- c) There shall be no change in extant provisions regarding preparation of second reservation charts.
- d) These instructions also cover charting at remote locations.

Young Indian players have shown they are capable of winning in English conditions: Vengsarkar

MUMBAI, JULY 9/--/ It was crucial for "world-class" Shubman Gill to score truckload of runs to "call the shots" as skipper, former India batter Dilip Vengsarkar said here on Wednesday, adding that young players showed that they are capable of taking Indian cricket forward.

India bounced back to pummel England by 336 runs in the second Test to level the five-Test series 1-1, after starting the tour with a disappointing five-wicket loss in Leeds.

Gill has been at the forefront of India's attack, amassing a mind-boggling 585 runs in only four innings with three centuries, the highest score being a stunning 269.

"He did very well as a captain, as a batsman, it was very important that he scored runs so that he can call the shots and he can lead from the front, which is very important and he has done that," Vengsarkar told the media.

"He is an experienced player. He is a world-class batsman and he that showed in England. Because of the English conditions, everybody was thinking what will happen to the Indian team in the absence of Rohit Sharma and Virat Kohli.

"But these young players have shown that they are capable of doing it and I am

very proud of them," he said during the launch of Mumbai's Cricketing season 2025-26.

Gill's tally of 585 runs in four innings puts him on track to do the unthinkable — to break the record for all-time highest run-tally by any batter in Test history —



set by Sir Donald Bradman when he hammered 974 runs in the 1930 Ashes.

By his lofty standards, Gill is 390 runs behind and Vengsarkar said it is possible for the 25-year-old to rewrite the record.

"Well, he is in great form and he is an outstanding batsman. I hope he does that.

I don't know whether he will do it, but I am sure that he has got an opportunity. He is in great form and he should do it, that's what I feel."

"But then, what is important is not (get into chasing) personal milestone. Because we are obsessed with personal milestone, which is wrong. The important (point) is to win matches for our country. That is what matters. And the impact of



innings or a spell is what matters in the ultimate analysis," he said.

Without taking any names, Vengsarkar said India have done well in the first two Tests without some of the key players.

"India have performed very well and if they win at Lord's it will make a lot of difference. I expect them to win at Lord's and go 2-1," he said.

"You should not pay much heed to the slope, rather you should play every ball on its merit. Our

Germany through to Euro 2025 quarterfinals after coming from behind to beat Denmark 2-1

BASEL, July 9/--/ Lea Schüller scored again as Germany beat Denmark 2-1 on Tuesday, which secured a place in the knockout stage of the Women's European Championship. Sweden's subsequent 3-0 win over Poland means Sweden and Germany are assured of the top two places after their winning starts to Group C, leaving Poland and Denmark with no chance of making the quarterfinals.

Germany, the eight-time winner, needed to come from behind after Amalie Vangsgaard scored against the run of play for Denmark in the 26th.

VAR calls had gone against the favorites until referee Catarina Ferreira Campos awarded a penalty for Katrine Veje's 53rd-minute foul on Linda Dallmann.

Sjoeke Nüsken stayed cool to equalize from the spot, and Jule Brandt set up Schüller to sweep in the winner in the 66th. Brandt had scored and set up Schüller for the other goal

in Germany's opening 2-0 win over Poland.

Schüller had endured a difficult game until she scored.

"I don't know what's up with Lea," said Germany coach Christian Wück, who said he and his coaching staff were thinking of substituting the forward.

"It's like she knows she's about to come off so she scores a goal," Wück said. "But exactly what sets apart a goalscorer, that you don't notice her much. I heard she actually didn't have any ball-contact in the penalty box and the first half, but then she's there and scores that goal, which wasn't easy either."

There was a brief hold-up later while the referee received treatment for an apparent right leg injury, shortly after Denmark's Emma Snerle had to go off after being hit in the face by a powerful shot.

The win moved Germany to six points from two games in Group C, behind Sweden on goal difference. They meet in

Salt's bat used in IPL cleared by authorities after it initially failed 'gauge test' for size

LONDON, JULY 9/--/ England white-ball opener Phil Salt's bat, which he used in the last two years including in the Indian Premier League, was initially deemed "to have failed an on-field gauge test" but later cleared after further examination, his club said. The 28-year-old Salt currently plays for Lancashire. He played a major role in Royal Challengers Bengaluru's maiden IPL title win earlier in the year, scoring 403 runs from 13 matches, the second highest for his team after Virat Kohli (657 from 15 matches).

Lancashire Cricket in a statement said that the bat used by Salt during Friday's Vitality Blast T20 match against Northants Steelbacks has been cleared by the Cricket Regulator's Anti-Corruption Unit (ACU). "Salt was alleged to have breached ECB Directives 3.2 and 3.3, after

his bat failed an on-field bat-gauge test during the Vitality Blast fixture. It is a bat that he has used for the last two years for England, Lancashire and in the IPL with no issue," the club said in the statement. During the first over of Lancashire Lightning's run chase, an umpire conducted an on-field bat gauge test, as part of an assurance process undertaken to check the sizes of a bat being used. To pass the test, the bat must fit through a gauge of the specified size.

"Salt's bat did not pass through the gauge on the field and was therefore deemed to have failed the test, and in further tests carried out after the match, it was deemed inconclusive despite the bat fitting through the gauge on several occasions.

"The Club and player felt this should have been the end of the matter, but the officials felt it necessary for the bat to be taken away for further testing," the club said. "Following this evidential testing process undertaken by the Cricket Regulator, the bat was found to be compliant with the Regulations - and the Club and player have been informed that no further action will be taken."

The club said the "whole process could have been avoided with improved processes on and off the field, whether that be through better equipment and/or additional training".

"Following the incident there have been inappropriate comments made by match commentators, inaccurate articles written in the media and some unsavoury social media posts towards the player, that could have been avoided." Cricket Regulator, the body established by the ECB and responsible for monitoring and enforcing the game's regulations, said Salt's bat was subject to an on-field test and it did not pass the initial test during the July 4 match between Northamptonshire and Lancashire.

"Following standard practice the bat was then subject to a post-match test, the results of which were inconclusive," it said. "On 7th July, the Cricket Regulator investigated the matter and found the bat to be compliant with the regulations. Accordingly no further action will be taken against the player or Lancashire in this matter."

Salt has so far played 33 ODIs after making debut in 2021, scoring 988 runs at an average of 31.87 with one hundred. He has featured in 43 T20Is from which he has scored 1193 runs with three centuries at an average of 34.08 and strike rate of 164.32. (PTI)
