THANE

Out to swim, teen drowns

An 18-year-old drowned while swimming in the Rayladevi lake on Sunday evening. The deceased, Saheel Ghorpade, lived with his family in Sathenagar in Wagale Estate. An official from the Regional Disaster Management Cell (RDMC) of the Thane Municipal Corporation said, "After receiving information that a youth has drowned in the lake, a rescue vehicle, pickup truck and ambulance was dispatched." According to the RDMC, Ghorpade along with friends went to the lake to swim. However, he could not gauge the depth and drowned. Another friend alerted the locals as well as the rescue team. RDMC chief Yasin Tadvii said that the body was salvaged within an hour-and-a-half with the help of an underwater telescopic camera.

Bank scam: Stir in Thane

The depositors of scam-hit New India co-operative bank staged a protest on Monday, demanding urgent action on the revival or merger of the institution. Protesters under the banner of the NICB Depositors' Foundation marched to the bank's Majiwada branch and submitted a detailed memorandum. The main demands are increase in the withdrawal cap from Rs25,000 to Rs1.5 lakh, full repayment of fixed deposits beyond the insured limit, early recovery of funds from attached properties linked to fraudsters, etc. The depositors warned of intensifying their agitation if authorities continued to delay action.

Police duo held for 'colluding' with drug syndicate

In another startling development in the probe into drug cartel, which is apparently being operated from Malaysia, the special investigation team (SIT) has arrested two police men for allegedly colluding with the syndicate. The move comes after Gurunath Chichkar, 50, a builder and father of prime suspect Chichkar brothers - Dheeraj and Naveen - shot himself dead on Friday morning after being "fed up" of answering to the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and Anti-Narcotics Unit (ANU) during their investigations.

The accused cop duo has been identified as constable Sachin Bhalerao attached to Kharghar police station and Sanjay Phulkar working with the ANU, Navi Mumbai. The SIT was formed after the ANU nabbed two men on April 15 with imported drugs. The accused, identified as Ashish Gaware, 22, and Ahmed Olgi, 23, were caught red-handed on the terrace of Gaware's residence at NL-2 building in sector 15, Nerul, while conducting a drug deal. A third suspect, Akash Maurya, managed to flee.

During the operation, officers seized a total of 1.15 kg of traditional cannabis and 17.19 grams of imported drugs. In addition to the narcotics, police recovered weighing scales, empty plastic pouches, parcel bags, a crusher and other packaging material. The impounded items are estimated to be worth Rs2.76

Builder kills self over son's drug cartel links

lakh. The police then registered a case against the arrested individuals under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and formed a SIT under the directions of Navi Mumbai police commissioner Milind Barambe.

"During the investigations, we found the role of the two police men in the drug cartel and we arrested them on Sunday. Further investigations are on and we can reveal more information only later," Barambe said.

In the course of the investigation, the police had found that Dheeraj is allegedly running the cartel from Malaysia. According to police sources, Bhalerao and Phulkar are part of the drug syndicate. His elder brother Naveen is already wanted by the NCB, which issued a red corner notice against him a fortnight ago.

In a three-page letter addressed to the NCB, Gurunath mentioned his struggles of how he reached Mumbai and how he became a builder with hard work. Around five years back, he learnt that his elder son was involved in the drug cartel which broke him completely, read the letter. Gurunath added that when his younger son was named, it was unbearable for him. In the letter, he asserted that his wife and his youngest son had nothing to do with the drug cartel.

Retd professor duped of ₹11.93L

A father-daughter duo, both senior citizens, lost Rs11.93 lakh to cyber fraudsters, who trapped the 65-year-old woman under the pretext of providing medical insurance to her father.

According to the FIR, the 90-year-old father is a doctor, while his daughter has retired as a professor from a Sweden varsity. On March 19, R Kaul from Versova got a call from an unknown number and the caller identified himself as Kuldeep Shrivastak from the ONGC office. He told her that the medical insurance coverage of her father, Dr C Kaul, had not been approved yet.

When she asked what needed to be done, the scammer instructed her to download a 'customer support' app, assuring that her father would receive coverage of Rs10 lakh.

Later, the fraudster asked the professor to transfer Rs1.93 lakh, saying the same would be refunded. Two days later, her father learned that Rs10 lakh had been siphoned off.

Mob booked for vandalism

The police have booked 45 unidentified people for allegedly vandalising West Centre, a commercial building located in Kandivali. A company (not named in FIR) of one Bhavy Shah suffered damages worth Rs1.50 crore. The FIR, however, is silent on why the vandalism took place. On April 27, a mob of around 40 to 45 people gathered outside West Centre and threatened the security guard to ask the staff to vacate the premises. Subsequently, they began vandalising the office using hammers and sticks.



Over 15k sign petition opposing tree axing for Metro 9 car shed

More than 15,000 signatures have been collected in the first two days of the drive opposing the construction of Metro 9 car shed in Uttan, which requires axing of nearly 12,400 trees. Apart from a door-to-door campaign, booths and tables have been set up at strategic locations to collect signatures for the campaign, which will continue till March 4. - Suresh Golani

Metro 4 enters girder launch stage; schedule as per time

In a major milestone for Metro 4, phase 2 construction, the project has now entered the crucial and challenging stage of girder installation. In a high-precision operation carried out at the bustling Gandhi Nagar junction in Vikhroli, engineers are launching a colossal 62.7-metre steel girder, weighing around 540 metric tonnes, at a height of 24 metres over the JVL-RBS junction. The officials confirmed that the complex girder launch is progressing according to schedule. Once fully operational, the line is expected to serve over eight lakh commuters daily.

This operation marks a significant step forward for phase 2 of Metro 4, the section between Cadbury Junction and Gandhi Nagar, which is on course to open by December 2026. Once completed, the line will connect Gaimukh on Ghodbunder Road through Thane and



Mulund to Kanjurmarg, drastically cutting commute times and enhancing connectivity across Mumbai's eastern corridor.

The girder installation, one of the most technically challenging aspects of the project, is taking place in an extremely narrow space flanked by heavy traffic on both JVL and LBS Road. With cranes operating under tight constraints, the operation is being executed in three stages: a 30-meter span launched over JVL and under Metro 6, a 17-meter segment extending toward Vikhroli and a 15-metre portion toward Mulund.

2 The statement has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down under Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the 'Act') and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. The statement is in compliance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended).

3 The Board of Directors have recommended final equity dividend of ₹ 8 per share (80%) (previous year ₹ 7 per share (70%) of face value ₹ 10 per share for the Financial year 2024-25. The payment of dividend is subject to shareholders approval at the ensuing Annual General Meeting.

4 Operating segments are reported in a manner consistent with the integral reporting provided to the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM). The CODM regularly monitors and reviews the operating result of the whole Company as one segment "Bearing". Thus, as defined under Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments", the Company's entire business falls under one operational segment.
