



Landslide susceptibility mapping of Mussoorie and its surrounding areas in Uttarakhand Himalaya

(By Press Information Bureau)

Like most hill townships, Mussoorie, the popular hill station in Uttarakhand, has witnessed several landslides, probably resulting from an increased spate of developmental activities. The increased disaster hazard has led scientists to map the landslide susceptibility of Mussoorie and surrounding areas, showing that 15 percent of the region is highly susceptible to landslides. Scientists from Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology (WIHG), an autonomous institute under the Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, carried out the study in Mussoorie township and its surroundings covering 84 square km in the Lesser Himalaya. They found that dominant part of the area falling under very high and high landslide susceptible zone lies in the settlement area --. Bhataghat, George Everest, Kempty fall, Khattapani, Library road, Galogidhar, and Hathipaon and are covered by highly fractured Krol limestone exhibiting slope more than 60 degrees. The Landslide Susceptibility Mapping (LSM) published in the Journal of Earth System Science also showed that about 29% of the area falls in the moderate landslide susceptible zone and 56% in low to very low landslide susceptible zone. The researchers from WIHG carried out the study using bivariate statistical Yule Coefficient (YC) method utilizing Geographic Information System (GIS) and high-resolution satellite imagery. According to their study, various possible causative factors of landslides in the study area include lithology, landuse-landcover (LULC), slope, aspect, curvature, elevation, road-cut drainage, and lineament.

Hyderabad, Sept 1 (IPA) : Some chicken traders in the old city are allegedly cheating customers by manipulating electronic weighing machines using remote controls, if the recently formed association of chicken shops is to be believed. "Few chicken shops in the city are baiting customers with low prices. Truth is that they are using remote controls to manipulate the electronic weighing scale. As a result, the customer pays for one kilogram when he is actually given only around 650 grams," said Mohammed Abid Mahmood, a member of the Hyderabad Chicken Shop Association (Old City). Another member of the association, Mohammed Jahangir, says these traders keep

the remote control in their pockets and sit a little away from the weighing scale and press the remote button. "Depending upon the quantity of the commodity, the traders switch on the remote control to over report the weight. Not only chicken shops, this malpractice is prevalent in many shops where electronic weighing scales are used," alleges Jahangir. The association says electronic weighing instruments can easily be rigged by technicians by incorporating a chip in the machine. The chip is controlled by the handheld remote.

"If one presses the button of the remote control it helps to swiftly change between the standard and non-standard modes on the machine," explains a weighing machine dealer. A Legal Metrology official said they were regularly conducting checks in markets and registering cases against traders resorting to malpractices.

Sikkim reports fourth COVID-19 death

Gangtok, Sept 1 (IPA) : A 50-year-old COVID-19 patient died in Sikkim on Monday, following which the state's toll rose to four, an official said. He had comorbid conditions, including kidney ailments, said Sonam Bhutia, the state Information, Education and Communication (IEC) officer. He was undergoing treatment at the STNM Hospital here since August 27 after being referred to by doctors of the district hospital at Singtam in East Sikkim. Meanwhile, the state has recorded 25 new COVID-19 cases in the last 24 hours, taking the tally to 1,653, Bhutia said.

Worst-hit East Sikkim reported 23 of these cases, while the other two were detected in West Sikkim. There are 424 active cases in the state at present, while 1,225 people have recovered. East Sikkim has reported 1,138 cases so far, followed by South Sikkim (468), West Sikkim (46) and North Sikkim (one), Bhutia said. The state has tested 41,069 samples for COVID-19 so far, he said.

Another association member alleged that there is malpractice in largescale deals too. "For functions, the chef asks the customer to bring a specified quantity of chicken or mutton from a particular shop. In most instances, the shopkeeper and the cook will be hand in glove and if the chef asks for 200 kilograms, the shop owner weighs about 150 kilograms. The price of the rest is shared between them," he says.

Following several complaints from the public, the association is now reaching out to traders and holding meetings asking traders to maintain a uniform price and to ensure correct measurement on the weighing scales. "We have also asked the Legal Metrology Department to conduct periodic checks at the shops," Abid Mahmood said.

A Legal Metrology official said they were regularly conducting checks in markets and registering cases against traders resorting to malpractices.

2,734 new coronavirus cases in Telangana; 9 more deaths

Hyderabad, Sept 2 (IPA) : Telangana posted 2,734 new COVID-19 cases and 9 related fatalities, taking the tally of those infected by the virus in the state to 1.27 lakh. Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) accounted for the most number of cases with 347, followed by Rangareddy 212, Nalgonda 191, Khammam 161 and Medchal Malkajgiri 121 districts, a government bulletin said on Tuesday, providing data as of 8 pm on August 31.

New Delhi, Sept 1 (IPA) : India's economy suffered its worst slump on record in April-June, with the gross domestic product (GDP) contracting by 23.9 per cent as the coronavirus-related lockdowns weighed on the already-declining consumer demand and investment. The GDP contraction in the world's fifth-largest economy compared with 3.1 per cent growth in the preceding January-March quarter and

5.2 per cent expansion in the same period a year back, according to official data released on Monday. Bengal : Elephants cross swollen river, destroy crops

Jhargram (WB), Sept 1 (IPA) : A herd of 50 wild elephants strayed into the Sankrail area in Jhargram district of West Bengal on Monday, crossing the swollen Subarnarekha river, officials said. The herd, which had several elephant calves, destroyed paddy in Rohini, Rogra and Adhari villages in the area after swimming over to the elephants despite the loss of crop and cordoned off the area, they said. Efforts were on to drive the herd back to Chandabila forest range by quick response team of the Forest Department and locals, they added.

Girl raped by minor youth in Mathura

Mathura (UP), Sept 1 (IPA) : A 10-year-old girl was allegedly raped by an adolescent in a village in Mathura district of Uttar Pradesh, police said on Monday. The girl had stepped out of her house on Saturday to buy some groceries from a nearby shop when she was waylaid by the youth and raped in a lonely place, they said.

The youth is also from the same village. An FIR has been lodged by the victim's father under Section 376 (punishment for rape) of the Indian Penal Code and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.

The accused has been arrested and sent to juvenile custody, police said. The girl underwent a medical examination and returned home to her parents, they added.

Monsoon Session to start from Sep 14 : Notification

New Delhi, Sept 1 (IPA) : Parliament's monsoon session will begin from September 14, a notification issued on Monday said. The notification issued by the Lok Sabha Secretariat said President Ram Nath Kovind has called the lower house to meet on Monday, September 14 at 9 AM. Rajya Sabha is expected to meet at a different time on the same day, as it has been decided to stagger the sitting of the two houses due to the COVID-19 guidelines. The Cabinet Committee on Parliamentary Affairs had earlier recom-

mended that the monsoon session be held from September 14 to October 1. There will be in total 18 consecutive sittings with no holiday or weekend break, according to officials. Hectic preparations are underway for the session with several first-time measures because of the COVID-19 pandemic such as testing of all MPs, staggered sitting of Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha and use of both chambers and galleries to accommodate members while following physical distancing norms, officials had said.
