## Two more RRTS corridors linking Haryana towns get central nod

**New Delhi:** The two Namoo Bharat (RRTS) corridors that will cut down travel time to Gurgaon, Rewari, Sonapat, Panipat and Karnal have received the go-ahead from an inter-ministerial panel at the Centre. The proposals, with a cumulative cost of Rs 65,000 crore, will now be placed before the Union Cabinet for approval.

The green signal for these projects from the Public Investment Board (PIB) last week gains significance as it had been pending for long because of the Centre and then AAP govt in Delhi not being on the same page over funding issues.

As per the proposal of housing and urban affairs ministry, the 93-km Sarai Kale Khan to Bawal RRTS will cost Rs 32,000 crore, and the 136-km link to Karnal from Sarai Kale Khan will require an investment of Rs 33,000 crore. TOI has learnt that the panel headed by Union expenditure secretary has recommended that the participating states — Delhi and Haryana — work out value capture financing (VCF), a method of funding public projects by capturing a portion of the increase in private land values that results from public investment in infrastructure.

They have also been asked to go for transit-oriented development (TOD) — planned and intensive development — and set up Urban Metropolitan Transport Authorities (UMTAs). The urban affairs ministry is working on revising the TOD policy with a focus on more integrated development along the transport corridors.

After BJP returned to power in Delhi, PM Narendra Modi had said that having BJP govt in all states in NCR will open numerous avenues for development, and huge efforts will be made to boost mobility and infrastructure development in the region.

## Nithari bungalow: 'Dark' past hidden by creepers

**Noida:** Standing next to two sprawling homes with manicured lawns, an unsettling scent of neglect lingers over Nithari's bungalow number D-5 today. The house that once stood at the centre of one of India's most horrifying crime stories is now barely visible — swallowed by creepers that climb broken boundary walls.

Until last week, neighbours said the vegetation was so dense that the bungalow had nearly vanished from sight. When a group of labourers arrived unannounced to clear the overgrowth, speculation swirled — some attributed it to residents' efforts to ward off snakes, others to the family of former owner Moninder Singh Pandher.

Nearly 20 years ago, this plot pitchforked from an ordinary middle-class residence into the nucleus of the Nithari killings. Since his acquittal, Pandher has relocated to Chandigarh.

In a recent interview with a reporter in Chandigarh, Pandher said he was working in the fertiliser business in Badaun when he came to know of the bungalow. "A retired army officer," he said, had suggested the property, adding that Surinder Koli, Pandher's domestic staffer, had worked at the officer's home earlier.

Pandher also said he had known Payal, one of the first women to disappear in 2006. "The girl went missing suddenly. That time, my father passed away, and I came to Chandigarh," he said, maintaining he was not in Noida when the murders took place.

## 'AAP plea against phansi ghar summons may not stand'

**New Delhi:** Delhi High Court on Tuesday indicated that prima facie, the plea of AAP's Arvind Kejriwal and Manish Sisodia challenging the summons issued to them by Delhi assembly's privilege committee over the 'phansi ghar' issue is "not maintainable".

Justice Sachin Datta orally observed this as the peti-

tion came up for hearing and listed it for hearing on Wednesday at the request of the counsel representing the office of the legislative assembly.

Delhi assembly had recently summoned former CM Kejriwal, the then deputy CM Sisodia, former speaker Ram Niwas Goel and former deputy speaker Rakhi Birla, asking them to appear in person on Nov 13 before the commit-

tee looking into the previous AAP govt's claims of a 'phansi ghar' (gallows chamber) inside the assembly complex.

Kejriwal and Sisodia approached HC challenging the summons, saying the notices showed the proceedings are not founded on any complaint or report or refer to a motion of breach of privilege or contempt.

The counsel for the assembly, committee of privileges,

and the deputy secretary (legislation) raised a preliminary objection, saying the petition was not maintainable. However, the lawyer for the AAP leaders urged that notice be issued in the stay application, arguing that the committee notice is without jurisdiction. The petition said the reference to the committee appears to be for verifying "authenticity", a function be-

yond the remit of Delhi assembly and, especially its privileges committee, that too for the next Vidhan Sabha. "The proceedings suffer from procedural illegalities, constitutional infirmities and colourable exercise of legislative power. They violate the fundamental rights of the petitioners under Articles 14, 19, and 21 of Constitution and are liable to be quashed," it said.

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# GAIL Chief's Dissent Note Shows Rift in PNGRB Gas Reform Panel

Chairman Sandeep Gupta objects to proposal on domestic gas sales contracts and capping equity return on pipelines at 14%

New Delhi: GAIL chairman Sandeep Gupta has issued a formal dissent note on some of the key recommendations of the expert committee of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB), turning the panel into a battleground between the country's largest gas marketer-transporter and major consumers such as Adani Total, NTPC and Torrent. The committee, set up to recommend ways to expand domestic gas usage and deepen the market, has proposed sweeping reforms, including lifting restrictions on resale and destination in domestic LNG sale agreements; setting up an independent system operator for gas pipelines; a real-time bulletin board for all pipelines to book capacity; removal of excise duty

on CNG; viability gap funding for strategically important pipelines; subsidy for piped natural gas connections to homes; and bringing natural gas under goods and services tax in a lower tax bracket. "The recommendations contained herein—numbering over eighty—are not novel inventions," DK Sarraf, the chairman of the committee, wrote in the preface to the report. "The challenge, therefore, is not one of diagnosis, but of delivery... What is now required is the administrative commitment, and institutional courage to act." The committee comprised seven members, including Sarraf—former chief of ONGC and PNGRB—GAIL chairman Sandeep Gupta and the chief executives of NTPC, Adani Total Gas, Torrent Gas and Carmine Energy, along with a PNGRB official. Gupta objected to the panel's re-

commendation on domestic gas sales contracts. "The recommendation to remove destination restrictions in domestic gas sales agreement (GSA) contracts by natural gas marketers is not practicable and will threaten energy security by discouraging proactive sourcing by such marketers," he said. "The committee would like to emphasise that imposing both take-or-pay obligations and resale/destination restrictions simultaneously is inherently unfair to consumers," the committee responded. "This dual imposition significantly limits the buyer's ability to optimise gas usage, manage costs, and respond to market dynamics." Gupta also opposed the proposal to cap equity return on pipelines at 14%. "My viewpoint of recommending 15-16% ROE (return on equity) as is the case for power transmission lines instead of inventing pro-

posed 14%, devoid of any basis, has not been agreed to," he said. The panel said PNGRB may implement a transparent, investor-friendly tariff framework based on capital-cost bids and the discounted cash flow methodology, shifting from return on capital employed to equity-based returns. "Key features should include a normative 70:30 debt-equity ratio, equity return capped at 14%, cost of debt linked to the SBI MCLR (marginal cost of funds-based lending rate), and empirically benchmarked opex," it said. Gupta disagreed with the panel on establishing an independent system operator for pipelines. The panel said the ISO was aimed at "enhancing neutrality, transparency, and efficiency in gas transmission management—without altering ownership or marketing rights" of the pipeline companies.

## Tata Power to Buy 40% in Bhutan Hydro Project SPV

New Delhi: Tata Power on Tuesday said it will invest ₹1,572 crore for acquiring 40% equity stake in a SPV that will set up 1,125 MW Dorjilung hydro power project in Bhutan at an investment of ₹13,100 crore. The acquisition will be done in one or more tranches for which a shareholders agreement would be executed between the company and Druk Green Power Corporation in Bhutan, a regulatory filing said. - PTI

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# Adani Plans India's Biggest Battery Storage in Gujarat

**BOOST FOR CLEAN ENERGY SWITCH** Project commissioning by Mar

Mumbai: Adani Group on Tuesday announced its entry into battery energy storage systems (BESS) business with a 1126 MW/3530 MWh project at Khavda in Gujarat, site of the world's largest renewable energy park. Slated for commissioning by March, the project will be India's largest and among the world's biggest single-location BESS deployments, involving more than 700 BESS containers. The storage system, based on advanced lithium-ion battery technology, will be capable of delivering 1126 MW for about three hours, helping stabilise the grid, manage peak loads, and support round-the-clock renewable energy supply.

Adani Group did not disclose the investments it will be making in the project. Industry officials said per megawatt hour of setting up BESS could range between ₹2.20 crore and ₹2.40 crore for a specific 2023-2026 period. However, project-specific costs can be lower than this estimate due to tenders, subsidies, and the kind of technology used. So, Adani Group could be spending up to ₹10,000 crore in setting up the 3530 MWh capacity of BESS. The project is in advanced stages of deployment and will integrate cutting-edge energy management systems to enhance performance and reliability. "This historic project marks a major leap in India's clean energy transition," Adani Group said in a statement, adding that the system will help reduce transmission congestion, ease peak load pressure, and lessen solar curtailment—key challenges in large-scale renewable integration. "Energy storage is the cornerstone of a renewable-powered future," said Gautam Adani, chairman, Adani Group. "With this historic project, we are not only setting global benchmarks but also reinforcing our commitment to India's energy independence and sustainability." Following this flagship project, the group plans to boost storage capacity to 15 GWh by FY27, reaching 50 GWh within five years, making it a major player in global clean energy storage.

## Wilmar Gets CCI Nod to Buy 20% in AWL Agri

New Delhi: Fair trade regulator CCI on Tuesday cleared Wilmar International's proposal to acquire up to 20% stake in AWL Agri Business Ltd from Adani Group. The move came after Adani Group in July this year announced that it will sell a 20% stake in AWL Agri Business (formerly Adani Wilmar Ltd) to Singapore-based Wilmar International for ₹7,150 crore, as part of its decision to exit the FMCG business and focus on its infrastructure vertical. Wilmar International, through its

arm Lence Pte, is acquiring the stake in AWL Agri Business Ltd. "The proposed transaction involves acquisition of up to a maximum of 20% of the paid-up equity share capital, and a minimum of 11% of the paid-up equity share capital of the target (AWL Agri Business) by the acquirer (Lence Pte Ltd)," the regulator said in a release. Wilmar, through Lence Pte, holds a 43.94% equity stake in AWL Agri Business. - PTI

## Adani Ent Sets Rights Issue at ₹1,800 a Share

Mumbai: Adani Enterprises Ltd, the flagship company of the Adani Group, fixed its rights issue price at ₹1,800 per share, a discount of 24% from its closing stock price on Tuesday. It has fixed November 17 as the record date and aims to raise ₹24,930 crore through the rights issue. In a regulatory filing late Tuesday evening, Adani Enterprises said it will be issuing 138.5 million partly paid-up equity shares which will have a face value of ₹1 each. A rights issue is a capital-raising instrument used by a company. While dates of the rights issue are yet to be disclosed, the company said those who hold its shares as of November 14 will be eligible to subscribe to the rights issue. Shareholders will be entitled to receive three rights equity shares for every 25 fully paid-up equity shares they had as on the record date. Shares of Adani Enterprises ended nearly flat Tuesday at ₹2,366.30 on the BSE.

# Govt plans one-time traffic fine relief

**NEW DELHI:** Vehicle owners in Delhi could soon get relief from years of unpaid traffic fines, as the government readies a one-time waiver scheme offering up to 80% reduction on challans to clear long-pending dues and improve revenue collection.

Officials said the proposal, drafted by the transport department, will offer up to 60% waiver on challans issued to personal and commercial vehicles in the last 10 years, a 70% waiver for Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) buses, and 80% waiver for all two-wheelers and three-wheelers.

The proposal is expected to

be approved by the Delhi cabinet on Wednesday. Once cleared, the amnesty scheme will benefit thousands of motorists who have accumulated unpaid fines over the years due to procedural delays, non-service of notices, and pending court appeals.

According to Delhi traffic police records, nearly 50 million traffic challans have been issued in the past decade. However, only around 2.7% of them have been realised so far, while nearly 97% still pending.

The transport department, which issues its own set of fines, reported that of the 1.7 million challans generated in the past decade, 24.8% have been paid while 75% remain unsettled.

The government believes the amnesty drive will help clear a significant portion of the backlog while unlocking non-tax revenue. "The idea is not just to provide relief to citizens, but also to improve compliance and recover dues that have remained unrealised for years. A transparent, one-time settlement process will help streamline enforcement and ease the burden on courts. Additionally, it will encourage people to clear their pending fines that will likely increase government revenue as well," said an official.

If approved, the scheme will likely run for a limited window of 45 to 60 days, during which vehicle owners can settle their pending fines either online,

through the Delhi government's transport portal, or by visiting designated facilitation centres.

The move comes amid growing concern over enforcement fatigue and poor recovery rates following digitisation of traffic fines and the shift to e-courts. Officials said while automation has improved transparency, it has also triggered a surge in challans, many of which remain contested or unpaid.

"There will be no financial implication to the government and no budget allocation is required in this regard. In fact, there will be an expected increase in revenue collection of the government by the amount realised through the amnesty scheme," said the official.

# GZB: PWD GETS IN-PRINCIPLE NOD TO WIDEN 1.3KM GT ROAD STRETCH

**GHAZIABAD:** The Public Works Department (PWD) of the Ghaziabad district has received an in-principle approval from the Uttar Pradesh government to widen a 1.3km stretch of the Grand Trunk (GT) Road, from Bhatia Morh flyover to Lal Kuan intersection on the National Highway (NH)-9, officials said.

The stretch is used daily by lakhs of motorists headed from Ghaziabad to NH-9 and further to Bulandshahr. It also connects the NH-9 to several industrial areas, such as South Side GT Road, Loha Mandi, and Kavi Nagar.

On Monday, Ram Raja, executive engineer of PWD, said: "The four-lane stretch sees severe traffic snarls as trucks from industrial areas are parked on roadsides. So, we proposed adding one lane to each side of the stretch, which has received an in-principle approval. Once final notification is received, we will start the work. We're now preparing tender documents, and expect the project to be completed by March, 2026."

Officials estimate the stretch caters to 125,000-150,000 vehicles daily. The proposed widening is estimated to cost about ₹1 crore.

In 2022, a 14.9km stretch of GT Road — Gyani Border to Lal Kuan — was proposed for redevelopment. The project, estimated to cost ₹480 crore, was to be taken up by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). However, the project never took off. "Since the earlier project did not start, we have moved forward with the new road-widening work," Raja added. NHAI officials could not be reached for comments.

India awaiting US response but more talks may not be needed, say sources

India is awaiting a response from the US to its proposal on the bilateral trade deal being negotiated and does not see the need for additional rounds of negotiations, government sources said.

"India has kept in mind each sensitive sector (and protected them) in the proposal made to the US for the India-US bilateral trade agreement (BTA). The talks are progressing well between both sides... India is waiting for the US response to its proposal and another round may not be needed," the source tracking the matter closely said.

US President Donald Trump said on Monday that trade talks with India had made significant progress, and the two sides were reaching a fair and balanced agree-

ment. "We're making a deal with India — much different what we had. Right now, they don't love me, but they will love us again. We're getting a fair deal. They're very good negotiators, so Sergio, you will have to take a look at that. I think we're pretty close to doing a deal that is good for everybody," Trump said at the swearing-in ceremony of Sergio Gor as the new US Am-

bassador to India at the Oval Office on Monday.

CONTENTIOUS ISSUE

However, India's purchase of Russian oil remains a sticking point as the US has demanded that India should stop its purchases from Moscow. It alleged that the oil purchase

was fuelling Russia's war on Ukraine but Delhi argued that it should not be singled out as it had not gone against any restrictions on the energy purchase.

"India has given its offer of opening up its markets in several sectors that will help the US increase its exports to the country and lessen the trade imbalance. But it does not want to stop oil purchases from Russia following a diktat as the country's energy security is of utmost importance and India's ties with Russia have been historically strong," another source said.

The US imposed 50 per cent duties on India in August, of which 25 per cent is a penalty for buying Russian oil. For the BTA to happen, the entire penalty has to be rolled back.

"India's competitors in the US, such as Vietnam and Bangladesh, face duties of 19-20 per cent. The duties on India have to be lower for the country to have an edge in the US market. The oil penalty has to be rolled back completely and the reciprocal tariff, too, has to be brought down for that to happen," the source said.

Apart from Russian oil, the demand made by the US in the agriculture and dairy sectors, especially for market access for soya and corn, is another bone of contention between the two sides.

"Agriculture and dairy sectors are very sensitive in India and the country does not allow genetically modified soya and corn. But the US has been pursuing its demand strongly," the source said.

J&K bypolls: 78% turnout in Nagrota, 49% in Budgam

Amid a late-autumn chill, voters in central Kashmir's Budgam and Jammu's Nagrota constituencies cast their ballots in the Assembly byelections on Tuesday, with Nagrota recording 72.7 per cent turnout and outpacing Budgam (48.5 per cent) as of 5 pm.

The Budgam seat fell vacant after CM Omar Abdullah opted to retain his family bastion, Ganderbal, following victories in both constituencies in the 2024 Assembly polls. The byelection in Nagrota was called after the death of BJP legislator Devender Singh Rana on October 31, 2024.

PEACEFUL POLL

Polling officials said voting remained peaceful in both constituencies, with brisk turnout despite sub-zero morning temperatures.

"Many youth from the district are languishing in jails

outside Jammu & Kashmir and we voted for their release," said a voter from Soibug village, Budgam.

The main contest in Budgam is between the Jammu and Kashmir National Conference's (JKNC) Aga Mehmod and PDP's Aga Muntazir. In Nagrota, the contest shaped into a triangular fight between Devyani Rana of the BJP, Harsh Dev Singh of the Jammu and Kashmir National Panthers Party-India, and Shamim Begum of the JKNC.

After completing a nationwide review of flight training organisations (FTOs), the civil aviation regulator is preparing to launch a similar audit of aircraft maintenance engineering (AME) schools, sources told businessline.

The audit will assess compliance, infrastructure standards and training quality. Sources said that the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) had identified the need for a comprehensive evaluation of AME institutes. "The regulator concluded an extensive inspection of FTOs which focused on safety, infrastructure, instructor standards, and operational readiness," sources said.

'TO MEET STANDARDS'

"The next logical step is to review AME schools to ensure that the technical workforce meets global safety and maintenance standards," they added.

The proposed review will cover adherence to Civil Aviation Requirement (CAR) standards, infrastructure adequacy and instructor qualifications. It will assess workshop and simulator access, which are critical for practical learning. India currently has over 50 DGCA-approved AME training institutes, which train engineers for both domestic and international airlines, maintenance, repair and overhaul

organisations (MRO), and general aviation operators.

However, sector experts have pointed out a widening gap between industry requirements and the skill sets of graduating engineers.

BRIDGING THE GAP

Further, the review is expected to focus on placement records, internship tie-ups with MROs and adherence to new digital record-keeping and safety norms.

The move when the Indian aviation industry is witnessing its largest fleet expansion in history, with major carriers placing orders for more than 1,000 new aircraft.

"The regulator wants to ensure that AME schools are producing job-ready engineers equipped for modern fleets and technology," the sources added. The audit, sources said, will form the basis for a possible overhaul of training regulations, aligning them with international benchmarks on a par with the European Union Aviation Safety Agency and the Federal Aviation Administration.

Sembcorp secures 150 MW FDRE project
