## CR Patil inaugurated the 34 crore bridge like a jewel of beauty

The road is closed as soon as the bridge is reached, motorists are forced to take a U-turn; 56 percent of the work of the connecting railway crossing overbridge is incomplete

A new bridge has been constructed near Bhestan at a cost of Rs 34 crore by the Surat Municipal Corporation in the name of development, but this bridge has now become a joke for the city dwellers. On the road from Vadod to Kardwa, motorists can climb from one end of the 600-meter bridge and get off at the other end, but they have to return from there. The reason behind this is that the bridge prepared by the administration has been inaugurated, but the connecting bridge crossing the railway line in front of the bridge has not been built yet. Due to which, motorists get stuck after crossing the 600 meters of bridge. It is worth mentioning that looking at these scenes, it seems as if children climb the stairs to get into the garden and then come down and get back into it. Since there is no arrangement to cross the railway track, this bridge is currently proving to be just a 'decorative ornament'.  
Siddharthnagar Railway Bridge work is still 56 percent incomplete. If this railway bridge had been completed on time, Vesu would have had a direct connection with National Highway No. 48. With the completion of this project, it would have been much easier for about 5 lakh people of Dindoli and Limbayat areas to reach Dumas, Vesu and Althan. But unfortunately, the work of Siddharthnagar Railway Bridge is still 56 percent incomplete. Due to this slow pace of the system, the convenience of lakhs of people is currently hanging in the air. The project, which was to be completed at a cost of Rs 59 crore, is incomplete despite spending Rs 74 crore. When the work order for this project was given in 2019, it was hoped that the work would be completed in two and a half years. But today, even though seven years have passed, the work has not been completed. Due to this delay, the municipal treasury has also suffered a financial blow.

# 'We're even scared to go to school'

## What happens in schools when there's a bomb threat? Psychologist gives this serious warning

Ahmedabad  
The second threat to blow up a prominent school in Ahmedabad city in 36 days has raised concerns among school administrators, parents and police. Because, as soon as a bomb threat is received, an atmosphere of chaos is created in the school and parents also start running. However, it has come to light that such threats have the greatest impact on students.

Renowned psychologist Prashant Bhimani has warned parents about the impact of such threats on the mental state of students. He has also given some tips to school administrators to deal with such situations. Bhaskar spoke to students, parents, school administrators and psychologists to find out how such threats affect them.

Parents and school administrators are worried due to repeated threats.

Schools in Ahmedabad received a bomb threat last month, after which another threat was received on January 23. After receiving threats, 15 schools in the city were checked by the police, but nothing was found. Threatening calls are continuously increasing, which is also affecting the studies and mentality of students. So far, bomb threats have been received in three different patterns, which are being investigated by cybercrime.

The threat creates chaos in the school.

According to the rules, when a school receives a bomb threat, all the children

are first taken to an open field to safety. The school itself informs the police and DEO office, after which the parents are informed. In such an incident, the school cannot forcefully keep any student in the school. If the parent wants to take the child home, he can take him. If the situation is normal, the parents have to be informed that the school will resume regularly from the next day.

Upon receiving a message about a bomb, the police control room informs the local police station. The PI and team of the local police station go to the school, take everyone to a safe place and evacuate the building. The school is inspected along with the bomb squad and dog squad. If any suspicious items are found in the school, they are also inspected. Only after a complete inspection of the school is the movement of the school started after a few minutes. The local police provides information about the email to the cyber crime unit. The investigation is carried out by the cyber crime unit.

When the DEO office is informed about the bomb in the school, an officer from the DEO office visits the school. The DEO is informed about the condition of the school. The DEO prepares a report on the school and sends it to the Education Department, Gandhinagar. The DEO gives suggestions to the school in writing.

Along with education, the mental state of students

is also affected due to repeated bomb threats in schools. Vivek Kapasi, Principal of Shri Vidyanagar School, said that due to repeated such threats, panic situations arise. Because students do not know why they are immediately sent away. It also affects the education of students a lot. While coming to school, they get a home-like atmosphere here. But due to repeated such situations, they face a lot of problems. According to the school safety rules, as soon as a threatening mail is received, the students are immediately gathered in the field. The police are also informed immediately. The DEO office is also informed. After which a message is sent to all the parents and the students are sent home. Teachers also panic.

Vivek Kapasi further said that when such a situation arises, one also has to take care that no other accident occurs during the rush. Because as soon as the parents receive a message that the school has been threatened with a bomb, all the parents reach the school at once.

One also has to take care that traffic problems do not arise outside the school due to the parents coming to the school at the same time. It is natural that if a parent's child is studying in school and receives such a message, they feel scared. Also, it becomes a topic of discussion in the parents' group. A very tense atmosphere arises.
