**Subject: Intimation under Regulation 30 read with Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015**

In continuation of our letter dated March 23, 2020, March 31, 2020 and pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, this is to inform that taking cognizance of the orders of the Hon'ble Prime Minister dated April 14, 2020 for the complete shutdown in the Country till May 03, 2020 amid spread of COVID – 19 Pandemic, it has been decided to continue the suspension of operations at our plant(s) at Faridabad, Haryana, Mumbra, Thane District and Lonand, Satara District in Maharashtra and various Branch Offices till May 03, 2020 in the interest of health and safety of our employees and public at large.

However, the operations, if resumed at our aforesaid plant(s) and various Branch Offices in between of the period of lockdown shall be strictly in accordance with the guidelines to be issued by the Government of India in this regard.

Consequently, we anticipate that there will be severe adverse impact of these developments on our manufacturing capabilities and we will be required to reassess/recalibrate our ability to meet the delivery schedules in coming months. We are monitoring situation on daily basis and shall be in touch with our suppliers, vendors, customers etc. with regular updates and shall update the exchanges of the situations accordingly, as may be required.

As the situation is unprecedented and we all need to work together to address disruptions in supply chain caused by this great natural calamity, we sincerely solicit the support of all the stakeholders and look forward to jointly work out a way to tide over these challenging times.

Meanwhile, we wish that our employees, their families and the public at large stay safe and adopt strict social distancing and/or isolation measures and sustain a good health and well being.
