1. ISSUE CREATE AND ALLOT 33,27,778 EQUITY SHARES TO PROMOTER & PUBLIC (NON-PROMOTER) ON PREFERENTIAL BASIS.

To consider and, if thought fit, to give your assent or dissent to the following resolution as a Special Resolution:

"RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 23, 42, 62 and all other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'), the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014, the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 and other applicable Rules made there under (including any statutory modification(s) or reenactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force) and in accordance with the enabling provisions of the Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association of the Company, and subject to the provisions of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended up to date ('SEBI (ICDR) Regulations'), the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended up to date, as in force and subject to other applicable Rules / Regulations / Guidelines / Notifications / Circulars and clarifications issued thereunder, if any, from time to time by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), the Reserve Bank of India and/ or any other competent authorities to the extent applicable, the Listing Agreements entered into by the Company with the Stock Exchanges where the equity shares of the Company are listed and subject to the approval(s), consent(s), permission(s) and/or sanction(s), if any, of the appropriate authorities, institutions or bodies as may be required, and subject to such conditions as may

“RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the minimum price of the Equity shares issued shall not be less than the price arrived at in accordance with Chapter V of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations for preferential issue, being the highest of the following:

- a) The 90 trading Days’ volume weighted average price of the Company’s Equity Shares quoted on the Stock Exchange BSE, being the Stock Exchange in which the shares of the company is listed preceding the “Relevant Date”; or
- b) The 10 trading Days’ volume weighted average prices of the Company’s Equity Shares quoted on the Stock Exchange, BSE being the Stock Exchange in which the shares of the company’s listed volume has been recorded during the said period) preceding the “Relevant Date”; or
- c) The price determined under the valuation report obtained by the Company from an independent registered valuer in terms of Regulation 166A of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, a copy whereof is posted on the website of the Company.

“RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in accordance with the provision of Chapter V of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, the “Relevant Date” for the purpose of calculating the floor price for the Preferential Issue of Equity shares be and is hereby fixed as April 9, 2025, being the date preceding the day 30 days prior to the date of passing of the Special Resolution by Members since the relevant date falls on a holiday.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT without prejudice to the generality of the above resolution, the issue of the Equity Shares under the Preferential Allotment shall be subject to the following terms and conditions apart from others as prescribed under applicable laws:

- a) The Equity Shares to be allotted shall be fully paid up and rank pari passu with the existing Equity Shares of the Company in all respects (including with respect to dividend and voting powers) from the date of allotment thereof, be subject to the requirements of all applicable laws and shall be subject to the provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company.
- b) The Equity Shares shall be subject to lock-in for such period as specified in the provisions of Chapter V of the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations and be listed on the Stock Exchange(s) subject to receipt of necessary permission(s), sanction(s) and approval(s).
- c) The Equity Shares shall be allotted in dematerialized form within a period of 15 days from the date of passing of the special resolution by the Members, provided that where the

allotment of Equity Shares is subject to receipt of any approval(s) or permission(s) from any regulatory authority or Government of India, the allotment shall be completed within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of last of such approval or permission.

d) The Equity Shares to be allotted shall be listed on the stock exchanges where the existing equity shares of the Company are listed, subject to the receipt of necessary regulatory permissions and approvals.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT for the purpose of giving effect to this Resolution, the Board be and is hereby authorised to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may, in its absolute discretion, deem necessary, desirable or expedient, including without limitation, issuing clarifications, resolving all questions of doubt, effecting any modifications or changes to the foregoing (including modification(s) to the terms of the issue), entering into contracts, arrangements, agreements, documents (including for appointment of agencies, intermediaries and advisors for the Issue) and to authorize all such persons as may be necessary, in connection therewith and incidental thereto as the Board in its absolute discretion may deem appropriate, without being required to seek any fresh approval of the Members and to settle all questions, difficulties or doubts that may arise in regard to the offer, issue and allotment of the Equity Shares and listing thereof with the Stock Exchanges as appropriate, take all other steps which may be incidental, consequential, relevant or ancillary in this connection and to effect any modification to the foregoing and the decision of the Board shall be final and conclusive.

1. Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act"), in respect of the Special Business to be transacted is annexed hereto.
2. The Postal Ballot Notice is being sent only by email to all the Members, whose names appear on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as received from National Securities Depository Limited ('NSDL') and Central Depository Services(India) Limited ('CDSL') as on Friday, 04.04.2025 (the 'cut-off date') and who have registered their email addresses in respect of electronic holdings with the Depository through the concerned Depository Participants and in respect of physical holdings with the Company's Registrar and Share Transfer Agent, Purva Shareregistry (India) Private Limited ("RTA").
3. In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 and Section 110 of the Act read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time, Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations, SS-2 and MCA Circulars, the Company is pleased to provide members, facility to exercise their right to vote on the resolutions sent through the Postal Ballot by electronic means. The Company has engaged e-voting services provided by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for this postal ballot.
4. The Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot Form containing the process and instructions is being sent to all the Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / list of beneficial owners as received from National Securities Depository Limited ('NSDL') / Central Depository Services (India) Limited ('CDSL') on April 04, 2025.
5. Members whose names appear on the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as on Friday, April 04, 2025, will be considered for the purpose of voting. A person who is not a Member as on Friday, April 04, 2025, i.e. the 'cut-off date for reckoning voting rights should treat this Notice for information purpose only. Members may note that the Postal Ballot Notice will be available on the Company's website www.suprapacific.com, websites of the Stock Exchanges i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com, and on the website of CDSL, the e-Voting Service Provider (ESP).
8. The Board of Directors have appointed CS Vivek Kumar, Partners, M/s. DV & Associates, Practising Company Secretaries, as Scrutinizer for conducting voting process in a fair and transparent manner.

9. ~~Members may vote on the postal ballot from Friday, April 11, 2025 to Saturday, May 10, 2025.~~ In terms of the requirements of SEBI Circular, the e-voting period begins at 09.00 A.M. (IST) on Friday, April 11, 2025 and ends at 5.00 P.M. (IST) Saturday, May 10, 2025. Thereafter, the e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL.

10. Pursuant to SEBI Circular, e-Voting process has been enabled to all the individual demat account holders, by way of single login credential, through their demat accounts/websites of Depositories/Depository Participants (DPs) in order to increase the efficiency of the voting process.

11. Individual demat account holders would be able to cast their vote, thereby not only facilitating seamless authentication but also ease and convenience of participating in e-Voting process. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and e-mail ID with their DPs to access e-Voting facility.

12. The Scrutiniser will submit his report after completion of the scrutiny on or before 5.00 P.M. on Tuesday, May 13, 2025 and the results of the voting by postal ballot (including voting through electronic means) will be declared on or before Tuesday, May 13, 2025. The results along with the Scrutiniser's report shall be available on Company's website, www.suprapacific.com and shall also be communicated to the Stock Exchanges.

13. The resolution shall be taken as passed on the last date specified by the Company for receipt of duly completed postal ballot form and e-voting.

14. Voting rights shall be reckoned on the paid-up value of shares registered in the name of the Member as on Friday, April 04, 2025. Members can vote for their entire voting rights as per their discretion.

15. Relevant documents referred to in the accompanying notice are open for inspection by the Members at the Registered Office of the Company on all working days.

VOTING THROUGH ELECTRONIC MEANS

THE INSTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING:

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

Step 2 : Access through CDSL e-Voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and non-individual shareholders in demat mode.

- (i) The voting period begins on Friday, April 11, 2025 at 9.00 AM and ends on to Saturday, May 10, 2025 at 5.00PM. During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date 04.04.2025 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- (iii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

- (iv) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

- 2) Click on "Shareholders" module.

However, shareholders holding shares in demat form will now reach 'Password Creation' menu wherein they are required to mandatorily enter their login password in the new password field. Kindly note that this password is to be also used by the demat holders for voting for resolutions of any other company on which they are eligible to vote, provided that company opts for e-voting through CDSL platform. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential.

(iv) For shareholders holding shares in physical form, the details can be used only for e-voting on the resolutions contained in this Notice.

(v) Click on the EVSN for the relevant <Company Name> on which you choose to vote.

(vi) On the voting page, you will see "RESOLUTION DESCRIPTION" and against the same the option "YES/NO" for voting. Select the option YES or NO as desired. The option YES implies that you assent to the Resolution and option NO implies that you dissent to the Resolution.

(vii) Click on the **RESOLUTIONS FILE LINK** if you wish to view the entire Resolution details.

(viii) After selecting the resolution, you have decided to vote on, click on "SUBMIT". A confirmation box will be displayed. If you wish to confirm your vote, click on "OK", else to change your vote, click on "CANCEL" and accordingly modify your vote.

(ix) Once you "CONFIRM" your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

(x) You can also take a print of the votes cast by clicking on "Click here to print" option on the Voting page.

(xi) If a demat account holder has forgotten the login password then Enter the User ID and the image verification code and click on Forgot Password & enter the details as prompted by the system.

(xii) There is also an optional provision to upload BR/POA if any uploaded, which will be made available to scrutinizer for verification.

(xiii) **Additional Facility for Non – Individual Shareholders and Custodians –For Remote Voting only.**

- Non-Individual shareholders (i.e. other than Individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) and Custodians are required to log on to www.evotingindia.com and register themselves in the "Corporates" module.

Currently, SEBI ICDR Regulations provides that the pricing for the issue of securities on preferential basis by a listed Company is to be based on the following parameters:

a) In case of “frequently traded shares (Regulation 164(1) of the SEBI ICDR Regulations:

If the equity shares of the Company have been listed on a recognised stock exchange for a period of 90 trading days or more as on the relevant date, the price of the equity shares to be allotted pursuant to the preferential issue shall be not less than higher of the following;

a. the 90 trading days’ volume weighted average price of the related equity shares quoted on the recognised stock exchange preceding the relevant date; or

Provided that the floor price, in such cases, shall be higher of the floor price determined under sub-regulation (1), (2) or (4) of regulation 164, as the case may be, or the price determined under the valuation report from the independent registered valuer or the price determined in accordance with the provisions of the Articles of Association of the issuer, if applicable:

Articles of Association of the Company do not provide for any particular method of determination which results in a floor price higher than that determined under SEBI ICDR Regulations.
