Business Updates



The Meeting of Equity Shareholders of Gujarat Gas Limited was held on 17th October 2025, as directed by the Hon'ble Ministry of Corporate Affairs. Voting results from remote e-voting and e voting during the shareholder meeting were submitted, along with the Scrutinizer's Report to Stock Exchanges. The shareholders have approved the Composite Scheme of Amalgamation and Arrangement with thumping majority and the Company has filed Chairman's Report and Confirmation petition with Hon'ble Ministry of Corporate Affairs.

GGL as a plan to expand its footprint in CNG Business has commissioned its 1st FDODO station in Jamnagar district in Q2 FY 2026 and has executed ~78 CNG FDODO Agreements.

Achieved Highest CNG volumes 3.45 mmscmd in Q3 FY26, Robust annual growth of 11% on the back of investments in CNG station infrastructure. Company is also aggressively pushing for FDODO model which will help in accelerating growth for the future.








Gas Pipeline Network






Sales Volume Composition

Average APM Allocation (%)











CBG Offtake by GGL

- Inline with National Policy on Bio-Fuels for promoting waste to energy program and reduce carbon emissions, Gujarat Gas is actively engaged with CBG producers for increasing its offtake into CNG / PNG network
- **GGL is amongst the first CGD companies to offtake Compress Bio-Gas (CBG) into its NG pipeline network.**
- Commissioned India's first ever CBG off-take facility via Steel pipeline at Batala, Gurdaspur.
- **In Q-3 FY26, Eight (8) new Agreement signed** with Bio-gas suppliers for offtake of Bio-gas/CBG, taking tally to 27 agreements.
- GGL is off-taking Bio-gas/CBG currently at 8 locations across authorized areas.

ESG Initiatives (2/3):Trainings & Awareness

Trainings on HSE, Skill upgradation & Human Rights during Q3 FY 26

- **Offline Training :** HSE Training to 100 employees & Skill upgradation trainings to 90 employees.
- **Online Trainings :** Through 'iGOT Karmayogi' (Integrated Government Online Training) digital / e-learning platform online trainings was conducted for employees.
- **Multiple Trainings on POSH (Prevention of Sexual Harassment):** Multiple POSH trainings were conducted, reaching 212 employees.
- **HSE & Technical Competency Training and Awareness for contractor staff:** 1106 nos. of training sessions were conducted covering 8079 participants
- **Customer and general public Awareness on Natural Gas Safety:** Conducted 382 awareness sessions covering 4,578 participants.
- **Third party utility Awareness on Gas Safety & Pipeline damage prevention:** 800+ awareness meetings/briefings involving District Administration/ MC/ Nagarpalika departments/Electricity & Telecom utilities/ Fire department etc. covering 2800 participants.

Solar Group Captive project: GGL has planned to install around 12 MW of Group Captive Solar plant under the capex model for the Company Owned CNG stations, CGS and Offices.

Tree Plantation: In Q-3 FY26, 450+ sapling/trees were planted across GGL locations taking total tally to 4,600 till date in current Financial Year.




