Medan airport domestic traffic has been affected by supply-side constraints as a portion of the aircraft fleet remains grounded due to maintenance-related issues - a challenge currently impacting the broader Indonesian aviation market

- Regulatory Update#:
 - Bhogapuram International Airport has been declared as a 'Major Airport' by AERA on 29 Aug'25
 - First Control Period of 5 year will be from 01 Apr'27 to 31 Mar'32
- Work progressing steadily on multiple fronts:
 - Airside works (~100% complete), Terminal Building (~95.5% complete) and Air Traffic Control tower(~94.0% complete) progressing simultaneously
 - ~95.8% overall progress achieved as of 31 Dec'25
