# 37 water bodies lost in Ahmedabad Lakes missing in AMC plan; NGT issues notice to pollution boards and collector

Ahmedabad  
Out of 156 lakes in Ahmedabad, 37 have disappeared. This revelation has come to light in a report by the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation. Based on this report, the National Green Tribunal has written letters to the State and Central Pollution Control Board as well as the Ahmedabad District Collector, also requesting details regarding the disappeared lakes.



How did lakes disappear?  
The report by the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation mentions that these lakes were not included in the legal development plan (urban expansion). As a result, these lakes disappeared during encroachment and urban expansion.

What is in the NGT notice?  
The Principal Bench of the NGT has taken suo motu cognizance of the AMC report and has sought a response.

This situation has mostly arisen due to uncontrolled

urban expansion and the lack of inclusion of natural water bodies in urban planning. Additionally, looking at the aerial images of the city from 2000 to 2022, this picture has become clear.

Revelations in AMC report  
The AMC report also revealed that the lake in the Thaltej area was not only taken under residential colonies, but AMC also established a water distribution center there.

Who did the NGT send a notice to?

The tribunal has issued a notice to the Central Pollution Control Board, or CPCB, the Gujarat Pollution Control Board, or GPCB, and the District Collector. This notice seeks clarification and a response from them on this matter. They are required to send it to the tribunal's Western Zonal Bench in Pune before August 28. The next hearing of the NGT on this matter is scheduled to be held in Pune on August 28, 2025.

Instructions from Gujarat HC  
Meanwhile, the Gujarat High Court has directed the state government to map all water sources before and after the monsoon, so that such situations can be identified and prevented.

According to a report, lakes have decreased in urban expansion.

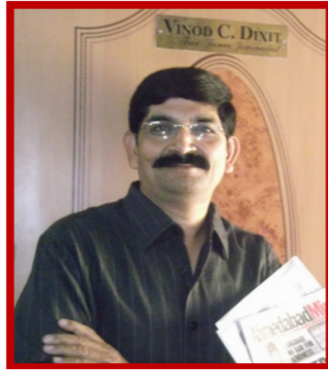
Urban flood management report  
According to AMC's 2024 "Urban Flood Management Report", approximately 371 billion liters of rainwater come to Ahmedabad every year. Of which, 40% of the water goes to natural lakes from the ground.

However, land of about 360 acres of lakes has now been developed into houses, roads, and other constructions, which obstructs the drainage of rainwater and causes waterlogging in the city even with less than moderate rainfall.

AMC's Redevelopment Efforts  
AMC is taking steps for the redevelopment of lakes. For instance, a budget of 8.17 crore rupees has been approved to rejuvenate Thaltej (Hebatpur) and Mumtazpur (Jodhpur) lakes. This plan includes deepening the lakes, constructing embankments, planting trees, installing gate fencing, and providing facilities like footpaths and lighting for visitors.

Future Plan  
AMC has now devised a new plan to revive 143 lakes. Under this plan, the aim is to collect rainwater in the lakes, connect them with rivers and drainage, and develop them again as an ecological system.

## Nephew killed uncle after watching serial killing series and videos

After hitting elderly man with blunt object on head, accused burned body by pouring petrol; planned murder due to debt

Rajkot, In a case from Raiya Road in Rajkot city, the postmortem report of an elderly person found partially burnt two days ago revealed that death occurred due to head injuries. After thorough police investigation, it was discovered that the murder was committed by none other than the elderly man's grandson (daughter's son). Following this, the police arrested the accused nephew and initiated legal proceedings. During police investigation, it was revealed that the accused learned about committing murder and destroying evidence by watching serial killer series and videos. Notably, the accused's father had borrowed money on interest from his grandfather, and later the accused himself borrowed

money from his grandfather after losing money in online gaming. Additionally, when his grandfather reprimanded him for committing theft in Ahmedabad, he planned the murder. The accused finally succeeded in killing his grandfather after two to three attempts. Police found partially burnt body of elderly man Rajkot City DCP Zone 2 Jagdish Bangarwa stated that

a partially burnt body of an elderly man was found in the Raiya Dhar area under Gandhi Gram-2 University Police Station area of Rajkot city. After recording it as an accidental death, police sent the body for forensic post-mortem. The examination revealed that the elderly man died due to head injury caused by a blunt object. Subsequently, police formed different teams and began

investigation. Upon learning that the elderly man lived alone, police questioned his family members and nearby residents. Anandjibhai Tank (age 73) was found to be murdered according to the forensic post-mortem report. Police registered a complaint under BNS sections 103(1), 332(C), 238(A) and G.P. Act section 135 and began investigation.

# Called to reconcile, youth killed by friends in Ahmedabad

murdered their friend Ketan Gohel by slitting his throat, creating a sensation. They called him for reconciliation in an old dispute and attacked their friend's throat with weapons.

Ahmedabad, In Ahmedabad July 11, there was a commotion when a former partner fired 3 rounds at a builder over a financial dispute of Rs 8 crore. When the builder asked for money, the former partner opened fire, creating a chaotic situation.

In the three rounds of firing, two bullets hit the builder while one bullet hit a passerby. The firing incident near Patva Sheri created a gangwar-like situation.

Zahuruddin Nagori opened fire Shojinbanu Pathan, who lives in CIFA Residency in Raikhad Police Line, filed a complaint at Karanj Police Station against Zahuruddin Nagori (resident of Rangila Pol's entrance, Shahpur) for firing and attempted murder.

Shojinbanu's husband, Nasir Khan alias Khanna Pathan, currently works in construction

and his partner was Zahuruddin Nagori. Both worked together from 2018 to 2021, but their partnership ended due to financial disputes. Nasir Khan was collecting money from Zahuruddin as he had dues to receive Nasir Khan had money to collect from Zahuruddin for business purposes, due to which he was collecting dues many times. Yesterday, when Nasir Khan was sitting near his house, Zahuruddin fired at him. Shojinbanu received a call from her nephew's son-in-law. He said that Khanna uncle's partner, Zahuruddin Nagori, shot him with a pistol. Nasir Khan was taken directly to the hospital, where his condition is critical. Zahuruddin fired three rounds at Nasir Khan. There was a dispute between Nasir Khan and Zahuruddin over monetary transactions, in which yesterday Zahuruddin fired three rounds at Nasir Khan. Two bullets hit Nasir Khan's body, while one bullet hit a passerby named Ujef. After the firing incident came to light, the police and a senior officials team reached the spot. Karanj Police has registered an attempted murder case against Zahuruddin. Middle-aged man stabbed to death in Ahmedabad In Ahmedabad on July 10th late at night, near Traged underbridge, two persons stabbed and killed a middle-aged man from the Satellite area who was involved in a love affair. Police have arrested three people, including one woman, in this case. Notably, two days ago in Chandkheda, after kidnapping a young man, he was attacked with sticks and knives, leading to his death. The youth was murdered due to an old rivalry.
