

India draws R-Day...

He said the temporary measures with regard to internet access in certain parts of the National Capital Region(NCR) were therefore understandably undertaken to prevent further violence. The MEA Spokesperson emphasised that it is important to see the comments by the US in the context in which they were made. "We have taken note of comments of the US State Department. It is important to see such comments in the context in which they were made and in their entirety," he said. "As you can see, the US state department has acknowledged steps being taken by India towards agricultural reforms."

One's threat today...

The US and China are currently engaged in a bitter confrontation over various issues, including the aggressive military moves in the disputed South China Sea. In his address, Singh said IOR countries have together demonstrated their mutual respect for a rules based order, setting an example of how abiding with international law will enable harnessing the global commons for the good of all. Intriguing dual stand of Oppn in Parliament

Joins debates in Rajya Sabha, but continues to create ruckus in Lok Sabha over farmers' issue

The Opposition has taken a dual stand in Parliament, joining the debate in the Rajya Sabha since Wednesday on the motion of thanks to the President for his address to a joint session while its Lok Sabha members continued to create a ruckus in the Lok Sabha forcing repeated adjournments.

The only concession the Opposition took from Rajya Sabha Chairman M Venkaiah Naidu was to extend the debate from 10 to 15 hours and allow them to raise the issue of the farmers agitating on Delhi's borders since past 71 days. Prime Minister Modi was also present in the debate on Wednesday and he is slated to reply on Monday.

The Opposition, led by the Congress, insisted on a separate debate in the Lok Sabha

Mamata loses cool as audience shouts demand

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee got angry with the crowd as a few among the audience urged for more developmental works in the state.

"The BJP purposely plants people to disrupt my rallies. The dates of the election will be announced in a couple of days. Now, I cannot do so many things and for that if a section of people doesn't want to vote for TMC, I am not bothered," mentioned the angry chief minister.

Her nephew Abhishek, however, was seen pacifying the crowd saying all the demands will be met after the chief minister's speech. Incidentally, something similar had happened at the chief minister's rally in Purulia last month, where a section of people started shouting their demands as soon as Mamata Banerjee started her speech. Taking a jibe at the BJP, Abhishek said the party is playing 'communal' politics and is not worried about the 'well-being' of the people.

Cong worried about minority votes

KOLKATA: Congress leader Abdul Mannan has written to party high command Sonia Gandhi seeking permission to form an alliance with Furruqa Serif Chaudhary's newly floated political party Indian Secular Front. In the letter, Leader of Opposition in West Bengal Asim Manjan pointed out that minority voters have shifted away from the Congress which was evident from the last parliamentary election 2019.

Vande Matram recital clips enter Guinness Book

SRRAWAN SHUKLA / LUCKNOW: The Uttar Pradesh government entered into the Guinness Book of World Records again when over 1.4 lakh students recited Vande Matram while standing in salute position during the Chauri Chaura centenary celebrations. The Principal Secretary Culture and Tourism Mukesh Meshram claimed that it took China 29 days to create a record for largest online video album with 10,369 video clips while Uttar Pradesh broke it in just an hour.

He said that over 1.4 lakh videos of students singing Vande Matram in salute position from 75 districts were already uploaded on the link provided by the Guinness Book of World records on Wednesday between 10 am and 8 pm to break the world record with huge margin and set a new record in its name "Many thousands more videos were uploaded till 12 noon on Thursday. An audit of the videos uploaded on the website is on and the Guinness Book of World Records authorities will announce the final tally on Friday," said Meshram.

Maha Assembly Speaker quits, may be named state Cong chief

MUMBAI: Maharashtra Assembly Speaker Nana F Patole resigned from his post here on Thursday evening. He submitted his resignation to Deputy Speaker Narhari S Zhirwal, after a tenure of nearly 14 months in the august post.

The development comes ahead of the 57-year old Patole's likely appointment as the new President of Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee, according to party sources.

"The Congress high-command has asked me to step down from as the Speaker, which I have done accordingly. I thank the party leadership for allowing me to serve as Speaker for the people of the state," he said in brief remarks after quitting. When queried whether he would be named the next MPCC chief, Patole guardedly said: "The Congress Party has not conveyed any new responsibility to me."

She also pointed that the security challenges at India's doorstep underscore the importance of the robust partnership between both the countries. To defend the rules-based international order against actors and activities that seek to threaten it, the US has joined India and like-minded countries to counter these emerging threats.
