Sub: Clarification w.r.t. sale of ZF Group's ADAS business to Harman International Inc (ref Press release dated 23rd December 2025).

Ref: Our letter dated 3rd December 2025 - Press Release titled "ZF Commercial Vehicle Control Systems India Limited Secures an ADAS Business Nomination from an Indian E-Mobility CV OEM"

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations"), we informed the stock exchange(s) that the Company has secured an ADAS Business nomination (vide above mentioned reference) from an Indian e-mobility Commercial Vehicle OEM on December 03, 2025.

ZF Friedrichshafen AG (Ultimate Holding Company) had announced on December 23, 2025 about the sale of Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS) for Passenger Cars to Harman International Inc. On this proposed business sale, we have received inquiries from the few investors, seeking clarity on the impact of this global transaction on our India operations.

We would like to confirm on behalf of ZF Commercial Vehicle Solutions (CVS) that:-

ZF Commercial Vehicle Solutions (CVS) confirms that the announced transfer of certain Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS) activities applies exclusively to its ADAS Division portfolio - specifically Compute Solutions, Camera, Radar, and Passenger Car ADAS functions - and does not pertain to the ADAS portfolio of the ZF CVS Division. It does not affect ZF CVS's development, supply, service, or support of ADAS solutions for commercial vehicles. Existing customer contracts, service arrangements, and terms & conditions remain in force, and program deliveries continue without interruption.

ZF will continue its activities in driver assistance and autonomous driving in the commercial vehicle sector, and CVS retains the dedicated teams, capabilities, and governance needed for the development and supply of ADAS solutions for trucks, coaches and buses applications.

We also further confirm that: -

- *There is no impact on customer agreements or project execution—current contractual terms, conditions, and delivery schedules remain unchanged.*
- *Continuity of support—customer engineering, program, and service interfaces at ZF CVS are unaffected.*
- *Ongoing ADAS roadmap for commercial vehicles—CVS continues to invest in and deliver ADAS innovations tailored to commercial transport requirements.*

The announced sale of certain ADAS activities to Harman applies only to ZF's passenger car ADAS Division. ZF's Commercial Vehicle Solutions (CVS) Division — including all ADAS development, supply, service, and customer programs for trucks, coaches and buses — is not part of the transaction and remains fully unchanged”.
