ED goes to SC, seeks CBI probe against Didi for 17 offences

Bengal DGP, Kolkata CP Also Named In Writ Petition

New Delhi: Enforcement Directorate Monday filed a writ petition in SC seeking a CBI probe into 17 offences under BNS allegedly committed by Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee, state DGP and Kolkata police commissioner on Jan 8 by obstructing ED raid on I-PAC's Pratik Jain, tampering and stealing evidence and intimidating its officials.

It requested SC to "direct immediate seizure, sealing, forensic preservation, and restoration to lawful custody of the ED all digital devices, electronic records, storage media, and documents illegally and forcibly taken away from the search premises."

ED has accused the CM and top police brass of committing 17 offences under BNS, including robbery, dacoity, theft, assault or criminal force to deter public servant from discharging his duty, causing disappearance and destruction of evidence and criminal intimidation.

Terming the incident shocking, unprecedented and extraordinary, ED said, "Protections of law — the CM, DGP and Kolkata police commissioner are party to serious cognisable offences requiring registration of an FIR."

It said the raid on Jain's

residential premises was conducted as part of investigation into a multi-state money laundering case involving nearly Rs 3,000 crore derived from illegal coal mining. It alleged that Jain had received Rs 20 crore of the illicit money.

"To the shock and surprise of ED officers and everyone concerned, the CM along with chief secretary, DGP, Kolkata police commissioner and deputy police commissioner along with cops and officials barged into premises under the search. They not only started intimidating ED officers but also snatched the files and electronic evidence containing incriminating material from the officers."

"Officers of the petitioners were threatened and were not permitted to conduct any further search on the premises. The searches were conducted at two places — one at residence of Pratik Jain and second office premise of one company called Indian Pac Consulting Pvt Ltd," it said.

It will be futile to approach local police to register an FIR for these illegal actions by the state's constitutional and police authorities as it involves

the CM who also holds the home portfolio under whom the police function, ED said.

It said Calcutta HC could not conduct hearing in its writ petition seeking registration of FIR and CBI probe into the illegal acts of the CM and others as her supporters created a ruckus and forced the judge to adjourn hearing. It sought a direction from SC to West Bengal Police not to lodge any FIR against ED officials without court's prior permission.

"The fact that the supporters of CM are involved in creating ruckus is evidenced from the WhatsApp group by party members to come and gather in huge numbers in the court. As a result of the tactics by the CM and her followers, remedy under Article 226 of the Constitution (in HC) has become illusory in the facts of the present case," ED said.

ED said that the state police has maliciously registered several FIRs against its officers for conducting the raid and sought protection from the court to carry out unhindered its investigations into the PMLA case relating to illegal coal mining and I-PAC.

EC trying to disenfranchise genuine voters, claims Mamata

Kolkata: Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee Monday wrote to CEC Gyanesh Kumar for the second time in 48 hours, alleging that EC was not issuing proper acknowledgments of documents submitted during SIR hearings and was instead marking them "not found" to disenfranchise genuine voters, reports Debashis Konar.

She said, "The non-issuance of documentary acknowledgment deprives electors of proof of submission and places them at the mercy of internal record-keeping deficiencies... This defeats the very objective of SIR, which is intended to strengthen and purify the electoral roll."

After the 2002 SIR of the electoral roll, voters applied for changes in names and addresses, which were ratified by EC and included in 2025 poll rolls, Mamata said. "EC is now disregarding its own statutory processes followed consistently over two decades and compelling electors to once again establish their identity and eligibility," she wrote.

Mamata said that over 23 years, many electors submitted Form 8 with valid govt-issued documents and, after quasi-judicial hearings, their particulars were corrected. "Why should process revert to 2002? Does this imply all revisions were illegal?" she asked, calling the move arbitrary.

2 held for killing ex-law officer's wife in Punjab, cops say help planned it

Mohali: The murder of 66-year-old Ashok Kumari, wife of former Additional Advocate General of Punjab Krishan Goyal, was allegedly planned by their house help, Neeraj, who roped in two cousins, police said Monday after arresting a second suspect, reports Barinderjit Saluja.

Neeraj was arrested a day after the murder, while a co-accused was caught in Fateh-

pur. UP Police are now looking for the third suspect, Mohali SSP Harmandeep Hans said. "We recovered 28 tolas of gold and Rs 1.5 lakh cash," he added. Much of the loot is still missing. The complainant said 40 tolas of gold and Rs 8.5 lakh in cash were stolen.

Cops said motive was not enmity but a desire to get rich after learning that gold and cash were kept in the house.

TMC claims 58L voters removed from rolls, SC seeks EC response

New Delhi: Supreme Court Monday asked Election Commission to respond within a week to TMC MP Dola Sen's plea accusing the poll panel of arbitrarily deleting more than 58 lakh names from West Bengal's draft voters' list by refusing to accept valid and permissible documents from people during the SIR exercise.

Appearing for Sen, senior advocate Kapil Sibal said, "What is this happening? EC is sending instructions to various election officers through WhatsApp messages or through video conferencing. This is impermissible as all such instructions must be in writing to ensure transparency in the process of preparation of voters' list."

A bench of CJI Surya Kant and Justice Joydip Bagchi asked EC counsel Eklavya Dwivedi to respond to Sen's petition by Saturday, and posted the matter for Jan 19.



Sen has sought extension of Jan 15 deadline for submission of claims and objections to draft voters' list. Calling EC "WhatsApp commission" for issuing instructions to election officers through the messaging platform and not through written orders, the MP said EC must be directed to accept permanent residence certificates, panchayat residence certificates and family registers as valid documents for inclusion in voters' list.

The draft electoral roll for Bengal was published on Dec 16, and 58,20,898 names were deleted, which the Rajya Sabha MP alleged was without any notice or personal hearing. She said there has been a precipitous decline from 7,66,37,529 voters after the Special Summary Revision of 2025 to 7,08,16,616 voters on the draft electoral roll.

She said contrary to the SOP for SIR, in several assembly constituencies, deletion decisions with respect to voters categorised as absent-

tee, shifted, dead and duplicate (ASDD) are being processed centrally and marked en masse as 'Disposed — Form 7' on the Electoral Registration Officer Net Portal. "Alarming, this appears to be occurring without physical verification, individual hearing or meaningful involvement of the EROs concerned," she alleged.

Sen said, "A majority of affected electors are women voters, whose surnames have changed post-marriage, leading to misclassification by algorithm used by EC; over 90% of the cases are mismatch in names attributable largely to failure of algorithm; minorities are largely affected by misclassification of algorithm."

As the final roll, scheduled to be published on Feb 14 (after closure of notice and hearing phase on Feb 7), Sen apprehended that the Bengal assembly elections will be immediately declared thereafter, and requested SC to direct EC to correct its voters' list revision process and attempt to include all eligible voters.

Tech error, claims EC after asking Admiral to prove his identity

New Delhi/Panaji: EC on Monday said that the notice to Admiral Arun Prakash (ret'd) to prove his identity in person as part of Goa's ongoing SIR of electoral rolls was triggered by a "system-driven procedure" and that he has submitted all necessary documents, paving the way for an early resolution of the matter.

"The matter will be settled, perhaps by Tuesday, making the retired Admiral and his wife eligible for inclusion in the final electoral roll of Cortalim constituency in Goa," an officer aware of the proceedings said.

Electoral registration officer Medora Ermomilla D'Costa said the BLO for Cortalim constituency had collected Prakash's enumeration form but found it lacked mandatory particulars from previous rolls. "It was observed that the enumeration form did not contain the mandatory particulars relating to previous SIR, including the name of elector, EPIC number, name of relative, name and number of assembly constituency, part, and serial number," D'Costa added.



The absence of these identification details led to Prakash and his wife being declared unmapped voters, as EC could not automatically link his enumeration form with the 2002 electoral roll. "As per the standard, system-driven procedure, a hearing notice was automatically generated and issued to enable verification of the elector's details and ensure due opportunity for confirmation of eligibility," D'Costa said.

Prakash said that if the enumeration form cannot elicit the required information, it should ask more questions about previous place of residence. "EC should also train BLOs and empower them to verify the documents and scrutinise enumeration forms," the 81-year-old Vir Chakra awardee and hero of the 1971 India-Pakistan War told TOI.

The retired Admiral, who has lived in Goa since 2009, said he and his wife would comply with EC notices but wondered why the BLO, who visited their home three times, could not ask for additional information, instead calling them to the election office, 18km away, on two different dates.

Mann seeks Bhagat Singh trial tapes from UK museum

Bathinda: Punjab CM Bhagwant Mann has written to British deputy high commissioner Alba Smeriglio seeking "audio/video recordings" pertaining to the trial of freedom fighters Bhagat Singh, Shivaram Rajguru and Sukhdev Thapar, who were hanged in Lahore Jail on March 23, 1931.

"Original audio/video recordings and archival documentation pertaining to the trial proceedings of Bhagat Singh, Rajguru and Sukhdev are held by authorities in Scotland, reportedly preserved within a museum/institution maintaining historical legal archives of that era," Mann wrote to Smeriglio.

"These records hold profound historical and emotional significance for people of Punjab. Govt of Punjab seeks access to these materials for academic study, digital preservation, and exhibition at Shaheed Bhagat Singh Heritage Complex," stated the letter, urging that the request be taken up with authorities in Scotland.

"The gesture will be remembered as a significant step in honouring shared history and the universal ideals of justice, sacrifice, and human dignity," the Punjab CM's letter said. —Neel Kamal
