SC to hotels on Kanwar route: Comply with law, display licence

ASSERTING THAT it was only trying to balance the sentiments of pilgrims and the rights of hoteliers, the Supreme Court said Tuesday that eateries along the Kanwar Yatra route "shall comply with the mandate of displaying the licence and the registration certificate as per the statutory requirements".

A bench of Justices M M Sundresh and N K Singh underlined that "consumer is the king" and should be given the choice to know what food a restaurant serves, including outside the Kanwar Yatra period, so that they can make an informed decision.

"If a hotel is vegetarian all through, without any diversion, then you are right, the question of indicating the name and other things will not arise. But only for the purpose of yatra, if somebody stops (serving) non-vegetarian and goes to vegetarian, the consumer should know. Even then we agree with you, the name may not be displayed, but there should be some way to indicate that yes only vegetarian is served though earlier both were being served. To that extent we are saying we must give the flexibility to the consumer," Justice Sundresh remarked orally.

The apex court was hearing an

interlocutory application challenging the UP government's direction to food-sellers along the Kanwar Yatra route to display QR code stickers which, on scanning, would reveal ownership details of the eatery and other legal compliance. While disposing of the application, the bench said it was not going into the legal challenge as the pilgrimage is already at its flag end. "At this stage, we would only pass an order that all the respective hotel owners shall comply with the mandate of displaying the licence and the registration certificate as required statutorily. We make it clear that we are not going into the other issues argued," the bench said in its order. "We are trying to pass an equitable order. Sentiments of the devotees should not be affected. Right to livelihood of the hoteliers should also not be affected," said Justice Sundresh.

The application cited news reports that the state administration had issued a directive making it mandatory for the eateries to display the QR codes. It also referred to a "press note dated 25.06.2024 issued by the Chief Minister of UP" and said "it expressly calls for shopkeeper names to be clearly displayed during the yatra". of identity division on a non-issue... The only issue here is identity politics... Justice Sundresh said people have different food choices and may want to know if a place serves vegetarian or non-vegetarian food. "I am out and out non-vegetarian... I am basically agnostic. I have no problem at all. You may go to a star hotel where both veg and non-veg are served. But some may have reservations going to a place where both are served...who will not even touch certain foods," he remarked.

PM'S 2-NATION VISIT STARTS TODAY Modi to raise pro-Khalistan activities, extradition of fugitives during UK visit

BESIDES THE expected signing of the free trade agreement (FTA) with the United Kingdom, India will also raise the issue of Khalistani extremism and the return of fugitive economic offenders during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's two-day official visit to the country, which starts Wednesday.

During the visit, besides discussing the whole gamut of India-UK ties with his British counterpart Keir Starmer, PM Modi is also expected to call upon King Charles III, officials said.

India and the UK had announced the conclusion of the FTA on May 6, after three years of negotiations.

India is also in discussions with Maldives for an FTA as well as an investment treaty, Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri said Tuesday, briefing reporters on the PM's two-nation visit.

After completing his visit to the UK on Thursday, PM Modi will head to Maldives on a two-day state visit, where he will be the 'Guest of Honour' for the 60th Independence Day celebrations of the island nation on July 26.

Misri said that the issue of Khalistani extremists and related groups is a matter of concern for India, and it has been brought to the attention of partners in the UK.

Discussions have also taken place between India and the UK regarding the extradition of fugitives to India, Misri said.

"The issue of the presence of

Khalistani extremists, bodies close to these people, is something that we have brought to the attention of our partners in the UK. We will continue to do so. This is a matter of concern not only to us but should be a matter of concern to our partners as well because this impacts social cohesion and social order in these countries as well," he said.

In response to a query on the issue of fugitives in the UK, including Vijay Malhiya, Nirav Modi and Lalit Modi, Misri said that there is a legal process to such requests regarding fugitives related to Indian law and India is working "very closely" with the UK on this issue.

"There is a legal process that such requests, issues go through in the other country, and we continue to follow up very closely

with our partners in the UK on these matters," he said.

Misri also listed key areas of the India-UK bilateral cooperation, saying that the partnership has seen regular high-level exchanges across sectors such as trade, investment and defence.

This would be PM Modi's fourth visit to the UK. The India-UK partnership was upgraded to a comprehensive strategic partnership in 2021 and since then, it has seen regular high level political exchanges.

Misri added, "In the defence sector, we are seeing regular interactions and exercises amongst all three branches of the armed forces." The two PMs will also exchange views on issues of regional and global importance.

Assent to Bills: Notice to Centre, states on President's timeline reference

THE SUPREME COURT on Tuesday issued notice to the Centre and all states on the reference made to it by President Droupadi Murmu under Article 143 of the Constitution, following its verdict that fixed timelines for the President and Governors to act on

Bills passed by Assemblies. Article 143 refers to the President's power to consult the top court.

A Constitution Bench of Chief Justice of India B R Gavai and Justices Surya Kant, Vikram Nath, P S Narasimha, and A S Chandurkar said it will fix timelines for the hearing next week. CJ Gavai said, "Tentatively, we propose to start (the hearing) somewhere in mid-August."

The counsels appearing for Kerala and Tamil Nadu said they propose to question the maintainability of the reference. The CJ asked them to reserve their arguments for the hearing.

In the reference made under Article 143(1), President Murmu has posed 14 questions over the top court's April 8 verdict. The President sought to know whether the actions of

Governors and the President are justiciable (whether courts can look into it) and whether such timelines can be imposed on them in the absence of any such provision in the Constitution.
