NHM workers strike in Chhattisgarh escalates as 25 staffers sacked; several resign in protest

SCORES of National Health Mission (NHM) workers tendered their resignations on Friday in protest against the termination of 25 staffers amid an indefinite strike by more than 14,000 contract employees that has been going on for the last 10 days. The 25 staffers were terminated from service after they were served multiple notices to report back to work, officials said. The contract employees have been on strike since the government's explanation or grade pay like regular health workers, as well as incentives and other benefits.

Hemant Kumar Sinha, one of the leaders from the Chhattisgarh Pradesh NHM Karanchari Sangh, said, "The NHM workers have been terminated from service multiple times, including on Thursday. We have 10 demands, and our top demand is regularisation or giving us a grade pay equal to other regular health workers. Sources in the health department said officials would soon meet the protest leaders to discuss the workers' demands. "Two demands - transparency in con-

ditional report (CR) evaluation and 30 days of paid leave in cases of emergency or serious health issues - have been fulfilled. Two more demands, a 27% salary hike and a minimum of 510 lakh cashless health insurance, have also been accepted and are under process for implementation," she said.

'We are adivasis, not Hindus': Row over Cong leader's comment in MP

MADHYA PRADESH leader of Opposition Umang Singhar has stirred controversy with his remark that "tribals are not Hindus", drawing sharp criticism from the ruling BJP.

Singhar said at a Tribal Development Council event in Chhindwara on Thursday, Singhar said, "I say with pride that we are adivasis, not Hindus. I have been saying this for many years. And it was Shabari, who left the leftovers to Lord Ram; she too was an adivasi."

The four-time Congress legislator from the Bhill community, the largest tribal group in Madhya Pradesh, clarified that his comments were not meant to offend any faith.

"We do not disrespect any religion. But our community, our traditions, our culture, our heritage must be recognised," he said, adding that tribals must be accorded respect regardless of which party is in power.

Singhar said the biggest problem with the BJP is that it has never fully accepted the tribals as its own. "For years, the RSS and its affiliated organisations have been pursuing a strategy to assimilate tribals into Hinduism by calling them 'Vanvasi Hindus', thereby weakening their political autonomy and power of resistance. Their larger goal is also end of reservations," he said.

"My mission is to protect tribal identity, establish pride, and preserve culture. The BJP has always recognised tribal identity; for them, tribals are nothing more than a vote bank," Singhar said.

Singhar's remarks elicited a strong rebuke from Chief Minister Mohan Yadav, who demanded an apology from the Congress leader and his party. "It is unfortunate that the Congress always works against Hindus and Hindutva. What should be ashamed. If they raise questions on Hindutva, the public will not forgive. Congress leaders should apologise," Yadav said in a video statement.

Facing backlash, Singhar accused the BJP and its ideological mentor, the RSS, of attempting to subsume tribal identity under Hindutva. "The original inhabitants of this country are tribals. Why do the BJP or RSS want to stop us from worshipping nature? We are not disrespecting any religion. I, too, respect the Hindu religion. But when it comes to tribals, the BJP wants to implement its agenda," he said.
