse the following proposed Resolutions along with their respective Explanatory Statement and thereafter record your assent or dissent by means of Postal Ballot form or E-Voting system provided by the Company.

The Board of Directors of the Company ('the Board'), has at its meeting held on Saturday, July 31, 2021 considered and approved the following resolutions, subject to the Members' approvals through postal ballot:

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the “Relevant Date” pursuant to regulation 161 of SEBI(ICDR) Regulations, 2018 in relation to the abovementioned Preferential Issue of Warrants is Thursday, August 05, 2021, being the date, which is 30 days prior to the date on which the resolution will be deemed to be passed i.e Saturday September 04, 2021.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the offer, issue and allotment of the aforesaid Warrants to the proposed allottees and equity shares resulting from the exercise of the entitlement of the said warrants, shall be subject to applicable guidelines, notifications, rules and regulations and on the terms and conditions given herein below:

a) Amount payable on allotment of warrants shall be 25% of the price per warrant and the amount

- 1. AN EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013 (“ACT”) SETTING OUT THE MATERIAL FACTS CONCERNING THE BUSINESSES TO BE TRANSACTED IS ANNEXED HERETO.**
2. The Postal Ballot Notice is being sent to the Member(s) whose names appear on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as received from the National Securities Depository Limited (“NSDL”) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) as on Friday, July 30, 2021 (cut-off date). The Postal Ballot Notice is being sent to the Members who have registered their email IDs for receipt of documents in electronic form to their email addresses registered with their Depository Participants/the Company’s Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (“RTA”).
3. Member(s) whose names appear on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as on the cut-off date will be considered for the purpose of voting/e-voting. A person who is not a member as on the cut-off date should treat this Notice for information purpose only.
4. In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act and Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Company provides the Members the facility to exercise their right to vote by electronic means through e-voting services provided by CDSL and the business may be transacted through such voting. 6. The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares of the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date i.e., Friday, July 30, 2021.
7. The Board of Directors of the Company ("the Board"), has appointed Mr. Chirag Jain (Membership No. F11127) Partner of M/s. JCA&Co. Practicing Company Secretary, (COP. No. 13687) as the Scrutinizer, for conducting the e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
8. As required by Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 read with MCA Circulars and the Listing Regulations, the details pertaining to this postal ballot will be published in one English national daily newspaper circulating throughout India (in English language) and one in vernacular language in that district (in Marathi Language) in which registered office of the Company is situated. The Result of the Postal Ballot will be published in the newspaper one in English national daily newspaper circulating throughout India (in English Language) and in one Hindi national daily newspaper circulating throughout India (in Hindi language) and one in vernacular language in that district (in Marathi Language) in which the registered office of the Company is situated.
9. To support the "Green initiative" members who have not registered their e-mail addresses so far are requested to register their e-mail address with the company's RTA or Depository Participants, in respect of shares held in physical/electronic mode respectively.

THE INTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:

- (i) The voting period begins on Friday, August 06, 2021 from 9.00 a.m. (IST) and shall end on Saturday, September 04, 2021 till 5.00 p.m (IST). During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of Friday, July 30, 2021 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.



In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants.** Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- (iii) In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.
