Accordingly, customs duty amounting to Rs. 1,05,18,265/- has been confirmed in the impugned order, along with interest under Section 28AA.</p> <p>The Company will be filing an appeal before the High Court seeking withdrawal of the customs duty and interest. The appeal will be filed within the statutory time limit.</p>
