Assembly moves to form Delhi's own public service commission

New Delhi/August 07

The Delhi Assembly on the first day of its monsoon session passed a resolution to constitute a Public Service Commission for Delhi, which would empower the Aam Aadmi Party government to conduct recruitments for the vacant posts in its various departments.

The AAP legislators' decision came after a long consultation during "repeated refusal" of bureaucrats to cooperate with the political executive. Deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia alleged that a "significant attempt" is being made to "sabotage" flagship AAP government schemes such as doorstep delivery of ration and creating mohalla clinics.

Having control over services does not only mean



transfers and postings of officers.

It is also about fixing accountability of existing officers, setting up corruption and creating posts. We have

6,000 classrooms and mohalla clinics, but how will we run these facilities if there are no teachers and doctors in these buildings, Sisodia said.

Speaking in the House, revenue minister Harchand Gahlot said that he and officers are clueless about who is the acting divisional commissioner in Delhi at present. "Manish Shrivastava went on leave in July and then for a long time an order came from the service department as to who has been given the interim charge. I called up the chief secretary to ask and was told the VAT commissioner has the charge.

But when I spoke to the VAT commissioner, he said he hasn't received any order," the minister said.

Gahlot also pointed out that it was only in August that the service department issued an order appointing G. Yashendra Kumar as the interim divisional commissioner. "Such is the state of affairs that now I

am told Kumar has been on leave ever since he was given the posting August 11 onwards, and he will be on leave till the end of the month. So right now, there is nobody to monitor and review the work of various district magistrates," he said.

Gahlot also pulled up transport commissioner Varun Jodhi with whom he allegedly got into a verbal spat over corruption in

Baruti transport authority. "No institute or human is perfect. How can there be no corruption in the authority? Why not investigate the complaints instead of just saying no case of corruption was found?" Gahlot told the House.

Replying to this, Jodhi said the transport authority was he con-

tinued to "actively" clean up Baruti's transport authority. "We spent the entire weekend formulating a proposal to clean up Baruti, and we were confident of the convenience of the visiting public. We will be putting up the proposal for approval soon," she said.

The resolution that was moved by AAP MLA from Greater Kailash, Saurabh Bhadouria, stated that "there are huge number of vacancies in various levels in all sectors of governance in NCT of Delhi including in professional, technical, and administrative positions such as teaching, non-teaching, medical, engineering, school/college, hospital administration, general administration, etc which is the main reason

Two women cry for help, rob man who came to their aid near Moolchand Metro station

Two women, who allegedly used to rob commuters after seeking their help, were caught when they were trying to flee after robbing a motorcyclist of his wallet near Moolchand Metro station on Saturday night. The women, identified as Severy alias Pooja, 24, and Muskan, 23, were

chased and arrested by police staff deployed in an emergency response vehicle (ERV) of the Anand Colony police station.

The motorcyclist's wallet was recovered from them, police said.

Deputy commissioner of police (southern) Chintan Biswal said the ERV staff, including a woman constable, were

patrolling near the metro station when they heard a man screaming for help and running after two women.

The police personnel caught the women after a brief chase, said Biswal. The complainant told police that he was going home when two women, who were screaming for help, signalled him to stop. As the man stopped his bike, one of the women slapped him because of which he lost balance and fell off the motorcycle. Suddenly, the other woman took out his purse and started running away," added the DCP.

During the interrogation, Biswal said, Muskan revealed that she was a widow while Severy claimed that she was living separately from her husband. In order to earn a livelihood, the two started robbing commuters, especially men riding alone, after seeking their help. "If any man resisted, the women used to intimidate him, saying they would file a false case against him. The women have disclosed that they had robbed half a dozen men in the last two-three months. However, none of them had filed a complaint," added Biswal.



Row in Delhi Assembly over BJP MLA using 'objectionable' word against Amanatullah

A high political drama erupted in the Delhi Assembly on Monday after Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) legislator Om Prakash Sharma used an "objectionable" word against Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) legislator Amanatullah Khan during a discussion on water shortage in the national capital.

Referring the matter to the privilege committee, speaker Ram Virraj Goyal expunged the word used by Sharma from the assembly proceedings. Chief minister Arvind Kejriwal, who was not present in the House on Monday, later in a

video message to the BJP legislator, said he was not in the House on Monday. "I am not in the House on Monday," he said.

When AAP's Ghulam Khan MLA moved the motion, Sharma made some remarks against him, using an "objectionable" word. AAP legislators trooped into the Well of the House and demanded action against Sharma. They turned his remarks as an "insult of the House".
