CM gives infra boost to higher education

Chennai, May 20: Chief Minister M.K. Stalin lays foundation and inaugurates higher education infrastructure worth over Rs.327.84 crore

At a function held today at Queen Mary’s College, Chennai, Chief Minister M.K. Stalin inaugurated newly constructed educational buildings worth Rs.120.02 crore, including a women’s hostel built at a cost of Rs.42 crore at the college. Additionally, he laid the foundation stone for new infrastructure projects in the higher education sector, to be constructed at a cost of Rs.207.82 crore.

As part of this initiative, various new buildings such as classrooms,

laboratories, administrative blocks, and hostels have been built in government arts and science colleges, engineering colleges, polytechnic colleges, and universities across Tamil Nadu.

The Chief Minister also laid the foundation stone for a new auditorium to be built at Queen Mary’s College campus with Rs.5 crore from MP Thiru P. Wilson’s MP Local Area Development Fund.

The govt is promoting Higher Education in Tamil Nadu with launching new institutions, Enhancing research, innovation, and technical skills, creating employment opportunities, supporting skill development through the “Naan Mudhalvan”

scheme, providing Rs.1,000 monthly aid to eligible students under “Pudhumai Pen” (for girls) and “Tamil Puthalvan” (for boys) schemes, offering support to first-generation graduates, upgrading college and university infrastructure.

These efforts have helped Tamil Nadu achieve the top rank in higher education enrolment across India.
