 - First Control Period of 5 year will be from 01 Apr'27 to 31 Mar'32

 - Airside works (~100% complete), Terminal Building (~96.9% complete) and Air Traffic Control tower(~94.7% complete) progressing simultaneously
 - ~97.4% overall progress achieved as of 31 Jan'26
