Massive fire breaks out in Iraq shopping mall

A fire engulfed a newly opened shopping centre in eastern Iraq, killing more than 61 people, including children, Iraqi officials said Thursday. Civil defence teams rescued more than 45 people who became trapped when the fire broke out late Wednesday in the city of Kut, the Interior Ministry said in a statement. Others are still missing, according to the State-run Iraqi News Agency.

Photographs and videos on local media showed the Corniche Hypermarket Mall, a five-storey shopping centre that had opened only a week earlier, fully engulfed in flames. Iraq's Ministry of Interior said in a statement that 61 people died in the shopping centre fire, most of them from suffocation.

Among the dead were 14 charred bodies that remain unidentified, it said. Mohammed al-Mayyeh in a statement declared three days of

mourning. He said the cause of the fire is under investigation but that legal cases were filed against the building owner and shopping centre owner. He did not

specify what the charges were. "We assure the families of the innocent victims that we will not be lenient with those who were directly or indirectly responsible

for this incident," al-Mayyeh said. The results of the preliminary investigation will be released within 48 hours, he said. Iraqi Prime Minister Shia al-Sudani said in a state-

ment that he had directed the interior minister to go to the site of the fire to investigate and take measures to prevent a recurrence.



Rain emergency in Pakistan

Torrential monsoon rains claimed 30 lives in Pakistan's Punjab over the last 24 hours, prompting the government to declare "rain emergency" in different parts, officials said on Thursday.

The most affected area was Chakwal, a salt range area of the province, receiving 423 mm of rain the authorities said. "A rescue operation is underway in Chakwal to evacuate people trapped by flash floods, with support from the military and local administration."

The rainfall is expected to continue across the province on Thursday as well and the authorities have issued an alert for possible flooding in rivers and streams across Punjab. "All relevant departments have been fully mobilised across the province to protect citizens from the worsening flood situation," a Punjab government statement said.

China backs to revive trilateral cooperation

China on Thursday expressed its support for Russia's initiative to revive the dormant Russia-India-China (RIC) troika, saying the trilateral cooperation not only serves the interest of the three countries but also the security and stability of the region and the world.

Russian news portal Izvestia on Thursday quoted Russia's Deputy Foreign Minister Andrei Rudenko as saying that Moscow expects the resumption of the RIC format and is negotiating on this issue with Beijing and New Delhi.

"This topic appears in our negotiations with both of them. We are interested in making this format work, because these three countries are important partners, besides the founders

of BRICS," Rudenko said. "Therefore, the absence of this format, in my opinion, looks inappropriate."

In this regard, we expect that the countries will agree to resume work within the framework of the RIC- of course, when relations between these states reach a level that allows them to work in a trilateral format," he said. his reaction to Rudenko's comments at a media briefing, Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Lin Jian on Thursday said, "China-Russia-India cooperation not only serves the respective interests of the three countries but also helps uphold peace, security, stability and progress in the region and the world." China stands ready to maintain communication with Russia and India on advancing the trilateral cooperation, he said.

Israel strikes hits Gaza church, 2 killed

Two people were killed in an Israeli strike on Gaza's only Catholic church on Thursday morning, according to church officials. Several other people, including the parish priest, were injured. The Catholic charity Caritas Jerusalem said the parish's 60-year-old janitor and an 84-year-old woman receiving psychosocial support inside a Caritas tent in the church compound were killed in the attack. The Israeli military said it is aware of the incident and is investigating. Parish priest Fr Gabriel Romanelli, who was close to the late Pope Francis, was also injured.

Parish priest Fr Gabriel Romanelli was very close with the late Pope Francis and the two spoke often during the war in Gaza. Catholic church in Gaza was damaged in the attack, officials said, in what witnesses said appeared to be an Israeli tank shelling. The church was sheltering both Christians and Muslims, including a number of children with disabilities, according to Fadel Naem, acting

director of Al-Ahli Hospital, which received the wounded.

At least two people were in critical condition, and others injured included one child with disabilities, two women, and an elderly person, Naem said. The Israeli military did not have immediate comment on the strike. Italian Premier Giorgia Meloni blamed Israel for the strike on the civilian population that Israel has been

demonstrating for months are unacceptable.

No military action can justify such an attitude. The church is just a stone's throw from Al-Ahli Hospital, Naem said, noting that the area around both the church and the hospital has been repeatedly struck for over a week. At least two people were killed in strikes on Gaza on Thursday, including one in Gaza City and one in central Gaza's

Bureij refugee camp, according to local hospitals.

In the last 18 months of his life, Francis would often call the lone Catholic church in the Gaza Strip to see how people huddled inside were coping with a devastating war. Last year, he told CBS' "60 Minutes" that he calls a priest daily at 7 pm at the Holy Family Church to hear what was happening to the nearly 600 people sheltering at the facility.

Australian PM indulges in panda diplomacy

Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese has toured a panda breeding facility in the final stages of an extended State visit that has cast China as a fellow champion of a global fair trade system under threat from the United States.

The panda diplomacy stop Thursday in the central Chinese city of Chengdu highlighted Australia's special status as the only Southern Hemisphere country to host a pair of the rare Chinese native animals. Albanese and his fiancée Jodie Heydon visited a pen where they saw Fu Ni, a giant panda who had been on loan to Australia's Adelaide Zoo until last year.

"A great ambassador for China and a great friend of Australia," Albanese said of Fu Ni as she chomped on bamboo. China loans Australia pandas Premier Li Qiang used a visit to the Adelaide Zoo last year to announce Fu Ni and her partner Wang Wang would be

replaced by another China-born pair that will hopefully breed. The new couple, Xing Qiu and Yi Yan, made their public debut in January at the zoo in the South Australia State capital where they are a major tourist attraction.

Albanese's China trip, which began Saturday and ends on Friday, is extraordinarily long compared with Australian state visits over the past decade and marks a normalisation of bilateral relations that plumbed new depths under the previous Australian Government's nine-year reign.

Albanese said he had visited Chengdu and the Great Wall of China, as well as the usual diplomatic destinations of Beijing and Shanghai, as a show of respect to the Chinese people.

"The Great Wall of China symbolises the extraordinary history and culture here in China, and showing a bit of respect to people never cost anything. But you know what it does? It gives you a reward," Albanese told reporters.

Syria withdraws army from Sweida after Israel attack

Syrian government forces largely withdrew from the southern province of Sweida Thursday following days of vicious clashes with militias of the Druze minority. Under a ceasefire agreement reached the day before, which largely halted the hostilities, Druze factions and clerics have been appointed to maintain internal security in Sweida, Syria's interim President Ahmad al-Sharaa said in an address broadcast early Thursday.

The dayslong fighting threatened to unravel Syria's postwar political transition and brought in further military intervention by its powerful neighbour Israel, which on Wednesday struck the Syrian Defence Ministry headquarters in the heart of Damascus. Israel said it was acting to protect the Druze religious minority. Druze leaders and Syrian government officials reached a ceasefire deal mediated by the United States, Turkey and Arab countries. Convoys of government forces started withdrawing from the city of Sweida overnight as Syrian state media said the withdrawal was in line with the ceasefire agreement and the military operation against the Druze factions had ended.

It remained unclear if the ceasefire would hold after the agreement was announced by Syria's Interior Ministry and in a video message by a Druze religious leader. A previous agreement Tuesday quickly broke down after being dismissed by prominent Druze

cleric Sheikh Hikmat Al-Hijri. The escalation in Syria began with tit-for-tat kidnappings and attacks between local Sunni Bedouin tribes and Druze armed factions in the southern province of Sweida. Government forces that intervened to restore order clashed with the Druze militias, but also in some cases attacked civilians. The Syrian government has not issued a casualty count from the clashes, but some rights groups and monitors say dozens of combatants on both sides have been killed, as well as dozens of largely Druze civilians killed in sectarian attacks.

Syrian Observatory for Human Rights, a Britain-based war monitor, says at least 374 combatants and civilians were killed in the clashes and Israeli strikes, among them dozens of civilians killed in the crossfire or in targeted attacks against the minority group. Videos circulated on social media showed government forces and allies humiliating Druze clerics and residents, looting homes and killing civilians hiding inside their houses. Syrian Druze

from Sweida told The Associated Press that several family members who were unarmed had been attacked or killed. Al-Sharaa appealed to them in his address and vowed to hold perpetrators to account. "We are committed to holding accountable those who wronged our Druze brethren," he said, calling the Druze an "integral part of this nation's fabric" who are under the protection of state law and justice, which safeguards the rights of everyone without exception.

The Druze community had been divided over how to approach Al-Sharaa's de facto Islamist rule over Syria after largely celebrating the downfall of Bashar Assad and his family's decades-long dictatorship. They feared persecution after several attacks from the Islamic State militant group. While it first appeared many Druze hoped to resolve matters diplomatically, over time they became more sceptical, especially after a counterinsurgency in the coastal province targeted attacks against the Alawite religious minority.
