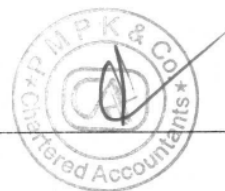

4. The Statement includes the results of the following entities:
Phoenix Cement Limited (subsidiary of company) and Phoenix Industries Limited (subsidiary of company).
5.
