## Media Release

### **Eraaya Lifespaces Limited Secures Comprehensive Judicial Protection against false claims and frivolous pleas filed by Mr. Robin Raina's based on a Forged Document.**

**New Delhi, January 10, 2026:** Eraaya Lifespaces Limited ("Eraaya" or the "Company") is pleased to inform that the Hon'ble District Judge (Commercial Court), Delhi, has passed a detailed and reasoned order dated 7th January 2026 in CS (Comm.) No. 1099 of 2024, rejecting the Arbitration Plea filed by Mr. Robin Raina based on the Disputed Document and granting several interim reliefs in favour of the Company and its global subsidiaries operating under Ebix Inc.

The litigation between the Company and Mr. Raina emanates from a disputed document, which the Company has consistently maintained to be forged and fabricated and not binding upon it in any manner. Based on this disputed document, multiple attempts have been made by Mr. Raina to lodge false and untenable claims, including repeated efforts to invoke arbitration proceedings.

The Hon'ble Court has dismissed the application filed by Mr. Robin Raina under Section 8 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ("Act"), holding that no prima facie valid or enforceable arbitration agreement exists in relation to the disputed document dated 16<sup>th</sup> August 2024, the execution, authenticity, and legitimacy of which have been expressly denied by the Company.

The Hon'ble Court has further allowed the Company's application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 granting interim injunctive protection to safeguard the Company's corporate governance, management authority, and assets pending disposal of the suit.

In arriving at its conclusion, the Hon'ble Commercial Court has taken judicial note of the fact that earlier attempts to invoke arbitration on the same basis have been rejected at multiple judicial levels, including:

- Dismissal of the petition under Section 9 of the Act by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court; and
- Dismissal of the petition under Section 11 of the Act and subsequent Review Petition by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India;

The Court observed that these outcomes clearly negate the absence of prima facie satisfaction as to the existence of any arbitration agreement.

Significantly, by the present order, the Hon'ble Commercial Court has also restrained and enjoined Mr. Robin Raina from seeking or pursuing any reliefs, remedies, or proceedings of any nature founded upon or arising out of the disputed document, thereby staying all claims premised on the said document and affording comprehensive protection to the Company.

This order reinforces the Company's commitment to robust corporate governance, judicial accountability, and the rule of law, and decisively puts an end to repetitive and unfounded proceedings based on a document whose validity has been consistently rejected by courts of competent jurisdiction.
