Preparations in full swing for national tribal dance fest

Jhabua dancers too gearing up for festival

Preparations are afoot in Chhattisgarh that is going to host its first national level tribal dance festival from December 27 to 29 in Raipur. Tribal dance troupes from over 30 states, numbering over 2500, are expected to take part in the festivities. Madhya Pradesh, which has around 21 per cent tribal population is also going to participate and tribal dancers from tribal districts like Jhabua, Alirajpur, Dhar, Barwani, Shahdol, Dindori are busy preparing to showcase their talent in the national scene through this festival.

According to plans, each state will send four groups of tribal dancers and each group will have 15 dancers each. The dance competition will be based on four themes. This includes dances on weddings or auspicious occasions, dance during harvest/agricultural based festivals, dance during traditional festivals and the last category is an open competition.

During this dance festival, exhibitions stalls highlighting government welfare schemes, products from cottage industry, tribal arts from Bastar and Sarguja, various regional cuisines, art and culture of Chhattisgarh will be put up.

Official sources said that a state-level committee has been formed under the chairmanship of Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel to



chalk out the programme schedule.

Other members in the committee include Home Minister Tamradhwaj Sahu, Agriculture Minister Ravindra Choubey, Tribal Welfare Minister Dr Premsai Singh Tekam, Forest Minister Mohammad Akbar, Food Minister Amarjeet Bhagat and Sports and Youth Welfare Minister Umesh Patel. Culture Department has been made

the nodal department for organising the programme.

Chief Secretary, DGP, Principal Secretary to Chief Minister and some other senior bureaucrats too have been included in the committee as members. Baghel is in touch with other chief ministers and ministers of tribal areas to ensure that the programme is a success.

SC slams ED's handling of Shivakumar's bail plea

The Supreme Court on Friday slammed the ED for doing a shoddy job of "copy and paste" when challenging the bail granted to ex-Karnataka minister and Congress leader D.K. Shivakumar referred to him in the petition as "former Home Minister and Finance Minister". A bench headed by Justice Rohinton Nariman said: "This is not the way you treat the citizens." The bench expressed its anguish after Shivakumar's counsel, senior Advocates A.M. Singhvi and Mukul Rohatgi noted the contents of the petition in question had been copied from the petition filed against Chidambaram.

The SC thereafter junked the ED's petition challenging the Delhi HC order granting bail to the Congress leader from Karnataka. The court also expressed its unhappiness after being informed by the counsel representing Shivakumar that the ED has "resurrected" the stringent Section 45 of the PMLA, which was quashed in 2017.

Centre withholding ...

The report was not released on time despite being vetted by the National Statistical Commission. The Congress on Friday latched on to the controversy with none other than Rahul Gandhi saying that "Modinomics stinks so much," that the Centre has to hide its own reports.

Party general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra also took a swipe at the government, saying the Modi dispensation is making history by "driving people into poverty".

The fall in consumer spending for the first time in more than four decades is primarily attributed to slackening of rural demand.

Priyanka Gandhi tweeted, "Consumer spending in India has collapsed. Successive governments have striven tirelessly to combat poverty and empower the people. This government is making history by driving people into poverty, while rural India faces the dire consequences of their policies, the BJP ensures that their corporate friends become richer by the day".

Congress spokesperson Pawan Khera said that the most serious matter is that even the consumption of food has declined, which implied that malnutrition was getting worse.

Indore officers to take public...

Speaking about the initiative, Jatav said "I got inspiration for this initiative from people of Indore. People of Indore support all initiatives which are in the interest of their city and its people."

He stated the purpose of him and other senior officers (officers) travelling in public transport was aimed at creating atmosphere.

"For doing something new, you have to create atmosphere for it. Travelling in public transport by us (officers) on Friday was aimed at creating that atmosphere," the collector said.

He stated that their move was also aimed at shattering the belief that use of public transport is associated with status symbol. "If you are using public transport, it does mean that you don't have your own car or vehicle," he said. He stated that the administration is going to improve quality of public transport so that well-off families also use public transport without any hesitation.

"Use of public transport will reduce number of private vehicles on road and check pollution also," he added. Jatav appealed to hospitals, colleges and other private organizations to encourage their staff into using public transport to reach office at least for a day in a week.
