Assembly special session to be convened if required: Speaker

Ishi Assembly Speaker under Gupta on Friday said special session of the House will be convened "if required" owing to the "unfortunate incident" of alleged direct towards Sikh Gurus disrupted proceedings three days.

The controversy stems from allegations of direct towards Sikh Gurus during discussion in the Assembly on January 6 to the Delhi government's programme held last to mark the 350th anniversary of Guru Gobind Singh.

The issue has since escalated into a major political row involving the BJP and the AAP-led NDA.

Leader of the Opposition in the Assembly Atishi has used the BJP of indulging petty politics by dragging the name of the ninth Sikh Guru. She, however, did not and the Assembly sittings over the incident.

While the Punjab Police registered an FIR in Jalandhar over the use and circulation of an alleged "doctored" video clip of Atishi, the Delhi Assembly has sought responses from senior police officers in Punjab over an alleged breach of privilege.

Addressing a press conference here, Gupta said that on January 7, the verbatim transcript of the January 6 proceedings was read out in the House, after which Atishi was given an opportunity to clarify his position. He said she was also given a chance to explain herself on January 6 itself.

which Atishi was again asked to come to the House to offer an explanation or express regret and place her defence on record.

He said controversies of this nature arise when words are spoken without emotional connect, sensitivity and reverence, leading to hurt sentiments.

Gupta emphasised that the Leader of the House and the Leader of the Opposition occupy important constitutional positions and carry equal responsibilities to respect the sentiment and the dignity of the House.

He said, "Not participating in discussions, leaving the House and remaining absent for the rest of the session despite repeated summons was a matter of serious concern."

The Delhi Assembly on Thursday directed Atishi to submit her written statement by January 19 regarding the alleged "derogatory remark" made against Sikh Gurus during the recently concluded Winter session.

The Speaker said that when the issue was first raised, Atishi left the House without responding, even though she could have clarified her stand at that moment. As members collectively heard the matter, the atmosphere became extremely tense, forcing the Chair to suspend proceedings.

Gupta said the Chair refrained from taking an immediate decision on

January 7, given the seriousness and sensitivity of the issue.

Jamia Hamdard to host Kashmiri Youth Exchange Programme

A first of its kind, the event to be university, Jamia Hamdard, is all set to organise a Kashmiri Youth Exchange Programme (KYEP) from January 17 to January 22, 2026. The students of six districts from the valley including 80 boys and 50 girls have been selected for the programme who will stay in for six days.

Addressing a press conference in this regard, the Vice Chancellor, Jamia Hamdard, Prof. Asgar Ali, said, "We are proud to host this great event—the My Jammu, Kashmiri Youth Exchange Programme. The event is organised in collaboration with the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports."



"Different events will be conducted to bring them together and to develop a feeling that we are Hindustani, we are Bharatiya, and we are not separate. So, they will be shown Jammu Hamdard and the culture of Jammu Hamdard," said Ali.

A total of 132 youth participants from six districts of Jammu and Kashmir—Anantnag, Kupwara, Baramulla, Budgam, Srinagar and Pulwama—will attend the programme. Its primary objective is to promote cultural exchange and national integration.

The primary goal of this exchange is to provide Kashmiri youth with a platform to experience the diverse cultural landscape of the national Capital while promoting the spirit of Bharat Shreshtha Bharat. By interacting with peers and visiting sites of historical and educational importance, the participants are encouraged to act as ambassadors of peace and integrity within their home regions."

The Registrar of Jammu Hamdard, Colonel Tahir Mustafa, said, "We are delighted that Jamia Hamdard has been chosen as the host institute for the KYEP. We will also organise entrepreneurial development classes for Kashmiri youth. There will be discussions on national integration, unity and diversity and many more," Col Mustafa said.

Kapil Mishra directs officials to ensure social security for gig workers

Delhi Labour Minister Kapil Mishra on Friday directed officials to speed up the process for providing social security benefits to the gig and construction workers in the unorganised sector.

Mishra also said that Delhi's Labour Code should be aligned with that of the Centre to ensure maximum benefits to workers.

The minister made the statement after attending a meeting to review the publication and notification of rules framed under the Centre's Code on Social Security.

Welfare boards will be constituted to launch schemes benefitting the workers employed in the unorganised sector, a statement from the labour

department said. The Code on Social Security provides for the constitution of welfare boards for the unorganised sector and for the formulation of welfare schemes for them.

Mishra directed officers of the labour department to ensure that the benefits of schemes reach unorganised workers, gig and platform workers, and construction workers swiftly and transparently, said the statement.

The Union Ministry of Labour and Employment has consolidated 20 existing labour laws into four Labour Codes—the Code on Wages, the Code on Industrial Relations, the Code on Social Security, and the Code on Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions.

The objective of these codes is to protect workers' rights, promote ease of doing business and expand social security coverage.

21-year-old stabbed to death in Jaitpur

A 21-year-old man was stabbed to death, allegedly after he tried to intervene in a dispute involving his friend and a group of youths over an issue linked to a girl in Delhi's Jaitpur area.

According to the police, the incident occurred late Thursday night when the victims went to meet another group for reconciliation meeting following a dispute over social media posts.

Police received a PCR call at 11.15 pm. Upon reaching, the police team found three injured men and shifted them to the hospital.

One of the victims, Krishna Sahu (21), sustained multiple stab injuries to the chest, shoulder and back. He was declared brought dead at the AIIMS Trauma Centre.



Another victim, Sunny (21), suffered injuries to the abdomen and thigh and was undergoing treatment. The third victim, Prince (19), was discharged after receiving first aid for minor injuries.

Police in a statement said that a preliminary inquiry revealed that the clash was triggered by a personal dispute involving a mutual friend.

The conflict began when one of the accused, identified as Deepak, shared different posts on social media directed at Prince.
