## 'Ideal Indian wife'...

On the petitioner's contention that the wife was not ready to fulfill her marital obligation, the court said it was 'falsified by the fact' that they have a son who is now major. As to the claim that she accused him of illicit relations with a woman colleague, the court said it could not be treated as cruelty, considering her situation.

In sheer frustration she... entertains apprehension, alleging that husband is having some romantic relationship with another woman, therefore, he was not taking her to live with him, the court said, adding that she did not make the allegation publicly but only in response to his divorce plea. The husband had sought divorce claiming the wife showed no interest in marital relations, accused him of illicit relationships and drinking alcohol. The wife denied the charges, saying he was seeking divorce on false grounds.

## Modi, Putin to deepen...

We also reviewed the progress in our bilateral agenda, and reaffirmed our commitment to further deepen the India-Russia Special and Privileged Strategic Partnership. I look forward to hosting President Putin in India later this year."

On Wednesday, U.S. President Donald Trump signed an executive order adding an extra 25% levy on Indian goods—specifically over New Delhi's continued purchase of Russian oil — taking total duties to 50%. The new rate, among the highest imposed by the U.S. on any nation, will take effect on August 27.

## Over 20 'missing'...

A woman from Ambala Cantonment said her husband, Kesar Yadav, went missing after the Kawad Yatra, which was led by Pradeep Mishra and had taken out from Sewan River to Kubereshwar Dham.

Lakhs of people from different parts of the country and state participated in the Yatra. A devotee from Hapur in UP, Ramkumar Tomar, said the wife of his younger brother, 22-year-old Chanchal, went missing on August 6. He said he had requested the temple committee to check the CCTV, but they did not do so. He also alleged that the police were not cooperating with him. SP Deepak Shukla also confirmed that some people were separated from their family members, and a search was underway to locate them, and they would soon join their families.

## CS summons collector, SP...

the organiser of the event, Pradeep Mishra's, failure to make proper arrangements for the occasion — which led to the deaths of seven people — have come to light.

The officers also informed Jain that a stampede led to the death of two persons on the first day of the event.

Five other deaths occurred because of illness, anxiety and the presence of a huge crowd. As Mishra has political patronage, the administration could not act against him. Some administrative officers have been blamed for the mismanagement. According to sources, the axe may fall on some officers in Sehore because of the deaths. Feedback is also collected about the permission given to the organiser for holding the event.

The distribution of Rudraksha (sacred beads) was banned after some deaths occurred due to mismanagement on earlier occasions.

Feedback on how the permission was taken for the event is also collected.

Chief Minister Mohan Yadav took feedback on the incident through intelligence. The government will after receiving the intelligence report.

## SC relief for Saif in...

The High Court found that the trial court had relied on a judgment overturned by the Supreme Court in Talat Fatima Hasan vs Syed Murataza Ali Khan (2019), which held that succession must be decided as per personal law. Invoking Order 14 Rule 23A CPC, the High Court remanded the matter for a fresh decision. The petitioners have now approached the Supreme Court challenging the remand. Senior Advocate Rupesh Kumar said, "SC has granted interim stay on MPHC order which had remanded the matter back to the trial court. There was no case of remand made out either by the plaintiff or by the defendant."

## Shankar-Ehsaan-Loy...

The remaining awards, which include the National Information Technology Award, National Nirmal Verma Award, and National Hindi Seva Award, will be presented on the occasion of Hindi Day in Bhopal on September 14.

## 'Vote chori' rally in ...

Kharge, accused the Commission of colluding with the BJP in electoral malpractices, Leader of Opposition in Parliament Rahul Gandhi limited his speech to posing five questions to the Election Commission. Following the rally, Deputy Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar, along with KPCC Working President G.C. Chandrashekhar and BDA Chairman N.A. Harris went to the Election Commission office and submitted a memorandum.

## BEO held in Rs 20 cr...

The officers of the investigating agency also reached the residences of Kamal Rathore's three relatives located in Alirajpur, Ambua and Kathiwada. Rathore is accused of embezzling more than Rs 20 crore.

## Scindia holds Diggy's...

There was always a gap between the two leaders. But it widened after Scindia joined the BJP and pulled down the Congress government in the state. After the fall of the Congress government, Digvijaya opened a front against Scindia and called him a traitor. As both of them belong to the same constituency, they often make political statements against each other. A video of Scindia holding the hands of Digvijaya went viral on social media.

## Allahabad HC judges'...

On August 4, a bench of Justices J.B. Pardiwala and R. Mahadevan had ruled that Justice Kumar should not be assigned criminal matters for the remainder of his tenure, remarking that such orders "make a mockery of the justice system" and expressing bewilderment over "what is happening at the High Court level in the Indian judiciary."

In Friday's hearing, the bench clarified that its intention had not been to embarrass or personally target the judge but to uphold the dignity of the judiciary. The court said the comments were being expunged following the CJI's intervention and left it to the Allahabad High Court Chief Justice — as the "master of the roster" — to decide on any administrative action.

## GROWTH DRIVE | Union Cabinet approves fuel subsidy and compensation for LPG consumers and marketers; announces infrastructure &amp; devpt projects

## Cabinet's over ₹50k cr bonanza

The Union Cabinet on Friday approved Rs 30,000 crore as compensation to public sector oil marketing companies for losses in domestic LPG, announced fuel subsidy worth Rs 12,000 crore for LPG consumers while also giving its nod to three development and infrastructure projects worth over Rs 11,600 crore.

## SUPPORT TO OMCs FOR UNDER-RECOVERIES

The most significant decision taken by the Cabinet, in a meeting chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, pertained to approving compensation worth Rs 30,000 crore to IOCL, BPCL and HPCL for the under-recoveries incurred in sale of domestic LPG. The compensation will be paid through the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas in 12 tranches.

The Cabinet said the decision was necessitated because international prices of LPG remained at high levels during 2024-25 and continue to remain high. However, to insulate consumers from fluctuations in international LPG prices, the increase in cost was not passed on to them which led to significant losses to the three OMCs. This compensation, it said, will allow the OMCs to continue meeting their critical requirements such as crude

and LPG procurement, servicing of debt, and sustaining their capital expenditure.

## SPL DEVELOPMENT PACKAGES FOR ASSAM AND TRIPURA

The Cabinet also approved four new components of Special Development Packages (SDPs) under the existing central schemes for Assam and Tripura with a total outlay of Rs 4,250 crore. The government of Assam will contribute another Rs 3,000 crore for these schemes.

It said out of this amount Rs 500 crore will be allocated for development of infrastructure in Adivasi inhabited villages/areas of Assam as per agreement signed between the Centre & Assam Government.

Another Rs 500 crore has been sanctioned for development of infrastructure in the North Cachar Hills Autonomous Council (NCHAC) area of Dimas National Liberation Army/ Dimas People's Supreme Council inhabited areas of Assam.

The approvals also cover Rs 3,000 crore for development of infrastructure in keeping with the pact between the Centre and Assam Government with the ULFA groups. Besides, Rs 250 crore has been approved for development of tribals of Tripura as per the agreement with the National Liberation Front of Tripura (NLFT) and All Tripura Tiger Force (ATTF) groups.

## FOUR LANE ROAD PRO-

## Rs 4,200 cr for technical edu

The Cabinet also approved an outlay of Rs 4,200 crore for implementation of the 'Multidisciplinary Education and Research Improvement in Technical Education' (MERITE) Scheme in 275 technical institutions comprising 175 engineering institutions and 100 polytechnics. The objective of the scheme, it said, is to improve the quality, equity and governance in technical education and to implement interventions that align it with the National Educational Policy-2020 (NEP-2020).

## JECT APPROVED IN TNPUDUCHERRY

The Cabinet also took a purely infrastructure related decision as it approved the construct of the 4-lane Marakkanam - Puducherry (NH-332A) in Tamil Nadu at a cost of Rs 2,157 crore.

The project will upgrade approximately 46 km of NH-332A from Marakkanam to Puducherry to a 4-lane road thereby decongesting the existing corridor and improving connectivity to Chennai, Puducherry Viluppuram and Nagapattinam.

The 34.7 km road project, the Cabinet said, will also play a pivotal role in regional economic growth and boost tourism to Puducherry.



## RS 12,000 CRORE FOR TARGETED SUBSIDY FOR LPG CYLINDERS

In another fuel related decision, the Cabinet approved a targeted subsidy of Rs.300 for every 14.2 kg LPG cylinder for up to 9 refills per year to the beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) during FY 2025-26. It allocated Rs 12,000 crore for this.

Stating that PMUY was launched in 2016 to provide deposit-free LPG connection to adult women from poor households, the Cabinet said there are about 10.33 crore connections. While at present the first refill and stove is also provided free of cost to all beneficiaries. In 2022, the Centre had started providing subsidy for up to 12 refills per annum, which it said has resulted in improved per capita consumption of gas.

## Over 53 hrs lost to disruptions in Rajya Sabha

As both Houses of Parliament again witnessed loud protests by the Opposition for seeking an end to and a discussion on the Special Intensive Revision of electoral rolls in Bihar, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju recalled a resolution passed in 1997 in the Rajya Sabha which had on the occasion of the golden jubilee of Independence urged the members to at least maintain the inviolability of the Question Hour.

Rijiju also regretted the loss of work due to the protests. He said the Deputy Chairman Hariwansh had observed on August 7 that, "During the current Session, we had the opportunity to take up 180 Starred Questions, 180 Zero Hour submissions, and 180 Special Mentions on various important issues so far. However, due to continuous disruptions, we have been able to take up only 13 Starred Questions, 5 Zero Hour submissions, and 17 Special Mentions." Hariwansh had added that "because of the disruptions, we have lost 53 hours and 21 minutes of this session (Monsoon) so far."

As the day again saw the Opposition moving into the well of both houses, leading to multiple adjournments, Rijiju wrote in a post on "X" that "Even the Upper House (Rajya Sabha) has become the victim of disruptions."

## TWO CRPF JAWANS INJURED IN IED BLAST

RANCHI: At least two jawans of the Central Reserve Police Force were injured in an IED blast in Chaibasa in Jharkhand's West Singhbhum district, police said on Friday. The incident occurred around noon in the Mankey area near Jaraikeela in Saranda forest, one of Asia's thickest forests.
