# At least 26, mostly tourists, killed in J&K terror attack

IN THE DEADLIEST terror attack on tourists in J&K in over three decades at least 26 people were shot dead and several others injured in south Kashmir's Pahalgam on Tuesday. Sources indicated that the death toll could climb.

The attack took place in the afternoon at Baisaran valley — it's an off-road meadow a little over 6 km from Pahalgam — which was packed with tourists. Gunmen showed up and fired indiscriminately at the tourists.

A local trade leader, who did not wish to be named, said, "There were around 1,000-1,500 tourists in Baisaran at that time." He said the shopkeepers in Baisaran told him that three-fourteen gunmen fired indiscriminately on the tourists at multiple places. "We reached Baisaran about half an hour after the incident. Bodies were scattered on the ground. There were some injured as well, and their families. They were in shock. We tried to comfort them," he said.

"Soon after we arrived, a police team also reached and drove us away," he said, adding that a local ponywallah was among the dead. Chief minister Omar Abdullah said the attack was "much larger than anything we have seen directed at civilians in recent years."

"This attack on survivors is an abomination. The perpetrators of this attack are animals — inhuman and worthy of contempt. No words of condemnation are enough," he said. Officials were tightlipped about the death toll.

Sources, however, said that more than 20 tourists and a local ponywallah were killed in the attack.

## Those behind the attack won't be spared, says PM

CONDEMNING THE TERROR attack in Jammu and Kashmir that killed at least 26 people, PM Narendra Modi on Tuesday said that those behind the heinous act will be brought to justice.

In a post on X, the prime minister said, "They (terrorists) will not be spared! Their evil agenda will never succeed. Our resolve to fight terrorism is unshakable and it will get even stronger." Modi also conveyed his condolences to those who lost their loved ones in the attack. "I

pray that the injured recover at the earliest. All possible assistance is being provided to those affected," he said. Modi also spoke to home minister Amit Shah following the attack and asked him to take all suitable steps to deal with the situation.

Meanwhile, the Prime Minister is set to cut short his visit to Saudi Arabia and leave for home on Tuesday night in view of the dastardly terror attack, sources said.

The 26 dead included two foreigners and two locals, a

high ranking official said without getting into details. Several Union ministers have condemned the terror attack. Tourism minister Gajendra Singh Shekawat said the perpetrators of the terror attack will face the harshest consequences.

"Deeply pained by the brutal terror attack on tourists in Pahalgam, J&K. My thoughts are with the families of the victims of this cowardly act, perpetrator of which will face the harshest consequences," Shekawat said. —PTI

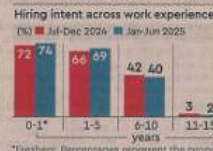

# Demand for freshers surges in H1 '25

THE DEMAND FOR freshers and professionals with 1-5 years of experience is expected to grow in the first half of 2025. The latest report from Team-LEASE Etech shows that not just a significantly higher proportion of companies are willing to hire freshers in the January-to-June 2025 period, they are going to ramp up their fresher hiring in the first six months of 2025 as compared to July-to-December 2024 period.

For instance, 74% of companies have reported that they will hire freshers in H1'25 as compared to 72% in H2'24. The surge in fresher hiring is fuelled by the demand for professionals trained in AI tools.

"The Union Budget has allocated ₹500 crore for the centre of excellence in AI education. This shows India's zeal to proliferate AI research and skills at a massive scale. The hiring trend across industries aligns closely with the government's vision of creating an AI-proficient workforce through strategic budget allocation & education initiatives," the report said.

Similarly, 69% of compa-

nies plan to hire professionals with 1-5 years of experience in H1'25 as compared to 66% in H2'24. On the other side, the demand for experienced professionals (6 years of work experience and above) is on a slide. However, on an aggregate basis, more companies are intending to hire more people in the first half of 2025 (79%) in comparison to second half of

2024 (72%).

The survey said young professionals can find unpreceded opportunities in e-commerce and tech start-ups with 70% of the employers planning to hire freshers, followed by the manufacturing sector at 66% and engineering & infrastructure at 62%. Chief cities like Bangalore, Mumbai, and Chennai remain key employment hubs

with hiring intent in these cities reaching 78%, 65% and 57%, respectively, the report said.

While hiring companies are increasingly seeking professionals with technical and interpersonal capabilities in terms of soft skills for entry-level positions, employers are looking for computer skills, analytic reasoning, adaptability and flexibility.

# Google paid Samsung 'enormous sums' to preinstall Gemini AI app

ALPHABET PAYS SAMSUNG ELECTRONICS AN "enormous sum of money" every month to pre-install Google generative AI app, Gemini, on its phones and devices, according to court testimony, even though the company's practice of paying for installations has twice been found to violate the law.

The company began paying Samsung for Gemini in January, according to Peter Fitzgerald, Google's vice president of platform and device partnerships, as testified Monday and Tuesday in Washington federal

court as part of the Justice Department's antitrust case.

The contract, set to run at least two years, provides fixed monthly payments for each device that preinstalls Gemini and pays Samsung a percentage of the revenue Google earns from advertisements

within the app, Fitzgerald told Judge Amit Mehta, who is overseeing the case.

Samsung also received "competitive offers" from other AI firms, Fitzgerald acknowledged, including Microsoft, Meta and OpenAI to include their AI apps. "We took into con-

sideration what was being offered by competitors," Fitzgerald said Tuesday about Google's offer to Samsung. On cross examination, Fitzgerald said that the agreement with Samsung would allow the firm to allow alternative generative AI services if it wants. The company also amended its search agreement with Samsung as of this month to eliminate the requirement that Samsung only pre-install Google's search engine and personal assistant, he said.

Mehta found last year that Google's practice of paying Samsung to be the default search engine on its devices violated antitrust law. —BLOOMBERG
