Trump's tariff gambit: Gain or pain for US?

WASHINGTON

At a glance, US President Donald Trump appears to be winning the trade war he unleashed after returning to the White House in January, bending major trading partners to his will, imposing double-digit tariff rates on nearly all imports, narrowing the trade deficit, and raking in tens of billions of dollars a month in much-needed cash for federal government coffers.

Significant hurdles remain, however, including whether US trading partners will make good on investment and goods-purchase commitments, how much tariffs will drive up inflation or stymie demand and growth, and whether the courts allow many of his ad-hoc levies to stand.

Trading partners have largely refrained from retaliatory tariffs, sparing the global economy from a more painful tit-for-tat trade war. But recent data indicate the tariffs are already affecting jobs, growth and inflation.

"I think the growth is going

to be unprecedented," Trump said Wednesday afternoon. He added that the US was "taking in hundreds of billions of dollars in tariffs," but he couldn't provide a specific figure for revenues because "we don't even know what the final number is" regarding tariff rates. Despite the uncertainty, the White House is confident that the onset of his broad tariffs will provide clarity about the path of the world's largest economy. Now that companies understand the direction the US is headed, the Republican administration believes they can ramp up new investments and jump-start hiring in ways that can rebalance the US economy as a manufacturing power.

But so far, there are signs of self-inflicted wounds to America as companies and consumers alike brace for the impact of new taxes.

the ultimate transformations of the tariffs are unknown and could play out over months, if not years. Many economists say the risk is that the American economy is steadily eroded rather than collapsing instantly.

Trump considers imposing 100% tariff on imported chips

US President Donald Trump announced on Wednesday that the United States will impose a 100 per cent tariff on imported semiconductor chips. Focus Taiwan reported that the announcement, delivered from the Oval Office, came just hours before the country-specific tariffs were scheduled to take effect. "We'll be putting a tariff of approximately 100 per cent on chips and semiconductors," Trump said. "But if you're building in the United States of America, there's no charge."

A tariff of this magnitude could sharply raise costs for

American companies reliant on Taiwanese chips and force difficult decisions for Taiwanese manufacturers trying to stay competitive in the US market. Taiwan, home to the world's largest contract chipmaker, Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co. (TSMC), plays a pivotal role in the global supply chain. Its advanced chip technologies are indispensable to everything from iPhones to fighter jets.

Earlier, a government-affiliated think tank, as per a separate report by Focus Taiwan, had said, "The US should prioritise strengthening semiconductor cooperation with Taiwan."

China backs Brazil

Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi has slammed the US for imposing tariffs on other countries. "Using tariffs as a weapon to suppress other countries violates the UN Charter, undermines WTO rules, and is both unpopular and unsustainable," Wang Yi said during a phone call with Celso Amorim, chief advisor to Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva.

This was revealed by Chinese envoy to India, Xu Feihong, in a post on his official X account. "Give the bully an inch, he will take a mile," Xu said in the post.

The Chinese reaction came after Lula turned down US President Trump's offer to call him anytime to discuss tariffs. "Trump does not want to talk," Lula said, adding: "I will call Xi Jinping, I will call PM Modi. I won't call Putin, because he can't travel now. But I will call many presidents."

Woman jailed for 20 years to get \$1.3 mn

An Australian state government's decision to pay 2 million Australian dollars (USD 1.3 million) compensation to a woman who spent 20 years in prison after being wrongfully convicted of killing her four children was condemned by her lawyer Thursday as "profoundly unjust."

New South Wales Attorney-General Michael Daley said Thursday that Kathleen Folbigg's lawyers had been told the sum the 58-year-old would be paid more than two years after she was released from prison.

Myanmar's acting Prez Myint dies

Myint Swe, who became Myanmar's acting president under controversial circumstances after the military seized power from the elected government of Aung San Suu Kyi more than four years ago, died on Thursday, the military said. He was 74. He died at a military hospital in the capital, Naypyitaw, on Thursday morning, according to a statement from Myanmar's military information office.

Boat migrants caught under new UK treaty

The UK government said on Thursday that border force officials have begun detaining migrants who arrive on the country's shores illegally on dangerous small boats as a new treaty becomes operational for returning some of them back across the English Channel to France. The Home Office said detentions under the so-called "one in, one out" pilot scheme began on Wednesday afternoon.

Japan deploys its first F-35B fighter jets

Japan's first three F-35B stealth fighter jets arrived on Thursday at an air base in the south of the country, its latest move to fortify defences as tensions in the region grow. The new arrivals are three of the four F-35Bs scheduled for deployment at Nyutabaru Air Base in Miyazaki prefecture.

'Israel to take control of all of Gaza'

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Thursday Israel intends to take military control of all of Gaza, despite intensifying criticism at home and abroad over the devastating almost two-year-old war in the Palestinian enclave.

"We intend to," Netanyahu said in an interview with Fox News Channel's Bill Hemmer when asked if Israel would take over the entire coastal territory. "We don't want to keep it. We want to have a security perimeter. We don't want to govern it. We don't want to be there as a governing body."

He said that Israel wanted to hand over the territory to Arab forces that would govern it. He

did not elaborate on the governance arrangements or which Arab countries could be involved. Netanyahu made the comments to Fox News shortly before a meeting he was due to have on Thursday with a small group of senior ministers to discuss plans for the military to take control of more territory in Gaza. The security cabinet session follows another meeting this week with the head of the military, which Israeli officials have described as tense, saying the military chief had pushed back on expanding the campaign. Total control of the territory would reverse a 2005 decision by Israel by which it withdrew Israeli citizens and soldiers from Gaza, while retaining control over its borders, airspace and utilities.

United Airlines' tech outage grounds 800 flights across US

More than 800 United Airlines flights were cancelled and hundreds more delayed by late Wednesday following a major technology outage that forced a systemwide ground stop across the United States, severely disrupting both domestic and international travel.

At Houston's George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH), where United operates a key hub, long lines and frustrated passengers filled terminals. The airline traced the



outage to failures in its dispatch and fuelling systems. "Due to a technology issue, we are holding United mainline flights at their departure airports," United said in a statement. "We expect additional flight delays this evening as we work through this issue."

Pak Army chief may visit US again

Pakistan Army chief Asim Munir is expected to visit the US this week for consultations with top American officials, his second trip to Washington since the four-day conflict with India, a media report said on Thursday.

In June, Munir travelled to the US on a rare five-day trip during which he attended a private luncheon with President Donald Trump. That meeting culminated in Trump's announcement of



enhanced US-Pakistan cooperation in various fields, including an oil deal. Field Marshal Munir is expected in the US this week for consultations with his American counterparts, Dawn newspaper reported, citing official sources. Sources told the paper that this would be a return visit, following a trip to Pakistan by Gen. Michael Erik Kurilla, head of the US Central Command (CENTCOM), in late July.

3 killed, 13 hurt in Pak blast

At least three people were killed and 13 others, including three police personnel, injured in a bomb blast in northwestern Pakistan's Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on

Thursday, police said. District Police Officer Tahir Shah said the improvised explosive device (IED) blast occurred close to a police patrol vehicle near a taxi stand in Wana tehsil in South Waziristan district. Two people were killed on the spot.

Racial attack on PIO girl, 6, in Ireland

An Indian-origin nurse who has been working in Ireland for eight years is distraught after her six-year-old daughter was attacked by a group of boys while she played outside her home in the city of Waterford. "One of her friends said a gang of boys older than them hit her on the private parts with a cycle, and five of them punched her on her face... They said the F word and 'Dirty Indian, go back to India,'" Anupa Achuthan, originally from Kerala and now an Irish citizen, told the 'Irish Mirror', recounting the attack on her Ireland-born daughter Nia Naveen on Monday evening. Naveen later told her mother that the boys, aged between eight and 14, punched her neck and twisted her hair.
