Notice is hereby given that **Extra Ordinary General Meeting** of members of **Best Agrolife Limited** will be held on **Monday, December 29, 2025**, at **12.30 P.M.** through video conferencing (VC)/ other audio-visual means (OAVM) to transact the following business:

1. To Consider and approve the Sub-Division / Split of Equity Shares and consequential alteration of Capital Clause of Memorandum of Association of the Company:

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution, with or without modification(s), as an Ordinary Resolution:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 13, 61(1)(d), 64 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the “Act”), including the rules made thereunder, the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the “Listing Regulations”) as amended from time to time, to the extent applicable (including any statutory modification(s), notifications, circulars issued thereunder or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force), and pursuant to the Articles of Association of the Company and subject to such permissions, consents and approvals, if any, required from the concerned statutory authorities as may be required in this respect and based on the recommendation of the Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as the “Board”, which term shall deem to include any committee constituted or to be constituted by the board, from time to time, to exercise its powers conferred by this resolution), the approval of the Members of the Company be and is hereby accorded for sub-dividing the Equity Shares of the Company, such that each Equity Share having nominal face value of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten Only) each, be sub-divided into 10 (Ten) Equity Shares having nominal face value of Re. 1/- (Rupee One Only) each fully paid-up.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT pursuant to the Sub-division of Equity Shares of the Company, the Authorized, Issued, Subscribed and Paid-up Equity Share Capital of nominal face value of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten Only) each, shall stand sub-divided into 10 (Ten) Equity Shares of nominal face value of Re. 1/- (Rupee One Only) each.”

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 13 and 61 of the Companies Act, 2013, applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, Clause V of Memorandum of Association of the Company be and is hereby altered and substituted by the following:

“The Authorised Share Capital of the Company is Rs. 50,00,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Crores Only) divided into 50,00,00,000 (Fifty Crore) Equity Shares of Face Value of Re. 1/- (Rupee One Only) each.”

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT upon sub-division of the Equity Shares as aforesaid, 10 (Ten) Equity Shares of the face value of Re. 1/- each to be allotted in lieu of existing 1 (One) Equity Share of the face value of Rs. 10/- each subject to the terms of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company and shall rank pari-passu in all respects with the existing fully paid-up Equity Shares of Rs.

10/- each of the Company and shall be entitled to participate in full after the Sub-divided Equity Shares are allotted.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT pursuant to the sub-division of equity shares as aforesaid and with effect from the Record Date:

- a) the equity shares held in physical form, the existing share certificate(s) in relation to the existing equity shares of face value of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten Only) each, fully paid up, shall be deemed to have been cancelled and be of no effect and that the Board/Company's Registrar and Share Transfer Agents ("RTA"), without requiring the Members to surrender their existing share certificate(s), shall issue new share certificate(s) or letter of confirmation(s) in lieu of existing share certificate(s) in compliance with the applicable laws/guidelines in this regard; and
- b) the equity shares held in dematerialized form, the sub-divided equity shares shall be credited proportionately into the respective beneficiary demat account(s) of the Members held with their Depository Participant(s), in lieu of the existing credits present in their respective beneficiary demat account(s).

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the sub-division of equity shares shall be subject to the terms and conditions contained in Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT pursuant to the sub-division of the face value of equity shares of the Company from ₹10/- each to Re. 1/- each, the Board be and is hereby authorised to proportionately adjust the total number of stock options approved by the shareholders under the 'Best Agrolife Employee Stock Option Scheme 2024' ("ESOS 2024"/ "Scheme"), such that the number of stock options available for grant under the Scheme shall stand increased corresponding to the share split.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014 and the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014, as amended, (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force), the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and the policies, rules, regulations, the board be and is hereby authorised to make an appropriate adjustments due to sub-division of shares, to the Convertible Warrants allotted under the Preferential Allotment to the promoters/non-promoter individual/entities in terms of the ICDR Regulations, as amended from time to time, such that the exercise price for all the outstanding convertible warrants (allotted but not exercised) and the number of shares per warrant as on the Record Date shall be proportionately adjusted.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT for the purpose of giving effect to the aforesaid resolution, the Board be and is hereby authorised to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may deem fit in its absolute discretion, to delegate all or any of its powers conferred under this resolution to any of its committee or Director or Key Managerial Personnel or any officer/executive of the Company including to fix and announce the Record Date, to make appropriate adjustments on account of sub-division of equity shares, to accept and make any alteration(s), modification(s) to terms and to give such directions as they may in their absolute discretion deem necessary, proper or desirable, to apply for requisite approvals, to settle any questions, doubts or difficulties that may arise with regard to the sub-division of the equity shares as aforesaid and to carry out/execute all matters in connection therewith and incidental thereto in order to give full effect to this resolution including execution and filing of all the relevant documents with the Registrar of Companies, Stock Exchanges, Depositories and other appropriate authorities in due compliance of the applicable rules and regulations."

2. To issue Bonus Shares

To consider and if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following Resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 63 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (“the Act”) read with the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 (“the Rules”), and the rules made thereunder, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 (“ICDR Regulations”), the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“Listing Regulations”), the Foreign Management Act, 1999 and other applicable provisions of regulations and guidelines issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) and Reserve Bank of India (RBI) from time to time, the enabling provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, and pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as “the Board”, which expression shall be deemed to include a Committee of Directors or officer(s) of the Company duly authorized in this behalf), and subject to such approvals as may be required in this regard, approval of the Members be and is hereby accorded to the Board for capitalization of a sum not exceeding Rs. 12,99,42,450 (Rupees Twelve Crores Ninety Nine Lakhs Forty Two Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Only) from and out of the Company's Free Reserves (Retained Earnings) and the securities premium account for the purpose of the issue of bonus equity shares of Re. 1/- (Rupee One only) each, credited as fully paid-up equity shares to the holders of the existing equity shares of the Company in consideration of their said holding and whose names appear in the Register of Members maintained by the Company/List of Beneficial Owners as received from the National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), on such date as may be fixed in this regard by the Board, in the proportion of 1 (One) equity share of Re. 1/- (Rupee One only) each for every 2 (Two) existing equity shares of Re. 1/- (Rupee One only) each held by the Members and that the new bonus equity shares so issued and allotted shall, for all purposes, be treated as an increase in the paid-up capital of the Company held by each such Member.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (“the Act”) read with the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014 and the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014, as amended, (including any statutory

modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force), the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and the policies, rules, regulations, the board be and is hereby authorised to make an appropriate adjustments with respect to the exercise price and/or the number of Convertible Warrants allotted under the Preferential Allotment to the promoters/non-promoter individual/entities in terms of the ICDR Regulations, as amended from time to time, such that the exercise price for all the outstanding convertible warrants (allotted but not exercised) and the number of shares per warrants and also decide on the allotment of such number of additional warrants/shares as bonus warrants/shares to the warrants holders who have been allotted convertible warrants, in same proportion as the bonus equity shares being issued.

1. Pursuant to the General Circular No. 09/2024 dated September 19, 2024, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) and circular issued by SEBI vide circular no. SEBI/ HO/ CFD/ CFDPoD-2/ P/ CIR/ 2024/ 133 dated October 3, 2024 (“SEBI Circular”) and other applicable circulars and notifications issued (including any statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force and as amended from time to time, companies are allowed to hold EGM/AGM through Video Conferencing (VC) or other audio visual means (OAVM), without the physical presence of members at a common venue. In compliance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (‘the Act’), the SEBI Listing Regulations and MCA Circulars, the EGM of the Company is being held through VC/ OAVM on **Monday, December 29, 2025 at 12:30 p.m.** (IST). The deemed venue of the EGM shall be the Registered Office of the Company.
2. Since this EGM is being held pursuant to the MCA Circulars through VC / OAVM, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the Members will not be available for the EGM and hence the Proxy Form, Attendance Slip and route map of EGM are not annexed to this Notice. Institutional members/ Corporate members (i.e. other than individuals, HUF’s, NRI’s, etc.) intending to authorize their representatives to participate and vote at the meeting are requested to send a certified copy of the Board resolution / authorization letter to the Scrutinizer by email to advisorsproficient@gmail.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.com.
3. The information required to be provided as per section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013, Secretarial Standard - 2 on General Meetings issued by The Institute of Company Secretaries of India and SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, are furnished in the explanatory statement which is annexed hereto.
4. The Members can join the EGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the EGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large shareholders (shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairperson of the Audit Committee, Nomination & Remuneration Committee and Stakeholder Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the EGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis. Members attending the EGM through VC / OAVM shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Act.
5. In case of joint holders, the Member whose name appears as the first holder in the order of names as per the Register of Members of the Company will be entitled to vote at the EGM through e-voting.
6. The Register of Directors and Key Managerial Personnel and their shareholding, maintained under Section 170 of the Act and the Register of Contracts or Arrangements in which the Directors are interested, maintained under Section 189 of the Act and relevant documents referred to in the Notice of this EGM and explanatory statement, will be available electronically for inspection by the Members during the EGM. Members who wish to inspect such documents can send their requests to the Company at info@bestagrolife.com by mentioning name and Folio number/DP ID and Client ID.
7. In compliance with the MCA Circulars and SEBI Circulars, Notice of the EGM along with the explanatory statement is being sent only through electronic mode to those Members whose email addresses are registered with the Company Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (RTA)/Depositories. Further, the Notice and explanatory statement will also be available on the

Company's website www.bestagrolife.com, website of the Stock Exchanges i.e. BSE Limited and the National Stock Exchange of India Limited at www.bseindia.com and www.nseindia.com respectively and on the website of NSDL <https://www.evoting.nsdl.com>.

8. Instructions for e-voting and joining the EGM are as follows:

A. VOTING THROUGH ELECTRONIC MEANS

- i. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), and the Circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs dated April 8, 2020, April 13, 2020 and May 5, 2020 the Company is providing facility of remote e-Voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the EGM. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-Voting system as well as venue voting on the date of the EGM will be provided by NSDL.
- ii. The remote e-voting period begins on Friday, December 26, 2025 (9:00 a.m. IST) and ends on Sunday, December 28, 2025 (5:00 p.m. IST). During this period, Members holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on Monday December 22, 2025 i.e. cut-off date, may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. Members have the option to cast their vote on any of the resolutions using the remote e-voting facility, either during the period commencing Friday, December 26, 2025 (9:00 a.m. IST) and ends on Sunday, December 28, 2025 (5:00 p.m. IST). or e-voting during the EGM. Members who have voted on some of the resolutions during the said voting period are also eligible to vote on the remaining resolutions during the EGM.
- iii. The Members who have cast their vote by remote e-voting prior to the EGM may also attend/participate in the EGM through VC/OAVM but shall not be entitled to cast their vote on such resolution again.
- iv. The Board of Directors has appointed Ms. Rakhi Rani, Practicing Company Secretary (Membership Number: 31715) as the Scrutinizer for providing facility to the members of the Company to scrutinize the voting at the meeting and remote e-voting process, in a fair and transparent manner.
- v. The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date i.e. Monday, December 22, 2025.
- vi. Any person holding shares in physical form and non-individual shareholders, who acquires shares of the Company and becomes a Member of the Company after sending of the Notice and holding shares as of the cut-off date i.e. Monday, December 22, 2025, may obtain the User ID and Password by sending a request at evoting@nsdl.com. However, if he/she is already registered with NSDL for remote e-voting then he/ she can use his/her existing User ID and

Password for casting the vote. In case of individual shareholders holding securities in dematerialized mode and who acquires shares of the Company and becomes a Member of the Company after sending of the Notice and holding shares as of the cut-off date may follow steps mentioned below under **“Login method for remote e-voting and joining virtual meeting for individual shareholders holding securities in dematerialized mode.”**

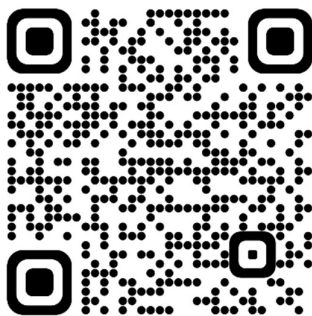
Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system

A. Login method for e-Voting and joining virtual meeting for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode

In terms of SEBI circular dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

Login method for Individual shareholders holding securities in dematerialized mode is given below:

If you are not registered for IDeAS e-Services, option to register is available at https://eservices.nsdl.com. Select “Register Online for IDeAS Portal” or click at https://eservices.nsdl.com/SecureWeb/IdeasDirectReg.jsp 4. Visit the e-Voting website of NSDL. Open web browser by typing the following URL: https://www.evoting.nsdl.com/ either on a Personal

	Computer or on a mobile. Once the home page of e-Voting system is launched, click on the icon “Login” which is available under ‘Shareholder/Member’ section. A new screen will open. You will have to enter your User ID (i.e. your sixteen digit demat account number hold with NSDL), Password/OTP and a Verification Code as shown on the screen. After successful authentication, you will be redirected to NSDL Depository site wherein you can see e-Voting page. Click on company name or e-Voting service provider i.e. NSDL and you will be redirected to e-Voting website of NSDL for casting your vote during the remote e-Voting period or joining virtual meeting & voting during the meeting. 5. Explanatory Statement
Pursuant to Section 102(1) of Companies Act, 2013

As required by Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the “Act”), the following Explanatory Statement sets out all material acts relating to the aforementioned special businesses:

ITEM: 1&2-

The Board of Directors of the Company, at its meeting held on December 03, 2025, approved and recommended the following for approval of the Members:

a) Sub-division of 1 (one) Equity Share of face value of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten Only) into 10 (Ten) equity shares of face value of Re. 1/- (Rupee One Only); and

b) Issue of 1 (One) bonus Equity Shares of face value of Re. 1/- (Rupee One Only) for every 2 (Two) Equity Share fully paid-up of Rs. 1/- (Rupee One Only) by capitalising such sums out of Free Reserve and/or Securities Premium Account and/or any other permitted reserves as may be considered appropriate.

In order to improve the liquidity of the Company’s share and make them more affordable, thereby encouraging greater participation from retail investors and broadening the small investor base, the Board of Directors of the Company has recommended to sub-divide (split) Company’s 1 (one) Equity Share of face value of Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten Only) each into 10 (Ten) Equity Shares of face value of Re. 1/- (Rupee One Only) each without altering the paid-up capital of the Company, subject to the approval of the members. The Record Date for the aforesaid sub-division of the Equity Shares will be fixed by the Board of Directors.

Further, in view of the proposed sub-division of Equity Shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each to Re. 1/- each, it is proposed to alter the authorised share capital to Rs. 50,00,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Crores Only) divided into 50,00,00,000 equity shares of face value of Re. 1/- each and to amend the capital clause of the Memorandum of Association as stated in the resolution at item no. 1 of the notice.

In appreciation of continuing support from shareholders of the Company and after considering the available reserves, with the Company and subject to the consent of Shareholders of the Company and all other requisite approvals, permissions, sanctions, the Board had considered, approved and recommended the issue of bonus Equity Shares of Re. 1/- (Rupee One Only) each (after considering the sub-division), credited as fully paid-up to existing members of the Company in the proportion of 1:2, by capitalizing such sums standing to the credit of Free Reserve and/or the securities premium account and/or any other permitted reserves, as per the audited financial statements of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2025, as may be considered appropriate.

Articles of Association of the Company permits capitalization of any part of the amount for the time being standing to the credit of any of the Company’s reserve accounts (including securities premium account and capital redemption reserve account), or to the credit of the profit and loss account, or otherwise available for distribution by applying the same towards payment of unissued shares to be issued to the members as fully paid bonus shares.

The Record Date for the aforesaid sub-division of Equity Shares and issue of bonus shares shall be fixed by the Board (including any Committee thereof) after the approval of the Members is obtained. Further, the aforesaid sub-division and bonus issue would, inter alia, require fair and reasonable adjustment to the stock options and convertible warrants that have been yet to be granted or yet to be exercised and also to the exercise price of such options/convertible warrants as on the Record Date. The ICDR Regulations provides for making a fair and reasonable adjustment to the outstanding stock options and convertible securities respectively as mentioned above.

Members are requested to note that in terms of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, the new equity shares to be allotted pursuant to the bonus issue shall be allotted in dematerialised form only. Accordingly, members holding shares in physical form are requested to provide such information and details as may be required, relating to his/her/ its demat account with a depository participant, to the Company / its Registrar and Transfer Agent atleast one working day before the Record date which shall be intimated in due course, to enable it to issue the bonus equity shares in dematerialised form.

With respect to the bonus equity shares of members holding equity shares in physical form who have not provided their demat account details to the Company, the said bonus equity shares shall be credited in dematerialised form to a new demat suspense account, to hold these shares till they are credited to the beneficiary accounts of the respective members holding equity shares in physical form. The voting rights on the bonus equity shares held in the demat suspense account / trust account, shall remain frozen.

Pursuant to proviso to Regulation 295 of SEBI ICDR Regulations, the bonus issue shall be implemented within two months from the date of the meeting of Board of Directors wherein, the decision to announce the bonus issue was taken subject to shareholders' approval.

Accordingly, the Company will take the requisite steps for implementing the aforesaid corporate actions on or before January 31, 2026.

The Board of Directors are of the opinion that the above proposals are in the interest of the Company and its existing and potential investors. The Board has therefore, recommended the resolutions set out at Item Nos. 1 and 2 of this Notice of EGM for the approval of the Members of the Company by way of Ordinary Resolutions.

A copy of the Memorandum of Association of the Company containing the proposed alterations is hosted on Company's website during the remote e-voting period at www.bestagrolife.com and would be available for inspection by the Members of the Company during business hours on any working day.

None of the Directors, Key Managerial Personnel of the Company and their relatives are concerned or interested, in this resolution, except to the extent of their respective shareholding, if any, in the Company. Promoter and Promoter group are deemed to be interested to the extent of their respective shareholding, if any, in the Company.
