Shaheen used SIM card obtained on a fake address

The ongoing probe into the Delhi blast has revealed that the suspected member of Jaish-e-Mohammed module, Dr Shaheen Sayeed, had been using a SIM card obtained on a fake address for a long time.

She had obtained a SIM card on the address of a mosque in Faridabad's Dhouj town and had been continuously using it from the Al-Falah University hostel.

Her travel history, frequent UP connections, and recent activities in Lucknow and Kanpur Nagar have further increased security agencies' concerns. The UP Anti-Terrorism Squad and

intelligence teams are now working to trace her movements.

It surfaced that Dr Shaheen operated her network using the mosque's address. During the investigation, the UP ATS and central agencies found that Dr Shaheen extensively used the mobile phone number, SIM card for which was obtained in 2023 by submitting fake documents.

Dr Shaheen, who was living in the Al-Falah University hostel, had a real address in Lucknow, but she neither provided the address of her father's home in Lucknow nor any valid identification documents. It is clear that she deliberately concealed her original address.

The investigation has also



revealed that Dr Shaheen did not mention her real home address in Lucknow in all her documents and official records. While filling the forms, she used to mention her brother Dr Parvez

Ansari's house as her permanent address. The investigating agencies believe that this could be a part of her strategy to maintain the secrecy of her network and travel history.

The role of Dr Parvez is also on the radar of the agencies.

It further surfaced that Dr Shaheen traveled to Thailand after leaving her job in Kanpur. Her travel history has further complicated the investigation. Records reveal that she traveled to Thailand for a few days in 2013, shortly after leaving her job in Kanpur.

The investigating agencies are examining the timeline of her trip to Thailand and her contacts. During this time, sleeper modules of several ter-

rorist organisations were found active in Southeast Asia.

About two months ago, Dr Shaheen suddenly came to Lucknow and took her brother Dr Parvez to Kanpur. The investigators are finding the persons with whom she met, the place of stay, and persons with whom she was in contact with.

The UP ATS believes that her trip to Thailand may have some specific purpose, and electronic surveillance and location dump data are being examined to uncover this. The UP ATS and intelligence teams are busy unraveling her network.

The investigation of Dr Shaheen's electronic devices, banking records and contacts has been intensified.

Youth attacked by neighbours, critically injured

A youth was critically injured after his rivals attacked him at his house in Gudamba over personal enmity on Friday night.

He has been hospitalised and the doctors say his condition is critical.

Based on a complaint from the victim's father, Nimal Kumar, the police have registered an FIR against three accused.

According to reports, Anirudh, a resident of Kakori, had a dispute with the son of his neighbor, Kamal, a few days back and since then Kamal and his family members nursed a grudge against him, leading to the attack.

According to victim's father Nimal Kumar, Kamal's wife, son and daughter suddenly barged into their house on Friday when Anirudh was alone at home and brutally assaulted Anirudh, injuring him seriously.

Anirudh managed to escape and reached his father, Nimal Kumar who was in the house of a neighbour. Seeing his son's critical condition, Nimal Kumar rushed him to a nearby hospital and lodged a complaint against the accused at Dubagga police station. He alleged that an old rivalry had led to the attempt to murder his son.

The police said that a case had been registered against the accused and the matter was being investigated.

The police have assured Nimal Kumar of strict action against the culprits.

ATTACKED

The staff of a car service centre on Ring Road in Gudamba allegedly assaulted a customer in the presence of his son on Saturday.

As per reports, the victim along with his son came to the car service centre on Saturday afternoon to get their car serviced. On some issue, an argument ensued, and the employees of the service centre assaulted him.

The incident came to light after its video went viral. The video was filmed by the victim's son, who kept pleading with the attackers to spare his father but in vain.

Domestic help hit by train, dies

A domestic helper was killed while crossing the railway track with earphones plugged, after he was hit by a train in Gomti Nagar extension police area on Saturday morning.

The 18-year-old victim,

Akhilesh, a resident of Mall locality in Lucknow, lived in a slum near Khargapur railway crossing in Gomti Nagar extension and worked as a house cleaner. He left for work at around 8 am on Saturday and was hit by a train while crossing the Khargapur railway crossing. He died on the spot.

In another incident, an unidentified youth was killed after he was hit by a moving train in the Para area of Lucknow on Saturday.

The incident occurred around 9 am on the Alamnagar-Kakori railway line near the Bhunwar bridge in Para. According to preliminary investigations, the deceased was 25-30 years old. The deceased was clad in blue jeans, a white shirt, and a brown belt. Police are making efforts to identify the victim. Locals told the police that the youth suddenly came in front of the moving train.

INJURED

A woman and an elderly man were seriously injured in a road accident near Bhatoiya village in Rahimabad on Lucknow-Hardoi highway on Saturday morning.

The woman was hit by a speeding two-wheeler while crossing the road around 10:30 am on Saturday.

Police arrest four over dairy owner's murder

A day after the murder of a dairy owner over garbage dumping dispute in Gudamba on Friday, a police team on Saturday nabbed four attackers, including two women members from the accused's family.

The accused have been identified as Afsan, Farukh Ali aka Mohammed Shahrukh, Shamin and Shaheen, all of Adil Nagar in Gudamba. They confessed to their crime and said they attacked the victim, Danish, after he stepped in a verbal spat with his mother. They confessed that they attacked the victim with sticks in a fit of rage but did not intend to kill him. To recall, the victim's mother had a verbal spat with Farukh over

dumping of garbage in front of her house. While the victim's mother alleged that Farukh used to litter the front space of her house, Farukh countered the allegation saying she instead had dirtied it by throwing garbage.

Later Farukh and other members in his family attacked the victim's mother. Hearing the commotion, the victim came out of his house and intervened. This irked the attackers to such an extent that they dragged him from near his house and beat him with sticks until he died on the spot. The accused later fled the scene. On the call of the victim's mother, the family reached the crime scene and Danish was rushed to a hospital where he was pronounced dead. His mother was also injured in the attack.

5 arrested for attack on social worker

The police have arrested five people and sent them to jail for chasing and opening fire on a social worker in Mohanlalganj.

The police have also recovered three cars used in the attack.

Mukesh Dwivedi, a resident of Ishwari Kheda in SGPGI area, and with his friend Himanshu Rawat were going in their Scorpio from a car service centre on Thursday evening to their plot in BCC Heights in Mohanlalganj. The victim, Mukesh Dwivedi, met the deputy commissioner of police on Saturday and demanded a fair investigation and security.

According to Mukesh Dwivedi, the assailants in a black Thar, a white Safari and another car chased their vehicle for several kilometres and tried to hit their Scorpio as it turned toward BCC Heights. When he saved his car from collision, they opened fire in the air to intimidate him.

The police investigating the case arrested Abhishek Tiwari, a resident of Nona Park village in Deoria, Harinam alias Rahul Rawat, a resident of Gosainganj in Amethi, Amit Mishra, Chandan Bhatt, a resident of Kalli West in SGPGI area, and Vineet Tiwari, a resident of Arjunanj, and sent them to jail.

Station House Officer DK Singh stated that the accused were identified by examining the footage of the CCTV installed at Raebareli highway.
