"Muslim Women Rights Day" organised at National Commission for Minorities office in New Delhi

Union Minister for Minority Affairs Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi today said here that commitment of the Government is "Politic Empowerment and not Political Exploitation". Several "bold and big reforms" are a reflection of our honest and effective efforts which have delivered better results, he said. Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi was addressing Muslim women from across the country through virtual conference along with Union Law Minister Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad, Union Minister for Women and Child Development Smt Smriti Irani on the occasion of "Muslim Women Rights Day". Shri Manjit Singh Rai, Vice-Chairperson, National Commission for Minorities was also present at the event. Shri Naqvi said that "1st August is a day which made Muslim women free from social evil of Triple Talaq; 1st August has been recorded in the country's history as "Muslim Women Rights Day". 1st August will remain as a golden moment of Indian democracy and Parliamentary history." Shri Naqvi said that the law which makes social evil of Triple Talaq a criminal offence has strengthened "self-reliance, self-respect and self-confidence" of the Muslim women of the country. He said that the Government has ensured gender equality and strengthened constitutional, fundamental and democratic rights of the Muslim women by bringing law against the cruel social evil of Triple Talaq. Shri Naqvi said that Triple Talaq or Talaq-a-Biddat was neither Islamic nor legal. Despite of the fact, the social evil of Triple Talaq was given "political patronage" by "Merchants of Votes".

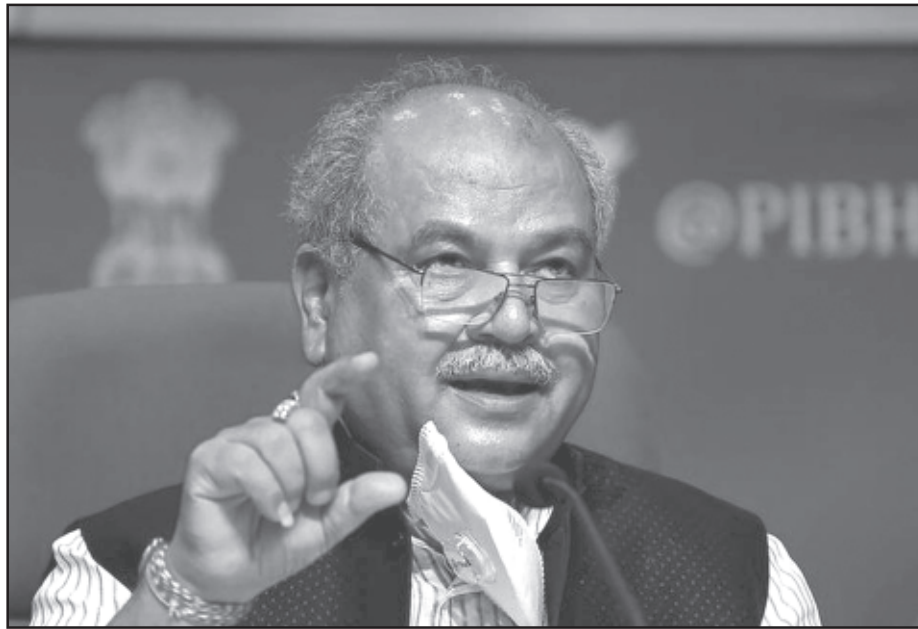
India could rise to top spot in COVID-19 cases : Chidambaram



New Delhi, Aug 1 (IPA) : Former Union Finance Minister P. Chidambaram on Friday said India could touch 55 lakh COVID-19 cases by September end if cases continued to rise at the present rate, and called the Centres strategy a 'total failure'. In a series of tweets, Mr. Chidambaram said India could rise to the top spot

going by the present rate of increase in infection. "Number of infections stand at 15,83,792 of which 9.6 lakh was recorded in July. The math is simple but frightening. At this rate, India will record over 30 lakh infections by end August 2020. If the daily rate surges, as is expected, India will record over 33 lakh infec-

Govt to spend 11.85 crore for funding 112 agri start-ups this year : Tomar



New Delhi, Aug 1 (IPA) : To promote agri firms, Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar on Friday said the government will fund 112 start-ups in the first phase with a sum of 11.85 crore in the current financial year.

The funds will be given to the start-ups selected by different knowledge partners and agribusiness incubators in the area of agro-processing, food technology and value addition, he said.

The funds will be pro-

vided under the Innovation and Agri-entrepreneurship Development Programme launched under the revamped Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY).

"In the first phase, 112 start-ups in the area of agro processing, food technology and value addition will be funded for a sum of 11.85 crore," Mr. Tomar said in a statement.

The funds will be released in instalments and the selected start-ups have been trained for two

months at 29 agribusiness incubation centres spread across India, he said. These start-ups will lead to employment opportunities for the youth. Besides, they, directly and indirectly, will contribute to enhancing the income of farmers by providing opportunities to them, he added.

The government has identified five knowledge partners as centres of excellence and 24 RKVY-RAFTAAR agribusiness incubators (R-ABIs) from across the country after a

Post lockdown, 3 Good Samaritans turn charity into business for survival

Kolkata, Aug 1 (IPA) : Turni Dhar, Debayan Datta and Swarnaditya Das — three friends who, when the lockdown was imposed in late March and their workplaces were shut, decided to keep themselves busy by turning Good Samaritans.

At a time when stepping out of home was almost unthinkable for the common citizens, not just because of the fear of COVID-19 but also because of police restrictions, they offered help to the elderly living alone, reaching them medicines and essential supplies and arranging ambulances. The work done by them was lauded so widely in Kolkata that these three hitherto unknown people earned minor celebrity.

Today, the police restrictions have eased off, but the grip of COVID-19 has only got firmer in the city,

forcing the elderly to continue staying indoors. And while businesses are gradually reopening, their workplaces still haven't.

They come from industries that are among the worst hit — Ms. Dhar works with a wine importer, Mr. Datta in a hotel, Mr. Das owns a restaurant.

While they have been generous with help during the lockdown, no one is helping them when their incomes have run dry. So they have decided to turn their charity work into business. Last week, they set up an organisation called Dependablez, through which they will continue helping the elderly living alone in the city — but this time for a cost. Their move is also a reflection of the changing nature of ventures in the new normal — before the pandemic, not many would have kept the elderly in

mind while starting a new business.

"We too need to survive," said Mr. Das, a lawyer by qualification but who always wanted to have his own business. His restaurant Hondo's, on Prince Anwar Shah Road, was just about recovering from losses when COVID-19 struck. Barely days into the lockdown he had no money to pay the rent and salaries, and soon came a down when he found it difficult to even meet his father's medical expenses. That was the time he found comfort in helping others. "When charities are doing business, it's better to do a business of helping people and not be a hypocrite about it."

Ms. Dhar said, "Our services will encourage senior citizens to live as independently as possible. Nearly a dozen clients are already on board, mostly

people who have their children living outside Kolkata or abroad. There are other companies doing this work but they are too professional in their dealings — we will provide the human touch, something we learned during the lockdown."

It was Ms. Dhar who, along with Debayan Datta, had set up a WhatsApp group called Let's Help during the lockdown. It was a great source of comfort to Indians stationed outside Kolkata or India but who had parents living in the city. "We helped about 500 families [during the lockdown] with regular supply of their daily needs and medicines. The requests are coming in even today, but it is not possible for us to keep on offering our services in an unorganised manner. That's why we set up Dependablez," said Mr. Datta.

Ram temple to be grander than planned earlier : Architect

Ahmedabad, Aug 1 (IPA) : The proposed Ram temple in Ayodhya will be almost double the size of what was originally planned as its design was modified following the Supreme Court verdict last year, its architect said on Friday.

The temple, to be constructed in Nagara style of architecture, will have five domes instead of two as envisaged earlier to accommodate more number of devotees, the architect said. According to him, the project is likely to be completed in the next three years once the work commences.

The 'bhoomi puja' (ground-breaking) ceremony of the temple in Ayodhya is scheduled to be held on August 5, which Prime

Minister Narendra Modi is likely to attend, as told by the members of the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Teertha Kshetra, a trust formed to oversee its construction.

"The design of the temple was modified after the Supreme Court verdict. Now it will be almost double the size of what was originally planned," architect Chandrakant Sompura, who has designed it, told PTI. "It will now have a shikhara (tower) over the sanctum sanctorum and five domes instead of the earlier plan of two domes. The height of the temple will also be more than what was in the previous plan," he said. In November last year, the Supreme Court had paved the way

for the construction of Ram temple at the disputed site in Ayodhya, and directed the Centre to allot an alternative five-acre plot to the Sunni Waqf Board for building a new mosque at a "prominent" place in the holy town in Uttar Pradesh. Sompura, 77, who comes from a family of temple architects that have designed over 200 such structures, said that he was asked to prepare a design for the Ram temple by late leader of the Vishva Hindu Parishad (VHP), Ashok Singhal, around 30 years ago. He said designing the Ram temple was an uphill task 30 years back, as he had to prepare drawings using his footsteps as the unit of measurement.

Cong questions Goa gov't's plan to build new Raj Bhavan

Panaji, Aug 1 (IPA) : The Congress in Goa on Friday criticised the Pramod Sawant-led BJP government over its plan to construct a new Raj Bhavan building in the state and asked for the need of it when the state was facing a cash crunch.

The chief minister had recently said that a new Raj Bhavan complex would be constructed in Goa and works like identification of land would be initiated soon. In a statement, Goa Pradesh Congress Committee (GPCC) chief Girish Chodankar alleged that the BJP government was

planning to rent out the Raj Bhavan building to a private firm to run a casino, spa and resort. "The chief minister had admitted during the one-day assembly session that the state's finances are in a bad shape. Despite that, the government announced projects like construction of new Raj Bhavan building and renovation of the Assembly complex, which need crores of rupees," he said. Hitting back at the Congress leader, Goa BJP chief Sadanand Tanavade said, "Chodankar should first know the facts before making irresponsible statements."

Monsoon session of C'garh legislature to begin on Aug 25

Raipur, Aug 1 (IPA) : The monsoon session of the Chhattisgarh legislative Assembly will begin from August 25 and will last for four days, an Assembly official said on Friday. As per an official notification, the seventh session of the fifth state Assembly will begin on August 25 and conclude on August 28.

As the session will be held amid the coronavirus crisis, precautionary guidelines for it will be issued very soon, said Chandra Shekhar Gangrade, principal secretary of the Chhattisgarh legislative Assembly. There will be Question Hour on all four days, along with works pertaining to financial and government affairs, the notification stated. On the last day, a time slot of two and a half hours has been allotted for non-government affairs, it was stated.

Govt to come out with strategic sectors list soon : FM

New Delhi, Aug 1 (IPA) : The government will soon come out with a new public sector enterprises policy that will define strategic sectors which will not have more than four PSUs, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on Saturday.

As part of the 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan' package, the finance minister in May had announced that there will be a maximum of four public sector companies in strategic sectors, and state-owned firms in other segments will eventually be privatised. "We are working on it... it should go to Cabinet soon," she said in interaction with media when asked about the strategic sector list.

She said there could be various models to achieve minimum four PSUs in case of those falling under the strategic sector.

Either they will be merged, or they will be

brought together in such a way that there are only four or lesser, she said.

Under the policy, a list of strategic sectors will be notified where there will be at least one and a maximum of four public sector enterprise, apart from private sector companies.

In other sectors, central public sector enterprises (CPSEs) will be privatised depending upon the feasibility. "We would like to announce a PSE policy (as) a self-reliant India needs a coherent policy. All sectors will be opened to private sectors also."

"PSEs will continue to play an important role in defined areas. We need a coherent policy because sometimes you open up some sectors in piecemeal... Now we shall define the areas... where their presence will be impactfully felt," Sitharaman had said while announcing the package.
