Surat: ACP dismissed for 'submitting fake caste certificate' in '93

OVER 30 years after he joined service, and a few weeks before he was set to retire, an Assistant Commissioner of Police (ACP) in Surat, B. M. Chaudhary, was dismissed from his duties following an order by the State Home Department in this regard on Wednesday. Chaudhary was accused of submitting a fake caste certificate of Scheduled Tribe (ST) at the time of recruitment for the post of police sub-inspector in 1993. Chaudhary was due to retire on June 30.

Deputy Commissioner of Police, Zone 5, R. P. Barot said, "We have received an order of dismissal of ACP B. M. Chaudhary (Bapu Motiram Chaudhary) from the state home department on May 20. We have handed a copy to him, and he has been relieved from his duties with immediate effect. He worked in the Gujarat police department in different districts and cities for the past 30 years."

While Chaudhary could not be contacted for comment, his nephew Jitendra insisted that they belong to ST category only. Jitendra, a resident of Kukarnunda, said, "My uncle was born and brought up in

the police recruitment drive for sub-inspector post in 1993 and cleared his physical and written tests. He worked in different districts across Gujarat and was promoted from police sub-inspector to inspector rank after 10 years. He was promoted to ACP rank in 2019. He was transferred to the Surat city police department and deployed as ACP, K division, in 2022.

Sources close to his family said that, around two years ago, somebody from Chaudhary's family complained to the Director General of Police (DGP) and the State Home Department about the alleged fake caste certificate he submitted to get a job in the police department. Police sources said that the home department had directed the Social Welfare department to probe Chaudhary's caste certificate.

During the probe, the team visited his house in Kukarnunda, met his relatives, and collected information from government records in the town, and sources said. The report was submitted to the State home department, after which a decision to dismiss him was made, said a senior police officer in Surat.

Sources close to Chaudhary said he would take up the issue with the Gujarat High Court in days to come.

MS university receives 22,716 applications under GCAS

Vadodra: With the procedure of filing applications under the Gujarat Common Admission Services (GCAS) drawing to a close, Maharashtra Sayajirao University of Baroda (MSU) Thursday said it has received 22,716 applications for its undergraduate (UG) programmes for 2025-26, with the Faculty of Commerce receiving over 10,000 applications.

MSU, in a statement, said, "This year marks a transformative shift in the admission process, with MSU fully embracing the GCAS — an integrated and transparent platform launched by the Government of Gujarat. The registration window closed on May 21, 2025..."

Last year, as GCAS was implemented across the state, protests erupted at MSU in Vadodra with fears that the quota of local students might be reduced to accommodate outside students, particularly in the commerce stream, triggered by the record cut-off of the first professional merit list.

While Faculty of Commerce received over 10,000 applications, the Faculties of Science and Arts received 6,116 and 2,484 applications, respectively. Prof. Hitesh D. Rayva, OSD (Public Relations and Communication), said, "The team has meticulously planned for the upcoming admission phases. Temporary assistant professors have been given extension till June 12, 2025..."

SEEN IN THE FRINGE AREAS OF RATANMAHAL SANCTUARY

Royal Bengal Tiger spotted in Dahod, could be on hunt for new territory: official

A ROYAL Bengal Tiger, probably looking to mark its territory, has been frequently spotted in the vacant areas of the Ratanmahal sanctuary in Dahod district, picking the interest of wildlife enthusiasts and the Gujarat Forest Department.

While officials of the Forest Department are watchful, they confirm that if the tiger marks its territory in Gujarat, it would be the first such instance in the state since the 1980s.

According to senior officials of the Gujarat Forest Department, a single male tiger has been spotted in the fringe areas of Ratanmahal sanctuary in Dahod district, which shares a border with Jhabua district of Madhya Pradesh in the South and East. Besides, it has proximity to Kathiwada region of MP, which is known for its tiger population. Officials said that the Gujarat Forest Department is yet to begin tracking the tiger or formally declare its presence as the big cat is yet to mark its territory in the state.

A senior official told The Indian Express, "For about three months now, the tiger has been frequently spotted in the fringe areas of the Ratanmahal sanctuary in Dahod, which shares its border with Jhabua

and Kathiwada in MP... The tiger is a single male, about five years old, who may be searching for a new territory as the population of tigers has significantly increased in Madhya Pradesh."

"We are not yet tracking it closely as it may be showing signs of marking territory in Gujarat that is clear enough to declare that the state has its first tiger in several years. So far, it has only shown movement in the fringe area," a senior official added.

Wildlife experts told The Indian Express that male tigers, especially sub-adults and adults, create their territories either by challenging other tigers in their own vacant forest areas.

"Tigers are known to travel several hundred kilometers in search of territory. Males disperse and move away sooner than the females. They are also known to cover a greater area in a quicker span of time to establish their territory."

They use many ways to convey their ownership of a territory, including scents, visual appearance, aggression towards intruders of space as well as marking signs... it could be scratching trees, roaring, and also urinating and droppings in their territory from time to time to check for intrusions — mainly other tigers — and once they have established their dominance, they will also be searching for prey," said a wildlife expert.

While forest officials strictly refuse to stake claim on the tiger yet, officials added that if the tiger shows definite signs of territory marking, it would be the first since the late 1980s.

In February 2019, a tiger had been sighted in Lunawada of Mahisagar district, and the Gujarat Forest Department had also confirmed the animal's

presence by camera traps. The animal was found dead just days later, suspected to be poisoned.

A senior government official said, "Usually, the villagers around the area where a tiger has been spotted go into an immediate panic mode... For now, we have advised villagers in Dahod not to panic but the official confirmation of the sighting can be made only when the tiger has settled in its territory and the groundwork has been done on educating the villagers around."

According to the Forest Department officials, the last population of tigers was estimated to be around 12 in 1989, with a majority of the big cats spotted in the South Gujarat forests of Dang district. In the 1992 tiger census, tigers were reported to have ceased to exist in Gujarat.

Services of Ahmedabad Metro disrupted due to theft of copper cables

THE TRAIN services of Ahmedabad Metro on the East-West corridor between Apparel Park and Old High Court were affected, following a theft of copper cables, on Thursday morning, according to a statement.

The services on the affected section were restored in the afternoon after the cables were replaced.

An FIR in connection with the theft of around 500-metre-long copper cable was filed in the Shapur police station under the provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita. The estimated worth of the stolen cable is Rs 9 lakh, said sources.

The East-West corridor of Ahmedabad Metro runs between Vastral and Thaltej Gan stations. Gujarat Metro Rail Corporation Limited (GMRC), the company that operates the services, in a statement, said, "In the East-West corridor of Ahmedabad Metro, the main services were affected in the morning between Apparel Park to Old High Court due to theft of cables last night between Shapur to Old High Court Station. However, the train services were available between

Honda expands production, 'to create 1,800 jobs'

AHMEDABAD: Honda Motorcycle & Scooter India Pvt. Ltd. (HMSI), on Thursday, said it plans to build a new production line at its fourth plant, located in Vitthalpur, in the Ahmedabad, according to a statement from the company.

The production line plans to build an annual production capacity of 650,000 units of 125 cc bikes and regular train services were restored at 13:37 hrs on East-West corridor as per regular train operation schedules," said the statement.

The GMRC also stated that the train services in the North-South corridor remained unaffected. The North-South corridor runs between APVC Market and Motera Stadium.

The FIR has been registered with police by an employee of the GMRC.

According to the FIR, the theft was committed by an unidentified person between 5:30 am and 6:15 am Thursday by scaling the steel bridge between Shapur and Old High Court stations. It added that the unidentified person had cut the cables used to supply power to the trains, with a sharp edged tool.

A senior police official, familiar with the development, said that investigations are ongoing since the case and they suspect the culprit to be a person with technical knowledge.
