Plea pending in SC, Ashoka prof sent to judicial custody until May 27

A COURT in Sonipat on Tuesday sent Ali Khan Mahmudabad, associate professor and head of the Department of Political Science at Ashoka University, to judicial custody until the next hearing on May 27.

Mahmudabad was arrested on Sunday for remarks he posted on social media that, an FIR alleged, “disparaged women officers in the Indian Armed Forces and promoted communal disharmony”.

Several political parties and academicians have condemned the arrest. On Monday, the Supreme Court agreed to hear his plea challenging the arrest.

Mahmudabad was produced before the court of Judicial Magistrate (First Class) Azad Singh in Sonipat on Tuesday, after the expiry of his two-day police remand.

While the police sought his remand for seven more days, the court dismissed the application and sent Mahmudabad to judicial custody, ordering him to be produced through video conferencing on May 27. Seeking extension of police remand, the prosecution told

the court that Mahmudabad's laptop and cellphone had been sent to the Forensic Science Laboratory in Panchkula, and the reports were awaited. While his call detail records had been obtained, records of communication via social media were yet to be recovered/ retrieved from his cellphone and laptop, it said.

The prosecution submitted that Mahmudabad said in his disclosure statement that he had visited 14 foreign countries, and the records of his visits had to be obtained. It also said that detailed statements of his bank accounts were yet to be received.

Mahmudabad's lawyers, Kapil Dev Balyan and Mohd Chand Hussain, argued that all the details pertaining to his bank accounts as well as his passport had already been pro-

vided. Mahmudabad also undertook to submit his passport to the Investigating Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday.

They pointed out that Mahmudabad was from the University of Cambridge and had many friends abroad. “It cannot be presumed that he has any links with some anti-national elements,” they said.

The court observed that the plea for extension of police remand was “primarily for confrontation with the data, which is yet to be received from Forensic Lab, Panchkula, and for the recovery of passport”. Saying that “the requisite details are yet to be received by investigating agency,” it dismissed the plea. When these details are received, “it would be open to the Investigating Officer to move fresh application if so required and advised,” it said.

Mahmudabad was arrested based on two separate FIRs lodged on complaints received from the Haryana State Commission for Women chairperson Renu Bhatia and Jathari village sarpanch Yogesh Jathari who is also the general secretary of BJP Yuva Morcha in the state.

Both the FIRs refer to a post by Mahmudabad, a Samajwadi Party member and former

spokesperson, on May 8 in which he said the optics of the media briefing on Operation Sindoor by women officers – Col Sofiya Qureshi and Wg Cdr Vyomika Singh – was “important” but would be “hypocrisy” if it didn't “translate to reality on the ground”.

In a statement later, Mahmudabad had said his remarks were “completely misunderstood”.

Both the FIRs were lodged at the Rai police station in Sonipat district under various sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

The FIR based on the complaint of Bhatia was lodged under Sections 353 (statements conducing to public mischief), 79 (word, gesture or act intended to insult modesty of a woman) and 152 (act endangering sovereignty, unity, and integrity of India).

The FIR on Jathari's complaint was lodged under Sections 196(1)B (promoting enmity between different groups on grounds of religion), 197(1)C (assertions prejudicial to national integration), 152 (act endangering sovereignty, unity and integrity of India) and 299 (malicious acts, intended to outrage religious feelings).

After Delhi elections loss, Arvind Kejriwal unveils ASAP — Aam Aadmi Party’s revamped student wing

AAM AADMI Party (AAP) chief Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday launched a revamped and re-named the party's student wing — the Association of Students for Alternate Politics (ASAP) — at the Constitution Club of India.

Critiquing mainstream politics, he said, “While the world is focused on AI (artifi-

cial intelligence), mainstream politicians are pushing your children into religious conflicts — while they send their own kids to elite foreign universities. Winning elections through misuse of power, manipulating electoral rolls is their mainstream politics, while winning hearts and elections is alternative politics.”

The event marked a significant political outreach to the youth by the party, with stu-

dents from Delhi, Punjab, Haryana, and Gujarat, dressed in yellow shirts, in attendance.

The event marked a rare political appearance by Kejriwal in Delhi following AAP's defeat in the February 2025 Assembly elections. The party, which had held power in Delhi since 2015, is now focusing its efforts on Punjab, where it remains in government.

Kejriwal said the goal of ASAP is to restore the dignity of politics and inspire a genera-

tion committed to reform. “Politics has become a dirty word — we need to restore its integrity and inspire a generation which is committed to serving the nation,” he said.

He announced that cultural and discussion groups would be established in colleges nationwide to engage students in the ideas of mainstream versus alternative politics. “A new generation of student leaders will be developed who work for reforms,” he added.
