




**Independent Auditor's Review Report on the Quarterly Unaudited Standalone

Review report to The Board of Directors
Premier Explosives Limited

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited standalone financial results of **PREMIER EXPLOSIVES LIMITED** (the 'Company') for the quarter ended September 30, 2020 and year to date from April 01, 2020 to September 30, 2020 (the "Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('the Regulation') as amended.

A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

- The Statement has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable and in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.
- The Company is engaged in the business of "High Energy Materials" and has only one reportable segment in accordance with Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments".
- On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization characterized the outbreak of a strain of the new coronavirus ("COVID-19") as a pandemic. This outbreak is causing significant disturbance and slowdown of economic activity. The management has assessed the impact of COVID-19 pandemic on the unaudited Standalone financial statements, business operations, liquidity position, cash flow and has concluded that based on the current estimates no material adjustments are required in the carrying amount of assets and liabilities as at 30th September 2020. September 30, 2020 and total revenues of Rs. 14.57 lakhs and 25.64 lakhs, net profit after tax and total comprehensive income of Rs. 6.09 lakhs and Rs. 13.14 lakhs for the quarter ended September 30, 2020 and from April 01, 2019 to September 30,2019, respectively, and net cash out flows of Rs. 6.05 lakhs for the period from April 01, 2020 to September 30,2020, and as considered in the statement. The Statement also includes the Group's share of net loss after tax and total comprehensive loss of Rs Nil for the quarter and for the period ended September 30, 2020, respectively, as considered in the Statement, in respect of one joint venture, based on their interim Ind AS financial results which have not been reviewed by any auditors. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial results and financial information are not material to the Group.
