# PM ends NE outreach with Assam rally; visits West Bengal, Bihar today

New Delhi, 14 September

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday said that Assam, currently ruled by Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP)-led coalition, was facing a demographic challenge due to the Congress' backing of infiltrators for votes.

"The Assam government is evicting encroachers, and providing deprived people land rights," he said while addressing a rally in Assam's Nimalgarh town in Golaghat district.

"We are taking steps for the welfare of tribals, who were neglected during the Congress rule," he added.

The ruling BJP-led coalition in the state has sought to make infiltration and demographic change in Assam, which is slated to go to polls in April next year, as key plank.

The PM's Assam visit is part of his outreach to the northeast. The September 14-15 tour began with him visiting Aizawl, the capital of Mizoram, followed by a trip to Manipal later in the day on Saturday. He will conclude the three-day tour of five states with his visit to poll-bound Bihar's Patna on Monday afternoon after a scheduled halt in West Bengal.

In the context of the US tariffs on India for buying Russian oil, Modi, during the Nimalgarh rally, said his government is taking steps to reduce

imports of crude oil and gas, focusing more on exploration of fossil fuels and green energy. He inaugurated and laid foundation stones for projects worth over ₹12,000 crore in the state.

Earlier in the day, at Mangaldai in Assam's Darrang district, Modi claimed that the Congress leaders insulted legendary singer Bipin Chandra Pal in 2019 when his government conferred the Bharat Ratna upon him. The PM also urged people to buy 'swadeshi' goods.

The PM halted his speech on several occasions and directed security officials to collect paintings of him and his mother from people who brought them

as gifts. He thanked them from the dais and asked them to write their names and addresses on the back of the paintings, promising to write a letter to them.

His gesture is notable with Bihar's ruling Janata Dal (United) and BJP-led National Democratic Alliance, and he himself, having been the insult to his mother from the stage of the rival NDA's Bihar.

In Aizawl, he inaugurated development projects worth ₹2,000 crore. He also inaugurated the Barailai-Sairang rail line connecting Aizawl to the rest of the country. The PM had visited the state after eight years.

Later on Saturday, the PM was in strict security. His first visit since October violence broke out in the state in May 2023 between Melaites, who dominate the Imphal valley, and the Kuki-Zo community, who predominantly live in the surrounding hills. The Congress and other opposition parties have criticised Modi's visit to the state of years for visiting the state.

The PM travelled by road to the hill district of Churachandpur, interacted with the displaced people and inaugurated projects worth ₹7,000 crore. He later addressed a gathering at Kangla Fort in Imphal city, 6 km from Churachandpur. The PM called for strengthening dialogue to build an abiding brotherhood of harmony between Manipur's hill and valley districts. In Patna, the PM will launch development projects worth ₹3,000 crore, inaugurate a new development project terminal and the National Mahatma Day set up, which was announced in the Union Budget earlier this year.

Bihar, the politically crucial Hindi heartland, is slated to go to polls by the end of next month. The Election Commission is likely to announce the poll schedule for the state by September 25. The term of the current Assembly will expire on November 22. Elections in the state in 2020 were held in three phases beginning from the last week of October.

## New projects worth ₹18K cr for Assam; clean energy in focus

PM lays foundation for bioethanol unit in Golaghat district

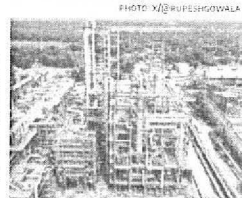

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday inaugurated a bioethanol plant and laid the foundation stone for a polypropylene unit at Nimalgarh Refinery Ltd (NRL), Golaghat, in Assam. The projects are aimed at promoting clean energy and reducing dependence on fossil fuels. Addressing a gathering on the occasion, he said projects worth ₹18,000 crore have been allocated to the state and the launch of energy security-related projects will further strengthen Assam's path to development.

"Assam is a land that strengthens India's energy capabilities. The petroleum products originating from Assam contribute significantly to the nation's development. The government is committed to elevating this strength to new heights," Modi said.

He added India has long been dependent on foreign sources for its energy needs. Importing large quantities of crude oil and gas. As a result, the nation has had to pay more to other countries, which in turn boost employment and income abroad. He said this situation needed to be changed.

In his speech, Modi recalled his announcement from the Red Fort regarding the "Samudra Manthan" initiative and said expert assessments suggested that Assam may hold substantial reserves of oil and gas. To harness these resources for national development, the National Deepwater Exploration Mission has been launched. The PM also said that in the changing times, India requires alternative fuels

to reduce dependence on oil and gas and ethanol is one such viable option. "Arrangements are being made to ensure a steady supply of bamboo for operating the bio-ethanol plant. The government will support local farmers in cultivating bamboo and will also procure it directly. Small units related to bamboo chipping will be established in the region," he said, adding around ₹200 crore will be spent annually in this sector.

Modi said India is making rapid strides in green energy and renewable power generation, and highlighted that the country ranks among the top five globally in solar energy capacity. He also said the government has launched the Semiconductor Mission with Assam serving as a major foundation for the initiative. ## 'Sugar industry survived due to use of ethanol'

Gadkari calls for bringing in technology in the farming sector

Pune, 14 September

Union Minister Nitin Gadkari (BJP) on Sunday said the sugar industry has survived due to the advent of ethanol, and asserted there is a need for new technologies in farming.

Speaking at an event of Nam Foundation in Pune, Gadkari attributed cultivator suicides in Maharashtra's Vidharba and Marathwada regions to

the security of water for farming. The senior BJP leader hailed the work of Nam Foundation, led by actors Nana Patekar and Malarand Anasapure, in the field of water conservation and the welfare of the children of farmers who had committed suicide.

"Water was the main cause behind the suicides of farmers in Vidharba and Marathwada regions. If water was available in abundance, the farmers would not have to take the extreme step," said Gadkari.

He said there is a need to bring in technology in the farming sector and experiments regarding the same have already been undertaken. "We import fossil fuel worth ₹22 trillion due to ethanol. Today, the sugarcane cultivators and sugar mill operators have survived just because of the advent of ethanol," he minister said.

Earlier this month, the Congress-led coalition of interest allegations against Gadkari, claiming he has been "aggressively lobbying" for ethanol production while his two sons are involved in firms that produce ethanol and "benefit" from government policy.

## Prosus scales up India AI play amid global headwinds

"There's a willingness to take pay for quality solutions, even in smaller cities," Gupta said. "If Arvian continues delivering, monetisation will follow."

At a time when there is competition from Tiger Global, Peak XV, and Accel for AI deals in India, Prosus claims its competitive advantage is investing from its balance sheet, offering founders patient capital and flexibility without the pressure of fund cycles.

The firm also leverages Prosus' in-house AI expertise, anchored by a dedicated team in Amsterdam that supports its global portfolio. "Our operating companies, especially in e-commerce, benefit from practical AI deployment experience," Gupta said.

Prosus uses its international footprint to help founders tap cross-market insights and networks. For instance, Goda Karma could leverage Prosus' presence in Latin America and eastern Europe, while successful models from those regions can inform new opportunities in India. Companies such as Decan AI

may also benefit directly from internal AI needs of Prosus, further deepening the partnership potential. Gupta said India's regulatory environment for AI remains favourable, with partners targeting price-sensitive segments can build profitable models—so long as they solve real, deeply rooted problems with strong execution.

"The government has also taken proactive steps, whether it is formalising funds for deep tech startups or having a semiconductor fund or having a vision for its own sovereign AI, which includes compute, GPU access, etc."

The AI push aligns with broader ambitions. During his India visit in May, Fabrice Biais, group CEO of Prosus, had said that the firm plans to grow the value of its India portfolio to ₹500 billion in the coming years, backed by a few billion dollars in fresh investments.

The strategy centres on deepening its presence in core sectors and scaling its ecosystem-focused approach. "My intention is to invest a few billion dollars more in India," Biais told Business Standard during a media roundtable.

Over the past year, Biais has pushed Prosus to open more like a tech company. He sees AI as a transformative force, calling it "as important as the Industrial Revolution", with the potential to fundamentally change how companies operate.

### Smartphone exports cross ₹1 trn in 5 mths

Over the past 11 years, the ranking of smartphones in India's export from the ₹671 in 2015 to the top 10 in FY25, where the sector clocked ₹2 trillion.

The impact of the PLI scheme is clear as from the fact that Apple's exports are up 100 per cent for the five-year period of the previous financial year, which is its last year under the scheme.

However, Samsung, whose five-year period for PLI was over in FY25, saw exports in the first five months by 21 per cent.

Samsung exports most of its smartphones from Vietnam, which has a cost advantage over India.

Queries sent to Apple and Samsung went unanswered till the time of going to press.

## US signals softer stand: Access to high-end cheese, not milk mkt

Bilateral trade talks stalled mainly because of India's refusal to grant the US unhindered market access to its politically sensitive agriculture and dairy sectors. Trump's decision to impose a 25 per cent reciprocal tariff, along with an additional 25 per cent tariff on India for purchasing Russian oil, had previously strained bilateral ties.

Signalling an easing of tensions, President Trump and Prime Minister Narendra Modi last week posted conciliatory messages on social media, expressing optimism about resolving outstanding issues and concluding a trade deal at the earliest. India's trade minister, Piyush Goyal, has said the country's trade talks with the US are progressing well, as both countries aim to finalise the first tranche of the bilateral trade agreement by November.

At least 10 PE suitors circle Balaji Wafers' 10% stake

Balaji Wafers, headquartered in Raipur, makes chips, namkeen, and confectionery under the Balaji brand, with a strong presence in western and central India. It also exports to the UK, US, and West Asia. The firm reported net sales of ₹5,433 crore in 2024-25, up 10.7 per cent, while per capita per capita rose 41.4 per cent to ₹578.8 crore, according to Capitaline.
