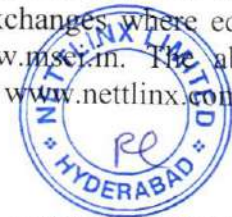

## Independent Auditor's Report

### Report on Audit of Standalone Financial Results

#### Opinion

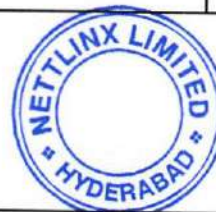
