'Global leader' PM Modi held in high regard for championing issues of Global South: SA envoy

New Delhi, As Prime Minister Narendra Modi heads to South Africa next week to attend the Group of 20 (G20) Leaders' Summit in Johannesburg, the country's envoy in New Delhi on Saturday hailed the continuous efforts and contributions made by the Indian PM to fulfill the collective aspirations of the Global South. Millennial media consulting

"It's a given fact that Prime Minister Modi is highly respected globally within the African continent. He is held in high regard in South Africa and we see him as an important global leader who is championing issues of the Global South, including Africa. This will be Prime Minister Modi's fourth visit to South Africa in less than a decade. I think he's one of the Indian Prime Ministers that has gone to South Africa the most number of times. And, that's also true of his numerous visits to the African continent and including of President Droupadi Murmu who has visited several African countries since she assumed office. This signifies the importance that India places on its relationship with the African continent, including South Africa," Anil Sooklal, the High Commissioner of South Africa to India, revealed to IANS in an exclusive chat on Saturday.

India, under PM Modi, spearheaded efforts that led to the African Union joining the G20 - an achievement termed as a landmark during India's G20 presidency in 2023.

"We must recall that it was through his efforts, and that of the Indian government, who championed the inclusion of the African Union into the G20 as a full member during India's presidency in 2023. And, I think the African continent leaders have spoken very favourably of the role that India and especially Prime Minister Modi played in ensuring that the AU is now a full member," said Sooklal.

The G20 Leaders' Summit is set to take place on November 22 and 23 in Johannesburg, South Africa's largest city and economic hub.

South African President Cyril Ramaphosa and Prime Minister Modi will also hold an important bilateral meeting on the sidelines of the event where they are likely to not only reflect on the status of the current bilateral relationship but also look at new areas of cooperation in areas like



security cooperation, people-to-people contact, etc.

"India was one of the first countries to support our struggle against apartheid and to support our liberation struggle. Since we became a democracy in 1994, our relationship has grown significantly. India is our third largest trading partner, one of our most important global partners. We have a very deep foundation that underpins our relationship.

The cooperation we have within the multilateral domain, within terms of bilateral trade, is very vibrant, it continues to grow.

"And, I am sure when Prime Minister Modi and President Ramaphosa meet next week for bilateral meeting, which they will have, they will reflect on the status of the relationship and also we look at new areas of cooperation in deepening this very important relationship in areas like security cooperation, in areas like people to people contact. And also, in terms of trade and investment, cultural

cooperation, as you know, sports and culture is a major pillar of our cooperation in terms of cementing ties between our respective countries," Sooklal told IANS.

Ahead of PM Modi's visit, the African media is highlighting how two years ago, during India's Presidency at the G20 Summit in New Delhi, Prime Minister Modi formally announced the African Union's inclusion as a permanent member of the group.

"This was a seismic announcement, allowing the AU the ability to give Africa a unified voice in global economic governance, promote equitable representation, and advance the continent's interests in areas like trade, climate change, and development. The genesis of the AU joining the G20 actually started seven years ago, when Modi unveiled India's 10 'guiding principles' for ties with African countries during a speech in the Ugandan parliament," a report in South African media outlet IOL detailed.

Political slugfest in Bengal over Trinamool leader Kalyan Banerjee's remarks linking PM Modi with Delhi blast

Kolkata, A political slugfest has surfaced in West Bengal on Saturday over a controversial statement made by four-time Trinamool Congress Lok Sabha member and senior advocate of Calcutta High Court, Kalyan Banerjee, during the day linking Prime Minister Narendra Modi in connection with the car explosion in New Delhi earlier this week, killing 12 persons.

While speaking to the media persons, Banerjee said that the blast was conducted deliberately just a day before the second phase of the Bihar Assembly polls, just to create a sympathy wave in favour of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).

The car explosion took place near Red Fort Metro Station in Delhi on the evening of November 10, and on



November 11, the second phase of the two-phase Bihar polls took place.

On Friday, after the announcement of the Bihar Assembly poll results, where the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) established a landslide victory, the Prime Minister said that the

Bihar results have paved the way for the BJP's victory in West Bengal for the 2026 state Assembly polls.

"I would like to assure the people of West Bengal that 'Jungle Raj' will end in West Bengal in 2026," the Prime Minister said on Friday.

Reacting to the Prime

Minister's comments regarding the 2026 West Bengal Assembly polls, Kalyan Banerjee said on Saturday that the Delhi car explosion was conducted deliberately just a day before the second phase of the Bihar Assembly polls, just to create a sympathy wave in favour of the BJP, and also held the Prime Minister responsible for masterminding that conspiracy.

"The Prime Minister has destroyed the democratic ambience in India. Hundreds of people are dying in the country. He had won by planting bombs in the car near the Red Fort Metro station the night before the second phase of the Bihar election. The 'Jungle Raj' has been established in the country by the Prime Minister himself. When you were the Chief Minister in Gujarat, you were

killing people. You established jungle raj in Madhya Pradesh and Delhi. On the contrary, the people of West Bengal are at peace. The people of West Bengal gave a fitting reply to the BJP in 2021. They will give a befitting reply to the BJP again in 2026," Banerjee added.

Scribe-turned-politician and BJP's state General Secretary Jagannath Chattopadhyay said that a competition is going on between Kalyan Banerjee and a state spokesman of Trinamool Congress on who is more capable of pronouncing slurs at the Prime Minister of the country.

"The more they use such slurs, the more popularity the BJP will gain in West Bengal. Our Prime Minister is in the hearts of common people," Chattopadhyay added.

Navy chief Admiral Dinesh K Tripathi discusses maritime issues with US Commanders

New Delhi, Indian Navy chief Admiral Dinesh K. Tripathi discussed areas of mutual maritime interest, including deeper information sharing and maritime domain awareness, with top US Commanders during his ongoing official visit, an official said on Saturday.

The Chief of Naval Staff held a series of high-level "engagements with Adm Samuel J Paparo, Commander @INDOPACOM; Adm Stephen T Koehler, Commander



@USPacificFleet; and Lt Gen James F Glynn, Commander US Marine Forces Pacific. @USMC," said Indian Navy Spokesperson in a post on X.

"Deliberations reviewed key pillars of defence cooperation, including strengthening #MaritimeSecurity and #MaritimeCooperation, enhancing #Interoperability, and expanding avenues for operational engagements across the Indo-Pacific," he said.

Processes relating to fire permits, licensing, and other statutory approvals have been simplified, made more transparent, and integrated through a single-window mechanism, she said.

Earlier, multiple agencies were involved, resulting in procedural delays and inconvenience. Clear departmental accountability has now been established, and responsibility for issuing the final certificate rests with the designated authority.

She further emphasised that to ensure maximum transparency, departmental file-processing has been made fully digital.

Citizens can now track the real-time status of their applications, including the officer handling the file, pendency duration, and stage of scrutiny.

Calling the new renewal portal a major administrative reform, the Chief Minister said Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of 'Digital India' is elevating governance across the nation.

In alignment with that vision, the Delhi government remains committed to delivering a 'Digital Delhi' where services are faceless, transparent, and technology-driven.

Highlighting the ease of digital adoption even among small vendors and rickshaw pullers, she said the governance system must evolve at the same pace to remain citizen-friendly and modern. CM Gupta reaffirmed that citizen safety, simplified services, and transparent administration remain the government's highest priorities. Speaking on the occasion, Delhi's Home Minister Ashish Sood said that under the leadership of PM Modi, the nation is progressing with the guiding principle of "Minimum Government, Maximum Governance."

The objective is to make governance simpler, more efficient, and empowering for citizens.

Indian Army conducts drill to assess battle readiness in Rajasthan's Thar desert

Jaipur, The Ranbikra Division of the Indian Army's Saptashakti Command, on Saturday, conducted an extensive validation exercise in Rajasthan's Thar Desert at the Mahajan Field Firing Range to assess its battle readiness and operational efficiency, Army officials said.

Lieutenant General Manjinder Singh, Saptashakti Command Army Commander, reviewed the proceedings of the exercise aimed to refine tactical procedures, enhance inter-arms coordination and test the seamless integration of all entities and detachments under challenging environment and terrain conditions. The exercise tested the troops' endurance, discipline and ability to perform in a realistic high-intensity

environment. The exercise focused on ensuring that combined arms operations comprising of infantry, mechanised forces, air defence, artillery fire support, engineers and logistics, was conducted with precision and agility. Emphasis was also placed on practising command and control procedures, intelligence, coordination and effective incorporation of Ashni Platoons (drones) to enhance combat readiness.
