Army provides food, medical aid to 3 stranded Chinese citizens in Sikkim

engaged in a fierce standoff with China's PLA in eastern Ladach, the Indian Army on Wednesday provided food, warm clothes and medical aid to 3 Chinese citizens who had lost their way in sub-zero temperatures at an altitude of 17,500 feet in a border area in North Skk im, officials said.

The Army personnel deployed in the area also guided the Chinese citizens, including a woman, to return to the Chinese side and reach their destination. The humanitarian gesture by the Army came when it is dealing with an aggressive behaviour by the Chinese troops in eastern Lad&h. The Army, in a statement, lost their way in the Plateau area of North Skk im. "Realising danger to the lives of the Chinese citizens in subzero temperatures, the soldiers of Indian Army immediately reached out and provided medical assistance including oxygen, food and warm clothes to protect them from the vagaries of extreme altitude and harsh climatic conditions," the Army said.

It said the Indian troops also gave them appropriate guidance to reach their destination after which they returned. "The Chinese citizens expressed their gratitude to India and the Indian Army for their prompt assistance," the Army said.

NEW DELHI: Terming Friday's meeting between the defence ministers as a positive step, the Chinese media said on Saturday in case of a border war, India will have no chance of winning. In an editorial on Saturday, 'Global Times', closely aligned with the ruling Chinese Communist Party, said, "We must remind the Indian side China's national strength, including its military strength, is much stronger than India's. Although China and India are both great powers, when it comes to the ultimate competition of combat capability, the Indian side will lose. If a border war starts, India will have no chance of winning. We hope the defence ministers' meet will be a turning point for the two countries to come back to the consensus of the leaders' meeting. Each side will make its due effort to reduce tensions on the border."

It has supported the meet of the Defence Ministers in Moscow on Friday. However, it seemed to point to the fact Indian policies on the border are being dictated by nationalism and public opinion.

The Mumbai-Ahmedabad bullet train project, which is scheduled to be completed by December 2023, may fail to meet its deadline due to the coronavirus pandemic that has led to delays in opening tenders and land acquisition, officials said. The National High Speed Rail Corporation (NHSRCL) has already acquired 63% of the land for the project about 77% land in Gujarat, 80% in Dadar Nagar Haveli and 22% in Maharashtra. Officials said there are still issues in acquiring land in areas lk e Palghar in Maharashtra and Navsari in Gujarat. Last year, the company had floated 9 civil work tenders, which could not be opened due to the pandemic, officials said.

"Because of Covid we had to postpone the opening of a few of the tenders. It is difficult to assess the impact of the pandemic on the project as it is still continuing. We cannot say how the pandemic will affect the project as I don't k now how long it will last," NHSRCL MD Achal Khare said.

Officially, the NHSRCL spdc esperson maintained the deadline for the project remained 2023. One of the civil work contracts for construction of stations, bridges, viaducts, maintenance depots, and tunnels across the network is to the tune of Rs20,000 crore.

Bihar to provide job to kin of SC/ST family in case of murder

Meeting was attended by the dalit and mahadalit MPs and MLAs of Bihar. Former chief minister, Jeetan Ram Manjhi welcomed the announcement of the chief minister and hoped this decision would give relief to the victims of atrocities on dalits and tribals.

However, leader of opposition in Bihar assembly, Tejaswhi Prasad Yadav regretted the decision of the chief minister and alleged Nitish k umar was playing caste card. He said if the RJD was

elected to power in November elections, the same favour would be given to the families of the back ward, extremely back ward and upper castes victims too. Rs four lachs ex gratia is paid to the families of dalits and tribals families

following murder Nitish ask ed the chief secretary to frame rules by amending the service conditions to enable implementation of the new scheme soon. He also ask ed the claw secretary to ensure, all pending cases of SC and ST atrocities were investigated by September 20. Nitish also directed the officials to create special courts and appoint special public prosecutors to defend the dalits and tribals. He ask ed the chief secretary to ensure all dalits and tribals were given houses and ration

cards without delay. Government decision came on the day, LJP president Chirag Paswan issued full page advertisements in newspaper with slogans-"They are fighting to rule over us, we are fighting to defend the pride of Bihar".

RAGINI, 11 OTHERS BOOKED

A day after her arrest, the Central Crime Branch of the Bengaluru police on Saturday named Sandalwood actor Ragini Dwevedi as the second accused in a First Information Report (FIR) that included the names of 11 others.

After initial investigation, the police named Shivapracash alias Chippi as the prime accused. Ragini Dwivedi and high-profile party planner Viren Khanna are the second and third accused persons in the case. Others named in the FIR include Prashant Ranka, Vaibhav Jain, Aditya Alva, Loum Pepper Ssamba, Prashant Raju, Ashwin alias Boogie, Abhiswamy, Rahul Tonse,

Vinay and others. However, Ragini Dwivedi's friend Ravi Shark ar and another arrested person Rahul Shetty have not been named. On Saturday, the CCB arrested Loum Pepper Samba, who was allegedly distributing drugs to the celebrities

Ragini Dwivedi and the other accused were book ed under section 120b (criminal



conspiracy) of the Indian Penal Code, and sections 21 (possession, purchase or uses any manufactured drug or any preparation containing any manufactured drug shall be punishable), 21(c) (rigorous imprisonment not less than 10 years), 27a (punishment for financing illicit traffic and harbouring offenders), 27b

Meanwhile, the name of another actor surfaced in the ongoing probe and the police are investigating. However, the actor has threatened to reveal the names of top police officials and VIPs who attend high profile parties.


