Four people duped of crores by cyber thugs

Cyber fraudsters duped four people of crores of rupees by luring them with the promise of share trading on Facebook.

After investing in the share trading, when the victims tried to withdraw their money, the fraudsters switched off their phones.

Asseem Bhalla, a resident of Ayodhya Road and a businessman, found an advertisement of a private company offering daily income on Facebook on October 15, 2025. He fell into the trap and clicked the link and got himself registered. He received an invitation code and the company's agents advised him to invest through OTC (over the counter) trading.

Initially, he was lured with promises of profits, after which he transferred money to several accounts through various methods.

The fraudsters then told him that his profit had exceeded 100 per cent so he should first deposit 10 per cent of this profit to the company to withdraw his money. Bhalla suspected fraud and filed a complaint on a cybersecurity portal.

Between September 21 and October 17, the fraudsters defrauded him of Rs 34.5 lakh.

In a separate incident, another businessman, Rishi Singh, a resident of Madhuban Nagar in Alambagh and, was duped of Rs 55 lakh, which he transferred to the cyber thugs in 11 transactions.

Singh said that in the first

week of September, he joined a group through WhatsApp and was asked to download a trading app. He was then asked to do trading through the app he had downloaded.

After this, in the name of investment, Rs 55.39 lakh he made about 11 transactions between September 12 and October 24.

In another case, a man identified as Rajesh Kumar Singh, a resident of Avadhpuri Sarvodaya Nagar, a native of Gorakhpur was defrauded Rs 8.68 lakh in the name of Google rating

Rajesh said that on May 3, 2025, he received a message on his WhatsApp and was offered the job related to Google rating work. Being unemployed, he accepted the offer.

The message sender

claimed to be associated with a multinational company and added Rajesh to the Telegram group. Initially, the fraudsters promised to pay Rs 150 per Google rating, but the next day, they changed the scheme and motivated him to invest money while promising a 30 to 40 per cent profit on the invested sum.

Rajesh initially sent Rs 2,000, and received Rs 3,000 as refund. Over the course of three months, the fraudsters lured him to deposit Rs 5 lakh into various accounts. Then, on July 29, the fraudsters demanded Rs 5.34 lakh as consulting fees and promised to pay Rs 20-21 lakh. When Rajesh shared this information with his friends, he was told that it was a cyber fraud. He reported the matter to the police.

Meanwhile, Alambagh resident Anoop Kumar said that on November 1, he received an APK file on WhatsApp from an unknown number. On opening it, the phone got hanged but started functioning again after 48 hours. During this time his bank account, UPI and Gmail ID were not working. Between November 1 and November 6, a cyber fraud of Rs 5.46 lakh took place. Interestingly the victim did not receive any message from the bank.

He reported the matter to the police.

Cybercrime Police Station in-charge Inspector Brijesh Yadav said that after registering a case, the transaction chain was being looked at.

"A lot of time has passed since the incidents due to which the money could not be frozen," he said.

Two killed, 5 injured in firecracker factory blast in Barabanki

Two persons died while three others were injured in an explosion inside a licensed firecracker factory here on Thursday, with police suspecting that something inside the factory triggered the blast. The incident occurred in Sarai Barai village of the Tikaitnagar area, triggering panic among locals.

Police said the explosion inside the factory led to a fire with thick plumes of smoke seen rising from the factory.

Superintendent of Police (SP) Arpit Vijayvargiya said fire tenders were rushed to the spot upon receiving information. "The factory was operating with a valid licence to manufacture firecrackers. Preliminary investigation suggests that something inside the premises triggered the

blast," the officer said.

Police have sealed the site and called in a forensic team to collect evidence. Efforts are on to clear the debris and search for anyone who might still be trapped inside, he added. Three persons with critical burn injuries have been admitted to a hospital. After the initial explosion, several firecrackers continued to go off for some time, police said.

Abetment to suicide case registered against woman

A case of abetment to suicide was registered on Thursday against a woman neighbour in connection with the death of Shivam Nigam, a resident of Para, who had committed suicide at his house on September 18. The case was registered on the complaint of deceased's wife Neha Nigam of Para locality.

Neha accused the woman of instigating her husband to commit suicide. She alleged that the accused woman had an illicit relationship with her husband, Shivam Nigam.

According to Neha, the accused had physical relations with her husband and she had made objectionable videos and photographs of him. Based on these videos and photographs, she threatened Shivam that she would file a rape case that if he did not leave his wife and children for her.

It is alleged that the woman forced Shivam to consume alcohol and have sexual relations with her.

The wife of the deceased told the police that her husband, Shivam, had told her all his sexcapades. Shivam also told the com-

plainant that the accused had forced him to consume alcohol and have physical relations with him.

It is alleged that Shivam was experiencing mental stress due to coercion by the accused. In her complaint to the police, Neha stated that on September 18, she had gone out of the house for some personal work.

During it her husband, Shivam, committed suicide by hanging himself from a fan on the instigation of the accused woman.

Neha alleged that the accused was responsible for her husband's death.

Challan issued for stolen scooter

In a bizarre case, a traffic challan was issued on November 6, 2025, against a scooter which was stolen from the Civil Hospital in Lucknow a year ago.

The incident came to light after the victim got a message of challan on his mobile phone linked to the vehicle registration documents.

The challan copy also includes a photograph of the youth and a woman riding the scooter. The scooter owner had informed the police about the matter.

The owner of the scooter, Ajay Chaudhary, a resident of Awas Vikas Colony in Barabanki, said that on the night of September 25, 2024, around 7:40 pm he had come to Shyama Prasad Mukherjee (Civil) Hospital to visit his relative and had parked his scooter (UP-41 AC 0640) near the helpline inside gate number one of the hospital.

Seven held for attacking police personnel in Banthra

The Banthra police arrested seven persons on Thursday evening in connection with the attack on a police team and for hindering government work.

Those arrested have been identified as Ankil, Aarvesh aka Ankush, Ram Prakash and Akhilesh from the first party and Tulsiram, Arjun Gautam and Yuvraj Gautam from the second party.

A police spokesman said the accused had been

booked under relevant sections of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and a hunt was on for others involved in the group clash and the attack on the police team who were absconding.

The Banthra police have registered a case against six dozen unidentified people for obstructing government work and pelting stones at the police team in Ambedkar Nagar ward. on Wednesday

The case was registered on the complaint of Sub-Inspector Shyam G Mishra of Banthra police station.

According to the complainant, while on patrol on the evening of October 12, he received information that two groups were fighting and pelting stones at one another near Tirupati Balaji Temple in Ambedkar Nagar ward. He reached the scene with a police force and found several people lying injured on the ground.

The sub-inspector said that unidentified people pelted the police team with stones when the cops tried to dispel the mob and prevent them from taking law in their

hands. The police called an ambulance to rushe the injured to hospital.

Youth arrested

The Thakurganj police, on Thursday, arrested the youth who made an attempt to kill his landlord by electrocuting him in his house in Niwajganj.

The accused was identified as Vikas Gupta aka Vinod. He is a native of Hardoi and was staying in the house of victim Mahendra Singh Tomar on rent. As Mahendra is also a

Gang involved in extortion from trucks busted

The Uttar Pradesh Special Task Force busted a gang that extorted money in the name of passing overloaded trucks.

The syndicate was operating allegedly in connivance with the officials from the Transport and Mining Departments in Lucknow, Fatehpur, Unnao and Rae Bareilly.

The STF investigation revealed that some officers in the Transport and Mining Departments, in collusion with brokers, had been extorting large sums of money to allow overloaded trucks to pass. These overloaded trucks filled with sand and gravel are often let off without a challan and the gang allegedly charges Rs 7,000 per truck.

The STF conducted raids in four districts, taking action against officials accused of illegal extortion. Simultaneous raids in four districts, including Lucknow, were conducted late on Wednesday night in

Lucknow, Fatehpur, Unnao, and Rae Bareilly.

An FIR was filed against nine individuals, including ARTO Raju Bansal and PTO Manoj Bhardwaj, constable Anuj, Ritesh Kumar Pandey, Sunil Sachan, Vinod Yadav, Kapil and Abhinav Pandey, at the Madioan police station in Lucknow.

A case was filed against six individuals, including mining officer at the Thariyaon police station in Fatehpur, against 11 individuals, including a transport official, were named in the Lalganj case in Rae Bareilly and a case against officials and brokers associated with this network at the Unnao city police station.

During investigation, the STF discovered that the number of overloaded trucks and the amount to be extorted were passed to the officials the night before.

The trucks were then passed without any checking the next day. Even those trucks that were caught en route were released without a challan.
